During the process, you will be able to customize your involvement by choosing how often you would like to be matched with a family in your community who has requested a meal (weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, or "just this once"), how far you are willing to drive to deliver the meal ('as the crow flies') and if you are able to accommodate any dietary restrictions or allergies.

Once all of your information is confirmed, you will be put into our system for the next round of matching which occurs at the beginning of each week. If/when, you are matched with a family; you will get some basic information such as the name of the person who requested the meal, address, phone number and the number of adults and children in the household to give you some insight into who you would be helping. You will then contact the family to schedule a contactless delivery, setting a date and time within a week of the match.

It is your responsibility to ensure that community service verification forms are accurately filled out, completed and signed at an approved nonprofit organization and returned to the Diversion Office.

### **What is a Nonprofit 501(c) (3) Organization?**

Being a nonprofit organization means that the agency provides a social service to the community and only makes enough money to cover the costs of staying in business and they are tax exempt.

**Section 501(c) (3)** is the portion of the US Internal Revenue Code that allows for federal tax exemption of nonprofit organizations, specifically those that are considered public charities, private foundations or private operating foundations. It is regulated and administered by the US Department of Treasury through the IRS.
