Rise Up for Youth presentation – Dr. Shareika Fisher delivered a power point presentation about the programs offered to youth in Wichita area high schools and was available to address questions from the board. - IV. Teen Team Justice Member Position - Steve Stonehouse updated on the process/applications for the position. Discussion was opened. Board all agreed the position should still be made available. - VI. Legislative Update - Mario Salinas provided an update on HB2021 that was signed into law by Governor Kelly since the last board meeting. Sedgwick County is meeting with KDOC next week to discuss logistics of the bill. Updates will be provided to the board as information is received.
- VII. Data and Program Updates – Data was available in the meeting packet. Mario Salinas shared Juvenile Residential Facility (JRF) reopened on May 8th at reduced capacity. There are currently 7 juveniles housed at JRF.
