SUBJECT: PREA Committee Review for August and September

On October 25, 2023, the PREA Committee met and present were the following: Capt. Paula Smith (Behavior Management Team), Logan Reich (Behavior Health Coordinator), Meghan Day (Director of Nursing), Kendra Wolff (Mental Health), Lt. Daniel Oliver (Investigations), Cpl. Chris Carlton (Intel / Investigations), Cpl. John Reed (Intel / Investigations) and Lt. Todd Hallacy (PREA Coordinator).

The PREA Committee conducted a review of 14 PREA complaints. This review consisted of:

2 Substantiated cases. Those cases were:

22S011126, 22S006994.

3 Unfounded cases. Those cases were:

MISC-2023-000641, PREA-2023-000070, PREA-2023-000046.

6 Unsubstantiated cases. Those cases were:

D.D.-2023-00030647, PREA-2023-000075, PREA-2023-000071, 22S008655, PREA-2023-000069, PREA-2023-000057.

3 Incidents not arising to PREA Standards. Those cases were:

MISC-2023-000077, PREA-2023-000072, PREA-2023-000064.

The review considered the following aspects in each case:

In reviewing each of the cases, the committee determined policy was followed; nothing occurred that could have prevented the incidents from happening. There were no signs to make an indication, in either circumstance, sexual abuse would occur.

In each case review, the committee potentially found no indication either incident was motivated by race, ethnicity, gender identity, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status.

The committee also determined there was no indication of gang affiliation, nor was any of the incidents motivated by or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incidents occurred. The physical barriers in the place had no effect on the abuse and the staffing level was adequate.
