- During the month of June, Sedgwick County Developmental Disability Organization (SCDDO) Quality Assurance Staff completed 8 day and 23 residential program visits.
- SCDDO Management Team members met in May to review the finalized strategic plan and develop the plan of work for 2022. Specific strategies for the plan of work include: Ensuring staff understand department infrastructure and how to navigate it, Modernizing processes, structure and positions of the SCDDO to reflect current needs and demands, Maximize tools and resource utilization, Building the SCDDO bench depth to meet required functions, Create a shared understanding and culture around working in a virtual environment and Monitor system capacity, identify gaps and opportunities for access to quality services.
- Shelley Herrington, Quality Assurance Director, convened a meeting to review feedback on waitlist exception requests submitted to the Kansas Department on Aging and Disability Services (KDADS). Over the last year, QA began tracking the questions and comments received from KDADS on the requests. SCDDO Funding Committee members reviewed the information to inform our review process for future waitlist exception requests.
