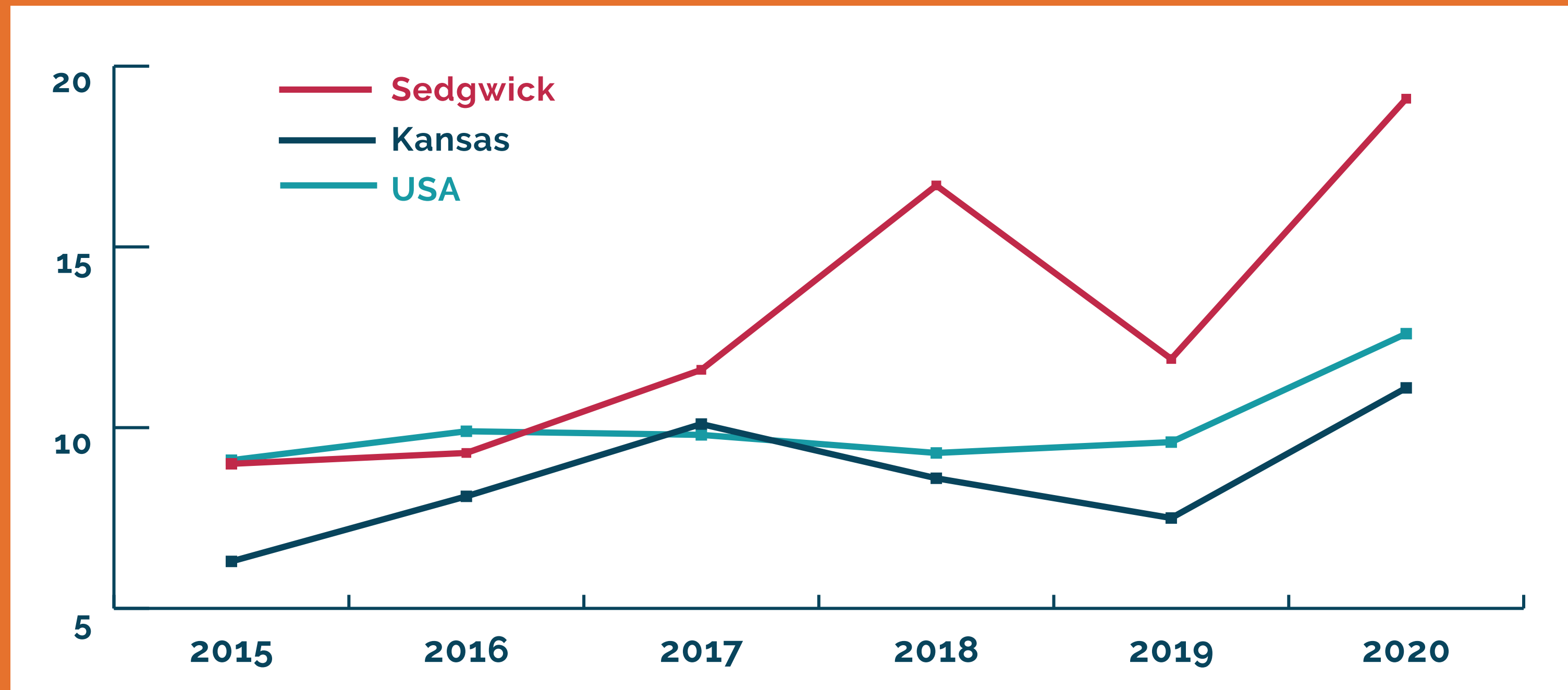

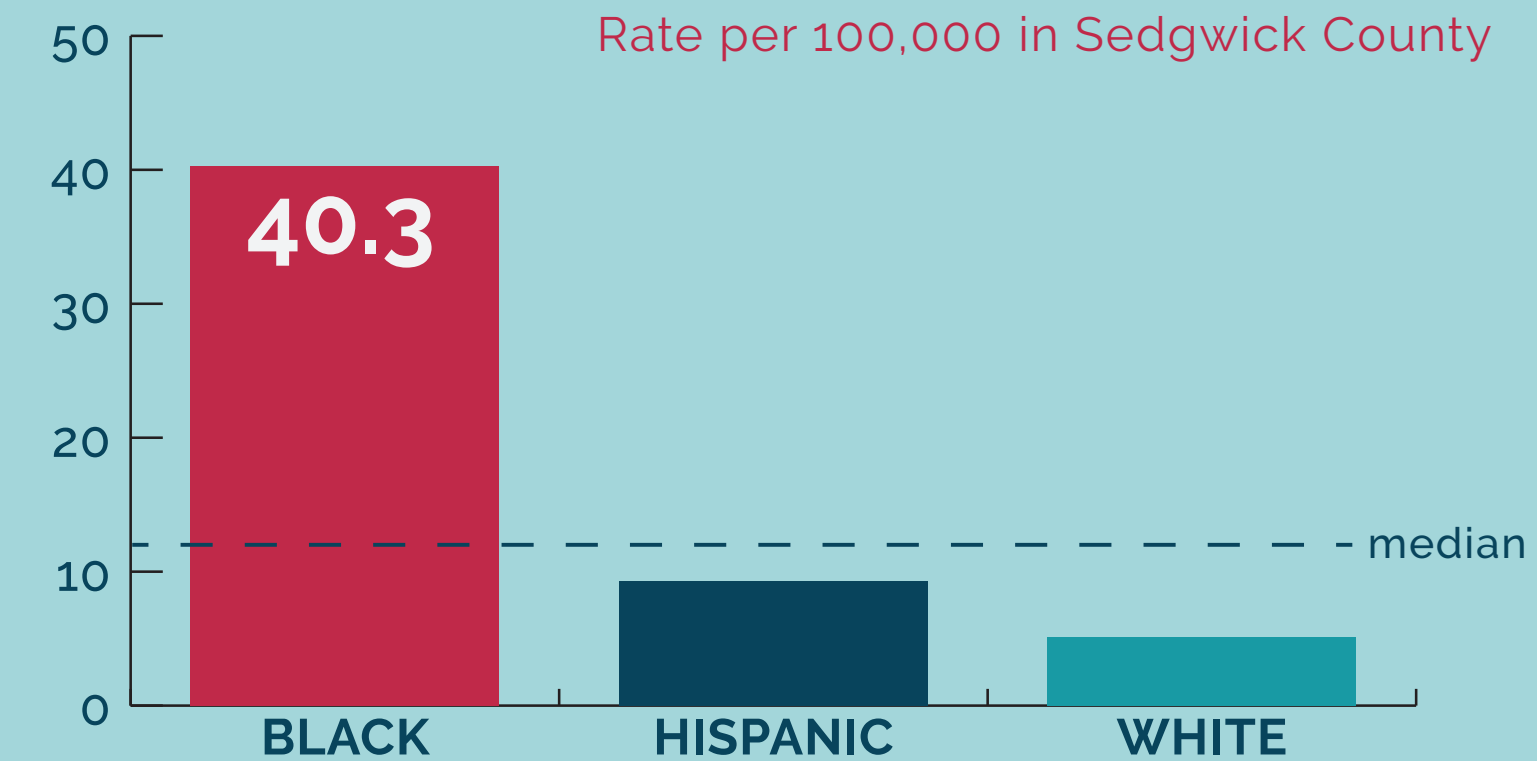

Rate per 100,000 in Sedgwick County

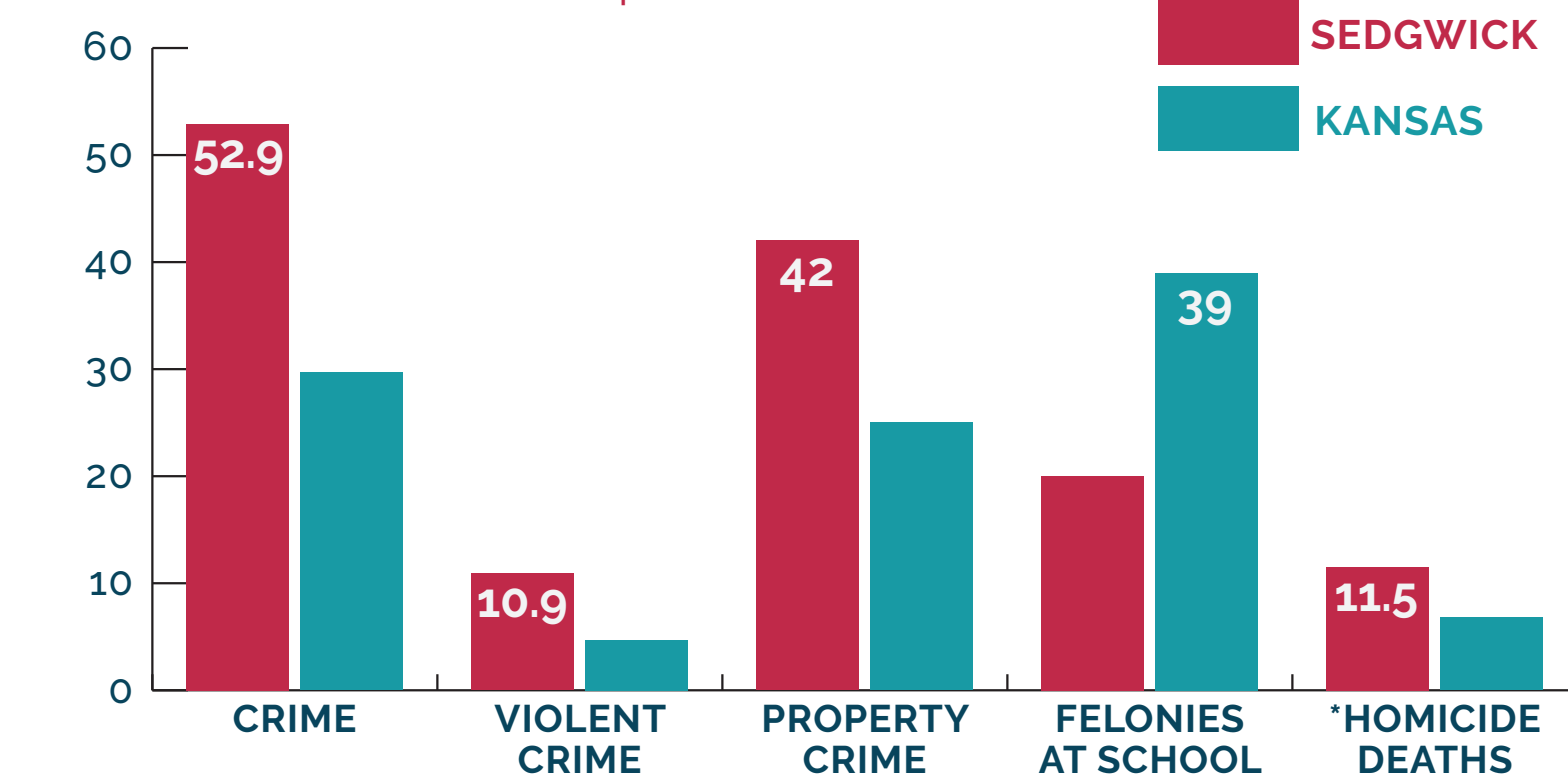

*Homicide Death rate is per 100,000

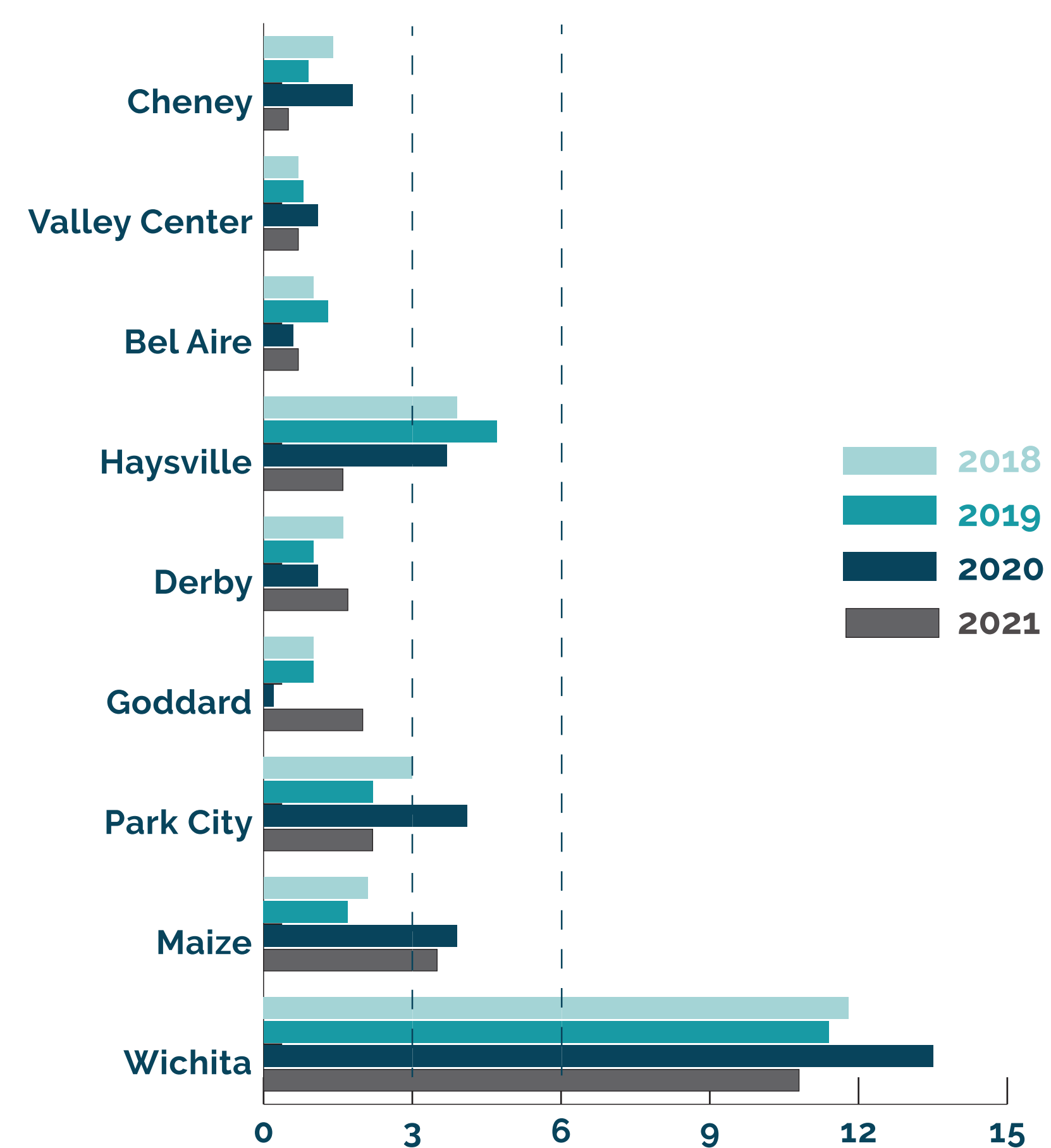

CRIME RATE PER 1,000 RESIDENTS

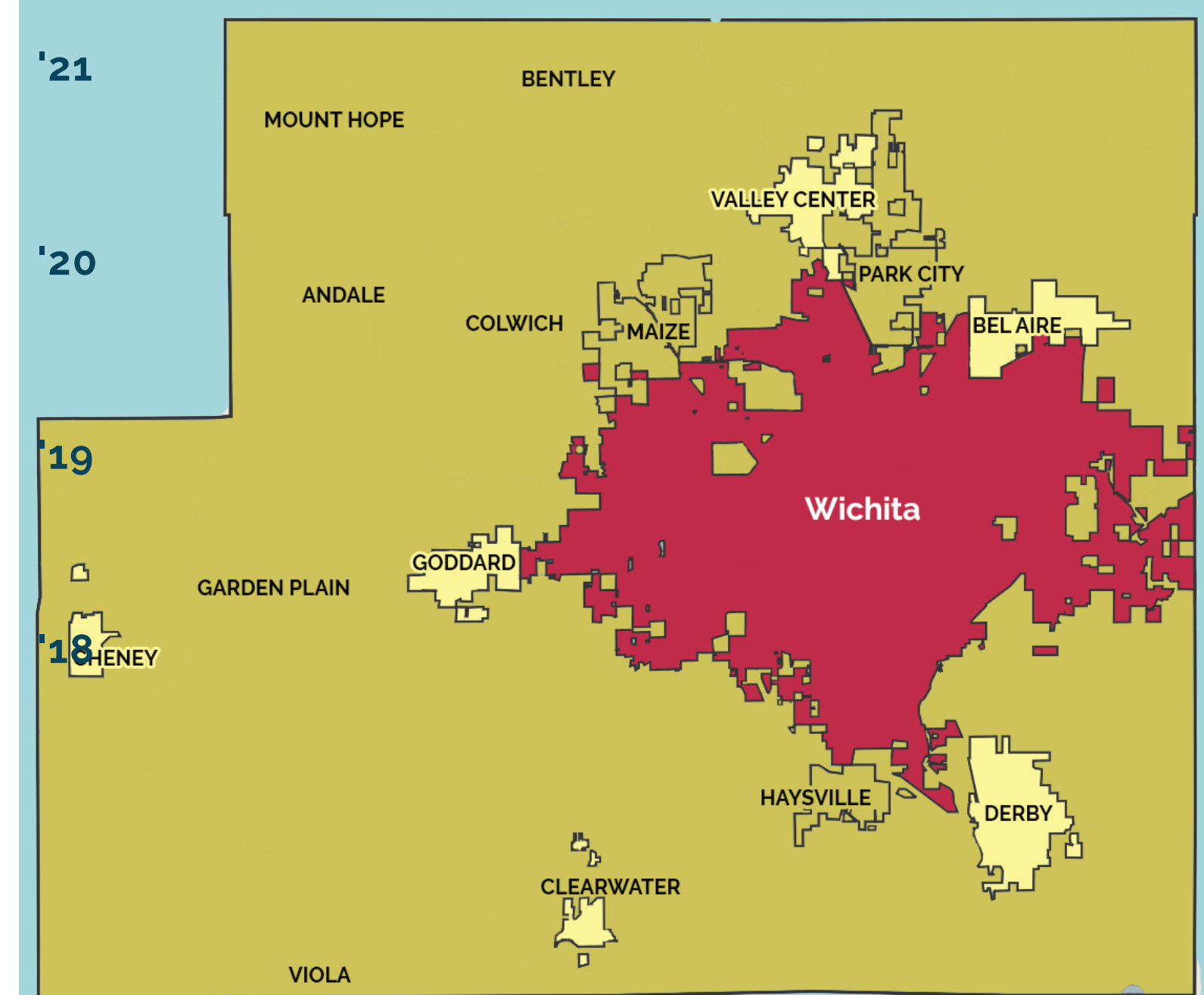

U.S. rate of violent victimization by household poverty level, per 1,000 persons age 12 or older



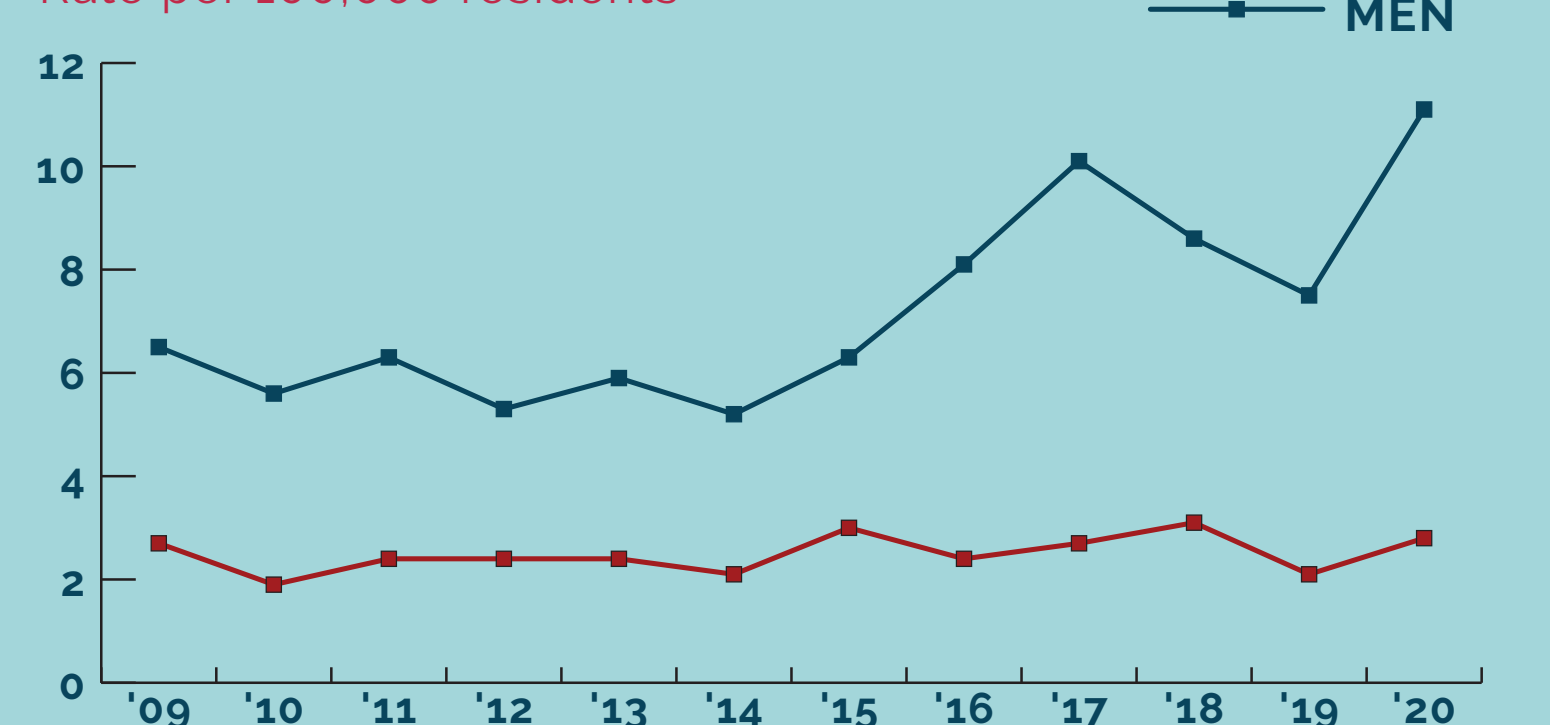
