WICHITA, KAN. – A woman was sentenced in connection with the death of an infant. Xjohnna Hannah, 26 of Wichita, was sentenced to 12 months of probation by Judge David Dahl. The sentence carries an underlying sentence of seven months in prison with 12 months post release.

On February 9th, Hannah pled guilty to aggravated endangering a child in connection with the death of Lasiah Williams. The 20 month old boy was the son of Hannah's boyfriend, Kentrell Willingham, who lived in the 2500 block of N. Chautauqua in Wichita. On March 20th, Judge Jeffrey Goering sentenced Willingham to 66 months in prison after he pled guilty to abuse of a child.

First degree murder charges against Hannah and Willingham were dismissed after an autopsy failed to explain the cause of the child's death. The exam found several bruises over the child's body, but no "notable internal injuries" that would have explained the death.
