Measles Alert: What to Do if You Experience Symptoms

The measles virus can be serious and can easily infect people who are unvaccinated. The measles virus spreads through the air when an infected person coughs or sneezes; it can stay in the air for up to two hours after an infected person leaves.

If you are experiencing symptoms of measles, including a high fever, cough, runny nose, red eyes, and a characteristic measles rash, **please follow these steps**:

1. **Call Your Healthcare Provider as soon as possible.** It is important that you do not visit your healthcare provider without calling first for additional guidance.

If you do not have a healthcare provider:

a. Call a Community Health Center for guidance (see page 2). They can provide care based on what you can afford to pay.

AND

- b. Call the Sedgwick County Health Department's **Measles Line** at **316-660-5558** and leave a message. A staff member will call you back by the next business day to provide additional guidance.
- 2. **Stay away from other people and wear a mask**. If you need to go out in public or be around others, wear a mask to help prevent the spread of measles.

If you are having difficulty breathing or experiencing severe respiratory distress, please call 911 immediately.

Stay safe and seek medical attention promptly to protect yourself and others.
