Sedgwick County Project 2025 BM Overlays (R175-E) will result in a 2" asphalt overlay on approximately 10.5 miles of roadway in Sedgwick County. The overlay increases the structural cross section of the road and provides an improved wearing surface for the traveling public.

Pearson Construction, LLC is a well-known contractor to Public Works and has successfully worked on many past county projects.
