On the recommendation of Lee Barrier, on behalf of the Division of Information Technology (DIT), Brandi Baily moved to **utilize State of Kansas Contract #049015 with Surdex Corporation good through December 31, 2027.** Anna Meyerhoff-Cole seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Sedgwick County's Geographic Information Services (GIS) regularly collects six-inch pixel resolution orthorectified aerial imagery every three (3) years and has historically partnered with the City of Wichita GIS Department to help offset the cost of collecting the entire county.

GIS uses this high-resolution orthorectified imagery in mapping products, web mapping applications, and other county enterprise systems including 9-1-1 Emergency Communications and Public Safety.

2017 was the last year GIS purchased imagery as COVID put a pause on extra spending and GIS has not purchased imagery since.

The State of Kansas Next Generation 9-1-1 program collects statewide one-foot pixel resolution imagery every three years (2018, 2021). All Kansas counties, cities, etc. have access to this imagery at no cost to local governments. However, since the state owns the imagery, Sedgwick County is not allowed to distribute it to other local business partners, developers, etc.

This imagery collection will include the entire county (including the metro area) and not include partnering with City of Wichita GIS as they have entered their own yearly service-based contract with Near Mapping.
