SUBJECT: PREA Committee Review for March

On April 10, 2023, the PREA Committee conducted a review of 19 PREA complaints.

This review consisted of 5 substantiated cases. Those cases were: 23S000029, 23S001937, 22S006220, 21S003767, 22S011510.

This review consisted of 4 unfounded cases. Those cases were: 23S002217, 23S001070, 23S002284, 23S001897.

This review consisted of 9 unsubstantiated cases. The unsubstantiated cases were: 22S000768, 22S004354, 21S002655, 23S001897, 23S002258, 23S000012, 23S002469, 23S002441, 23S002271.

This review consisted of 1 incidents not arising to PREA standards. Those cases were:


In reviewing each of the cases, the committee determined policy was followed; nothing occurred that could have prevented the incidents from happening. There were no signs to make an indication, in either circumstance, a sexual abuse would occur.


In each case review, the committee potentially found no indication either incident was motivated by race, ethnicity, gender identity, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status.

The committee also determined there was no indication of gang affiliation, nor was any of the incidents motivated by or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incidents occurred. The physical barriers in the place had no effect on the abuse and the staffing level was adequate.
