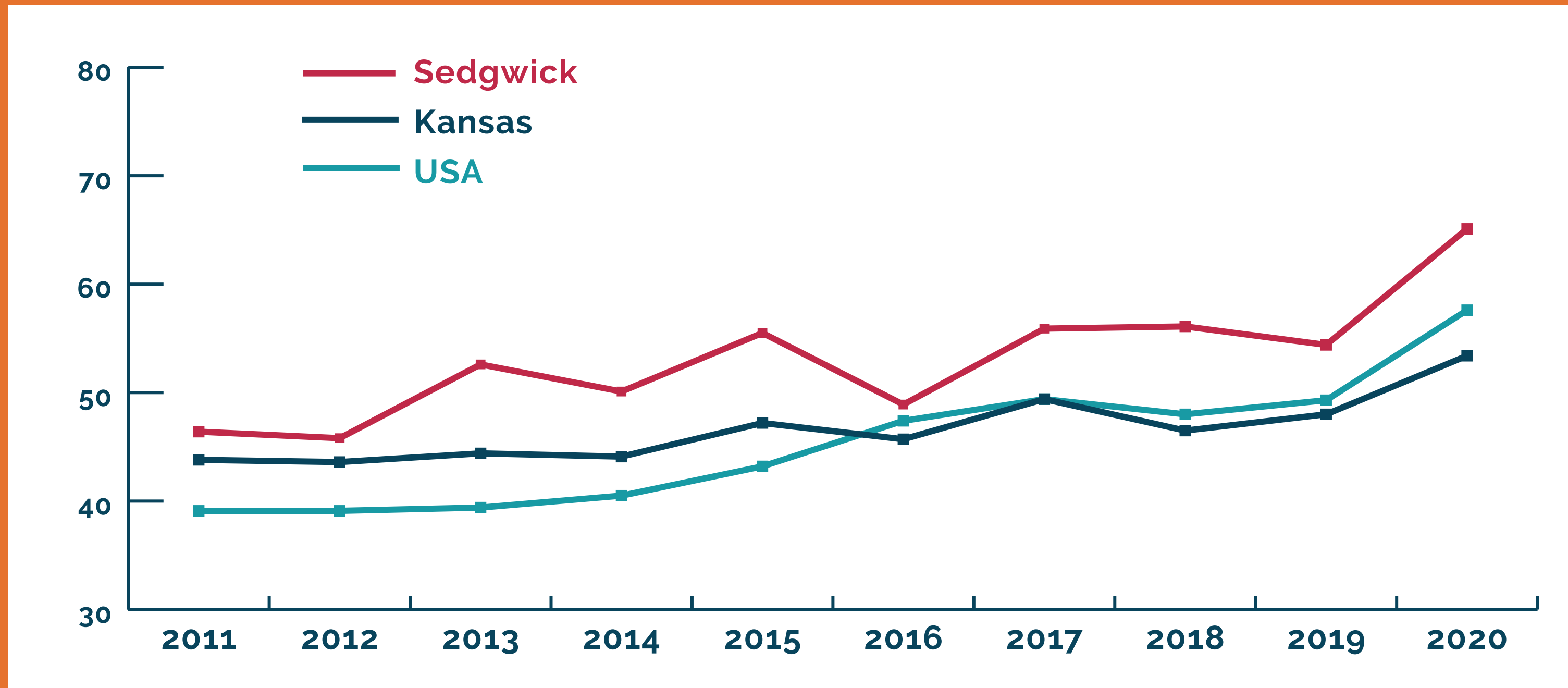

5. DROWNING

FALLING ACCIDENTS

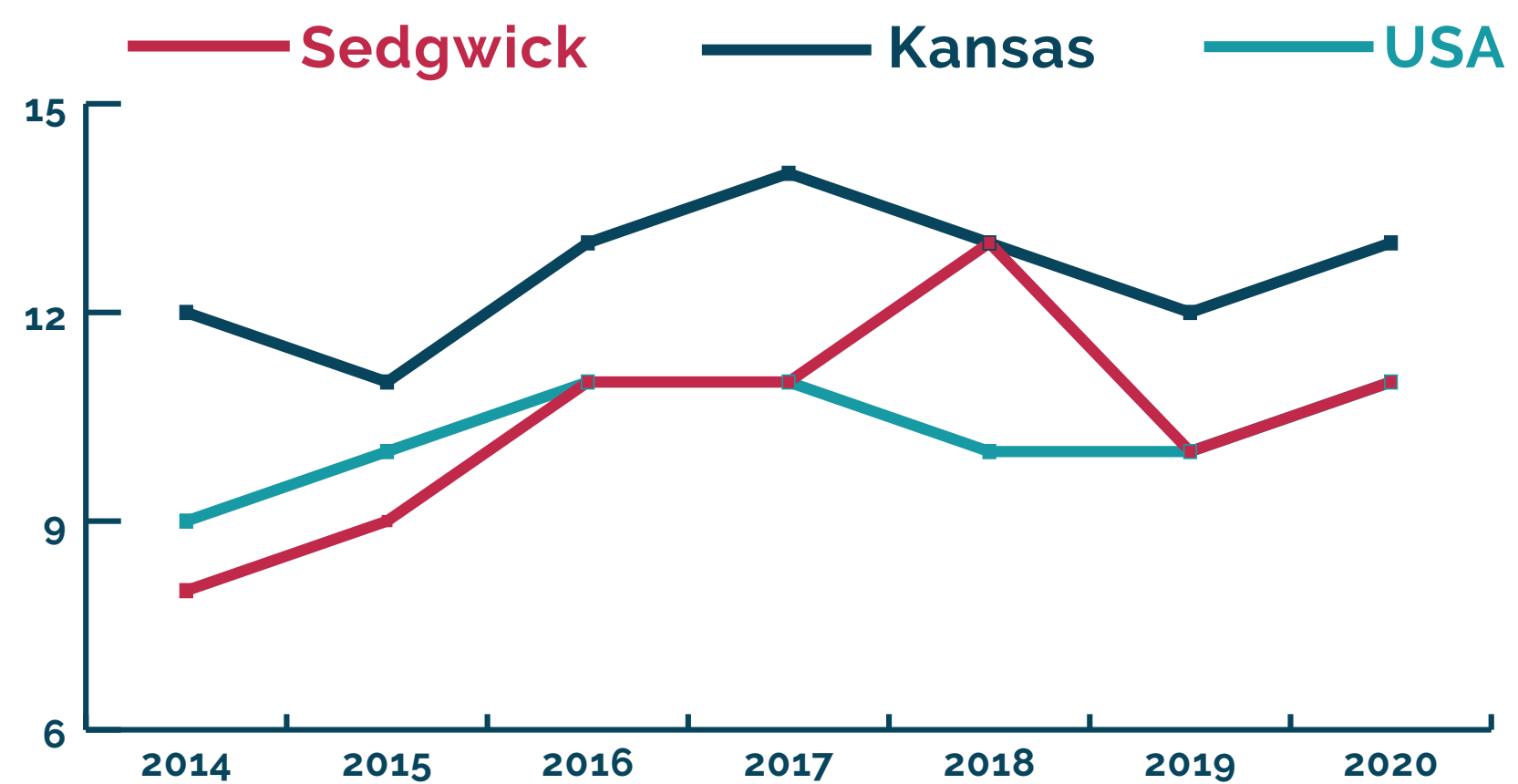

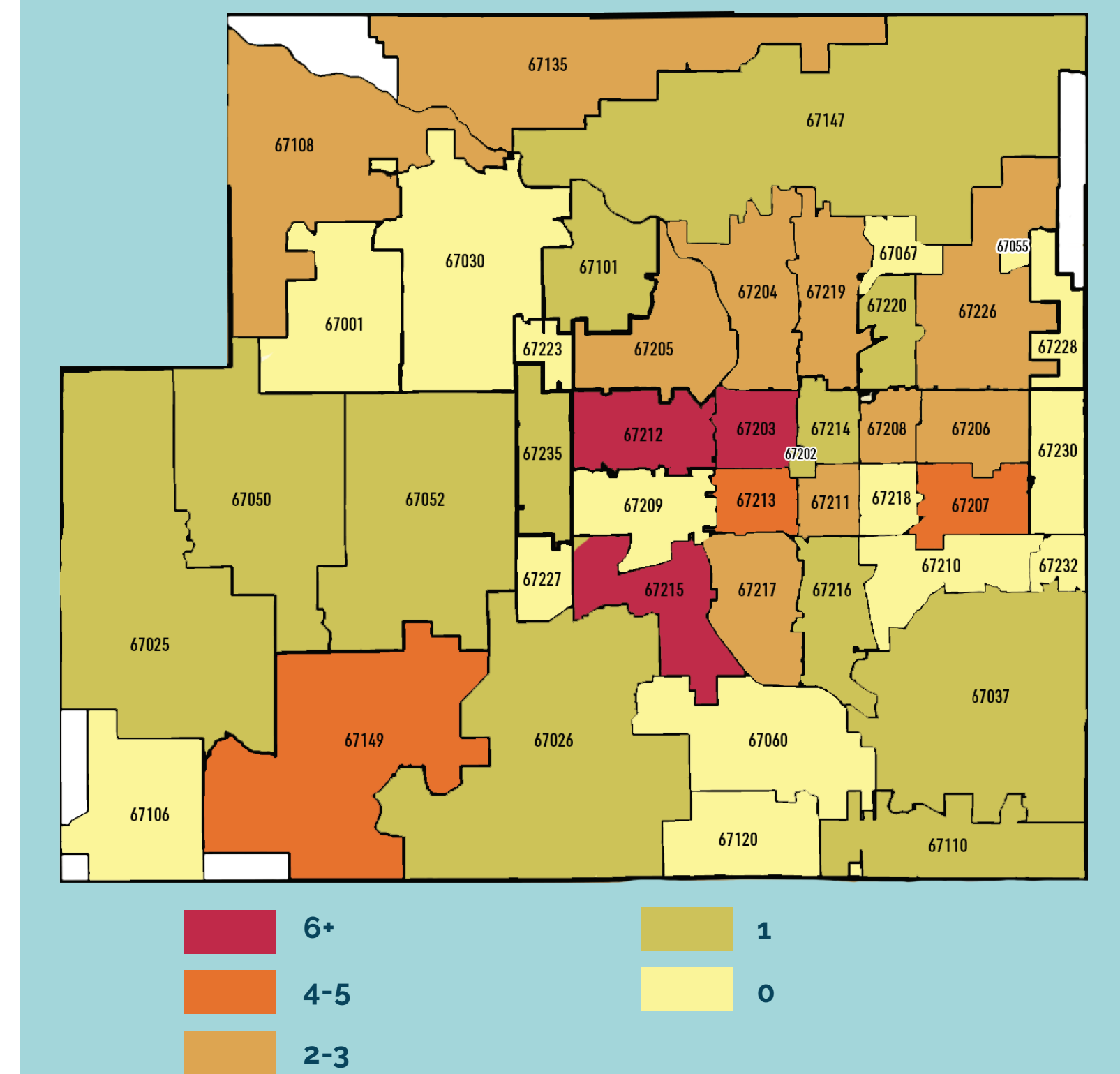

Total number of fatalities from motor vehicle crashes by ZIP Code in 2020.

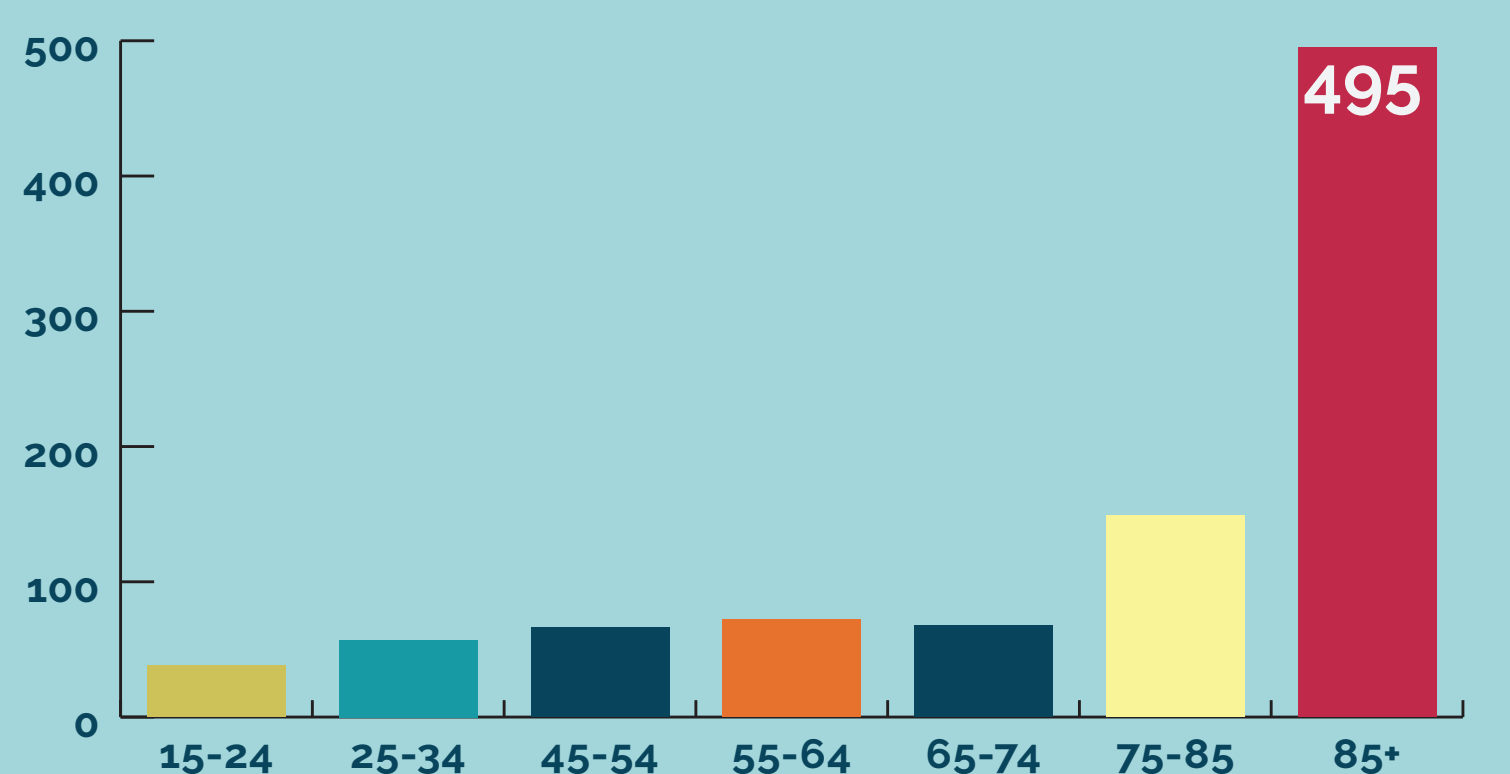

UNINTENTIONAL INJURY DEATHS PER 100,000 SEDGWICK COUNTY RESIDENTS BY AGE

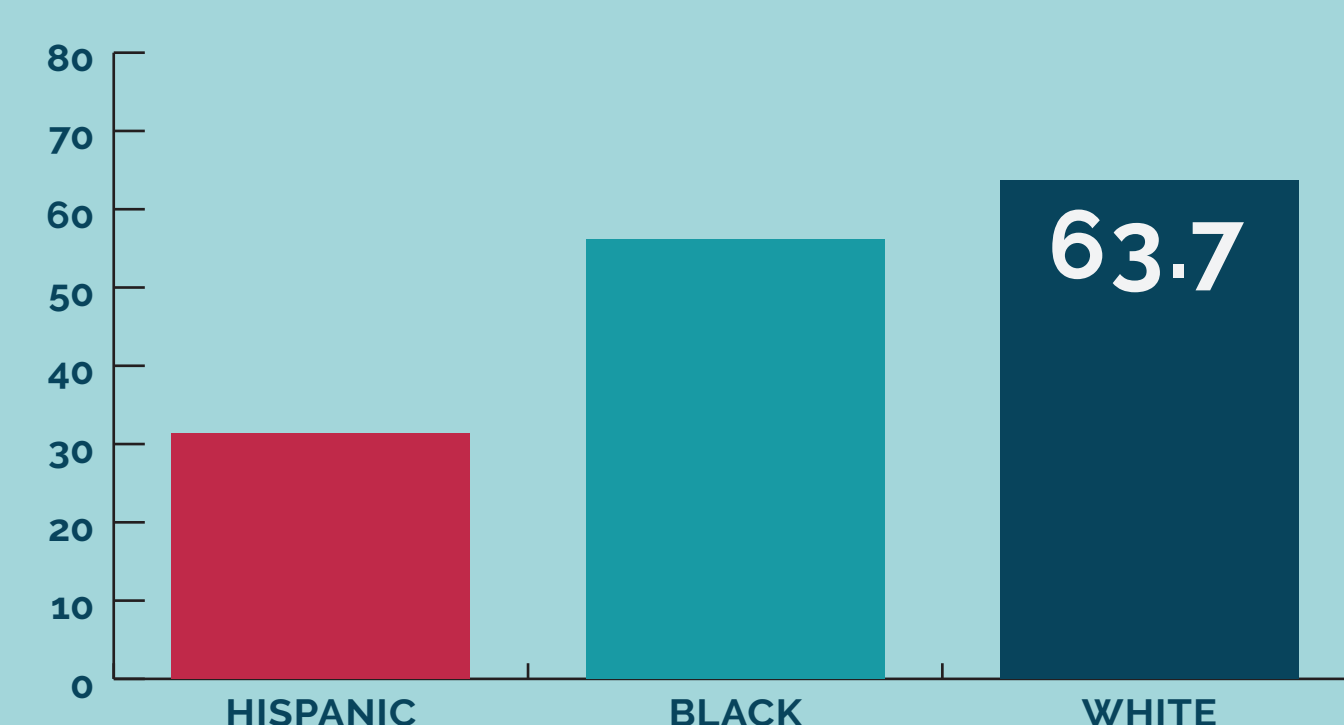

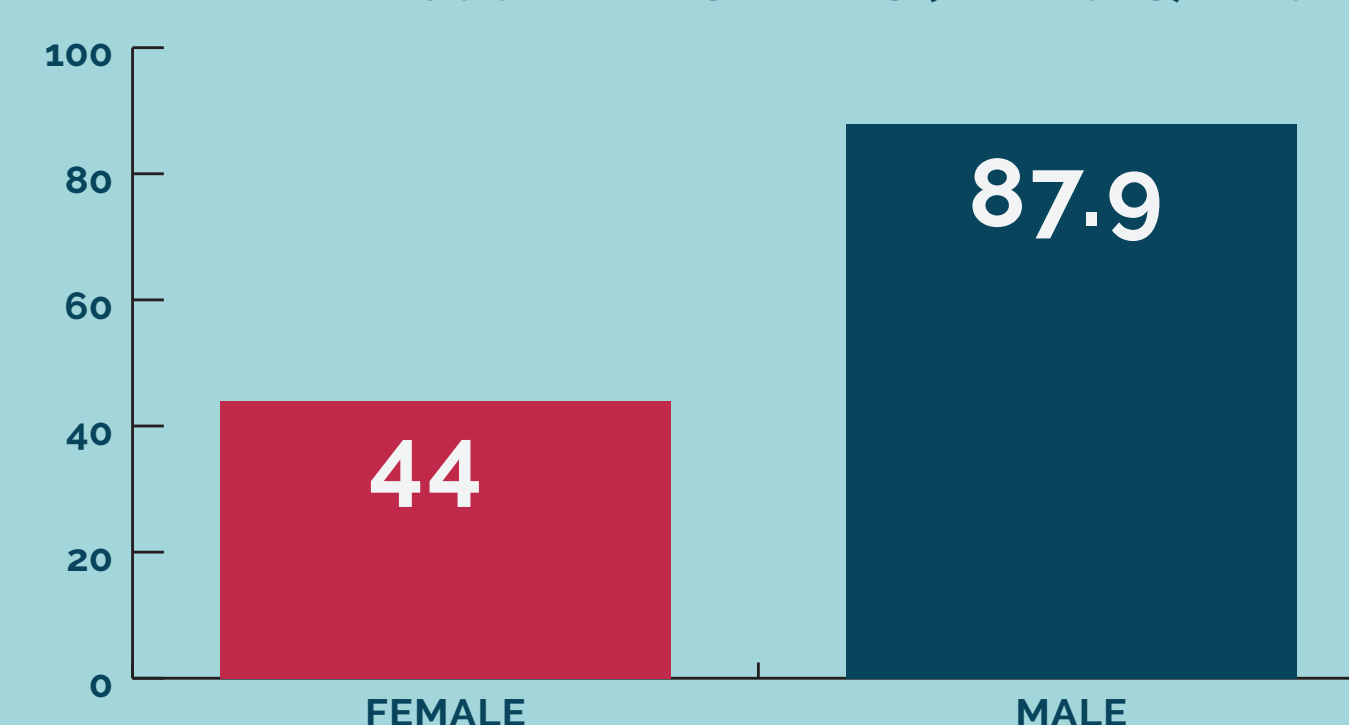
UNINTENTIONAL INJURY DEATHS PER 100,000 SEDGWICK COUNTY RESIDENTS BY RACE/ETHNICITY
