SUBJECT: PREA Committee Review

On February 26, 2021, the PREA Committee conducted a review of 16 unsubstantiated cases. The unsubstantiated cases were: 20S005348, 20S006976, 20S007364, 20S009189, 20S009442, 21S000124, 21S000163, 21S000264, 21S000279, 21S000429, 21S000559, 21S001105, 21S001173, and 21S001432. There was one case where no KSOR was generated by Lt. Walker according to Lt. Taylor's investigation.

There was one substantiated case under case number 20S006221

In reviewing each of the unsubstantiated cases, the committee determined policy was followed; nothing occurred that could have prevented the incidents from happening. There were no signs to make an indication in either circumstance a sexual abuse would occur.

In each case review, the committee did not find any indication either incident was motivated by race, ethnicity, gender identity, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status.

The committee also determined there was no indication of gang affiliation, nor was any of the incidents motivated by or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incidents occurred. The physical barriers in the place had no effect on the abuse. The staffing level was adequate, and there is no need for extra cameras.
