SUBJECT: PREA Committee Review

On November 30, 2021, the PREA Committee conducted a review.

The review consisted of 3 substantiated cases. Those cases were: 20S000456, 20S006834, and 20S006839

The review consisted of 5 unfounded cases. Those cases were: 21S005458, 20S008683, 20S009502, 20S009816, 20S010253

This review consisted of 13 unsubstantiated cases. The unsubstantiated cases were: 19S012590, 20S001969, 20S006380, 20S006773, 20S007745, 20S007960, 20S008259, 21S001905, 21S003953, 21S004681, 21S005540, 21S007453, and 21S009757.

In reviewing each of the cases, the committee determined policy was followed; nothing occurred that could have prevented the incidents from happening. There were no signs to make an indication, in either circumstance, a sexual abuse would occur.

In each case review, the committee potentially found an indication either incident was motivated by race, ethnicity, gender identity, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status. On case 20S007745 the inmate alleged as the suspect claimed that he was only being picked on due to being openly homosexual and the others not wanting him in the same living quarters.

The committee also determined there was no indication of gang affiliation, nor was any of the incidents motivated by or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incidents occurred. The physical barriers in the place had no effect on the abuse, the staffing level was adequate, but there might be need for extra cameras. On case 20S006773 there needs to be some research on if another camera is needed at a different angle. If the deputy is not at their desk, there is a small 5 foot blind spot between the door and the hallway.
