AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

by and between:

SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS

and

HEART OF CARE AGENCY, LLC

This Amendment is entered into this 28th day of April, 2022, by and between Sedgwick County, Kansas ("County") and Heart of Care Agency, LLC ("Contractor", "CSP", or "Community Service Provider").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have entered into a Developmental Disability Affiliation Agreement (Original Agreement") on November 10, 2021;

WHEREAS, Section 8.9 of the Original Agreement provides that such agreement may be amended if the parties agree in writing; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the Original Agreement by approving this Amendment to amend Section 4 regarding the services provided by Contractor.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, conditions and promises contain herein, the parties agree the Original Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Section 4: Authorized Services. is hereby amended to read as follows:

"4. Authorized Services. SCDDO agrees the Community Service Provider is authorized to provide and request reimbursement directly from SCDDO, the Managed Care Organization ("MCO") or the Medicaid intermediary for the following program services: Limited Licensed Day Supports (Age 18+), Limited Licensed Residential Supports (Age 18+)."

2. Any provision not specifically amended herein shall remain as provided for in the Original Agreement.

3. This Amendment shall become effective on the date first written above which is the date both parties' authorized representatives have signed indicating their approval.
