RESOLUTION NO. 202 - 2024

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING ACTING COUNTY COURT JUDGES AS ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING OFFICERS

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 19-101a, et seq., as amended, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") is authorized to enact rules and regulations governing the enforcement of County Codes and Resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to appoint an Administrative Hearing Officer to hear and decide appeals relating to the denial, suspension, or revocation of any license authorized by Chapter 17, Article VIII of the Sedgwick County Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to appoint willing present and future County Court judges to serve as Administrative Hearing Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS:

- 1) That for the purposes of Chapter 17, Article VIII, the Board of County Commissioners hereby appoint any consenting, active Sedgwick County Court Judges, both now and in the future, as Administrative Hearing Officers so long as they meet the definition of an Administrative Hearing Officer found in Section 17-503 of the Sedgwick County Code of Ordinances.
- 2) Any individuals appointed pursuant to this Resolution shall subscribe to the oath of office prior to assuming duties.
- 3) The Board of County Commissioners, or an Administrative Hearing Officer themselves, may withdraw the appointment upon providing written notice to the Sedgwick County Clerk.
- 4) The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the Administrative Hearing Officer to be paid \$100 per hearing.
- 5) Sec. 17-508 of the Sedgwick County Code shall hereby be adopted and state as follows:

Sec. 17-508. – Appointment of Administrative Hearing Officers.

- (a) For the purposes of this Chapter 17, Article VIII, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County have appointed any consenting, active Sedgwick County Court Judge to serve and perform the functions of an Administrative Hearing Officer, as may be required.
- (b) Provided however, any said consenting, active Sedgwick County Court Judge must subscribe to the oath of office prior to assuming any such duties.
- (c) The Board of County Commissioners, or an Administrative Hearing Officer themselves, may withdraw the appointment upon providing written notice to the Sedgwick County Clerk.
- 6) This Resolution shall take effect upon its publication in the official County newspaper.
