## TEAM JUSTICE JCAB Annual Report Workgroup

August 23, 2023 Juvenile Detention Facility Meeting scheduled from 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Purpose: The purpose of the meeting is to complete the FY2023 JCAB Annual Report Spreadsheet that will be presented before Team Justice for approval on September 8, 2023 with final submission to the KDOC-JS by October 1, 2023.

The workgroup met at JDF in the Training Room and via Zoom.

The workgroup reviewed the data provided in the draft 2023 JCAB annual report which will be finalized for submission to the Kansas Department of Corrections by October 1, 2023. The workgroup discussed gaps in services which will be a focus of future funding opportunities. The workgroup identified the following gaps in services which will be presented before Team Justice during the next scheduled meeting on September 8, 2023:

Previous gaps in services that have yet to be addressed:

- Short term/transitional (STAP) housing for justice involved youth
- Day Treatment Center/Drop-In Center
- Services for middle school aged youth targeting schools located in more crime prone areas of the community
- Services targeting youth that are system involved due to weapons related charges
- Substance abuse treatment with focus placed on inpatient treatment services for males aged 10-15 and females.

New potential gaps in services:

• The implementation of the Juvenile Justice Oversight Committee (JJOC) "Innovations in Community Supervision Grant"

\*The focus on all treatment programs will be to provide services that are timely, that are capable of accommodating the needs of the community, and that are geographically accessible.
