This Operational Support Van will be used by EMS Logistics and will provide several uses in a supporting role. The van's primary function is delivering mission critical medical supplies to EMS field providers (Paramedics & EMTs). These supplies are delivered to five of the areas main hospitals, including St. Francis, St. Joseph, St. Teresa, Wesley, and Wesley Woodlawn. These supplies consist of medications, disposable medical supplies, and durable medical equipment. Deliveries can range from a few single items to 1500 items being transported daily.

The van will be used to deliver non-critical supplies to 17 of our EMS Posts. It will also deliver medical supplies and medical equipment to Intrust Bank Arena. It can drop off and retrieve medical equipment in the field to our ambulances, such as monitor/defibrillators and ambulance cots. This helps keep ambulances on the streets without having them to go out of service to pick up equipment.

This van will be utilized by some of our specialty teams. It can transport equipment for our Disaster Medical Support Team (DMSU) for Mass Casualty Incidents (MCI), large accident scenes and natural disasters. It can also be used for our Bike Team in transporting bike equipment to large scale events such as the River Festival and the Air Show.

The van's enclosure will protect and secure our durable medical equipment and medical supplies while these items are being transported.
