## **2026 Overall Budget Goals**

- Correct any structural imbalance of recurring costs and bring in a balanced budget.
- Continue emphasis on staffing stability regarding reasonable compensation and benefits for employees.
- Prioritize mission-critical county services, and look for service improvements in those areas.
- Do NOT capture all available valuation increases and reduce the county mill levy again in the upcoming year.

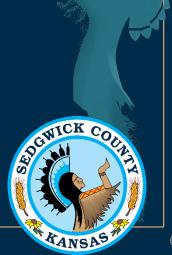
## **State of Operations**

- Improved staffing looking for balance
- Continued increased cost of doing business
- Several major projects and community issues in the forefront
- \$2.2 million forecasted structural imbalance at the start of budget process



## **BALANCE THE BUDGET:**

- Decrease crime prevention funds and culture/arts/entertainment subsidies by \$560,000
- Cut KPTS programming (\$80,000)
- Transition COMCARE property tax-funded items to CCBHC (revenue) funding; redirects \$366,000
- Increase revenue projections by \$300,000 due to stronger growth in certain key areas
- Raise valuation capture from 5.0 to 5.5% (\$950,000)



## STAFFING STABILITY AND COMPENSATION:

- General Pay Plan, 911, Corrections, COMCARE, DA all receiving
   3% pay adjustment plus 1% scale movement
- EMS 3% step plus 1% scale movement
- Sheriff 5% step plus 1% scale movement
- Fire 3% step adjustments



## MISSION CRITICAL COUNTY SERVICES

- 20 additional positions for Emergency Communications (911)
- Accreditation Position added for 911; other items
- Seven Engagement Care Specialists to COMCARE (CCBHC funding)



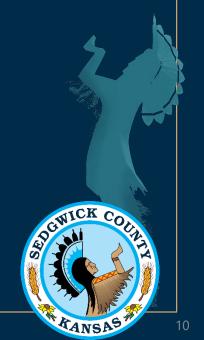
## **COUNTY SERVICE IMPROVEMENTS**

- Part-time position in Strategic Communications
- Two elephant keeper positions at Sedgwick County Zoo



## VALUATION CAPTURE AND MILL LEVY REDUCTION

- Capture 5.5% of the available 8.6% assessed value growth
- Reduce County levy by more than 2/3 of a mill; Fire by 1/4 of a mill
- **Do NOT fund additional \$10 million** in department requests made through the budget process



## **FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE**

- \$10.3 million for drainage projects and infrastructure repair to taxpayer owned facilities.
- \$24.9 million for road and bridge projects countywide

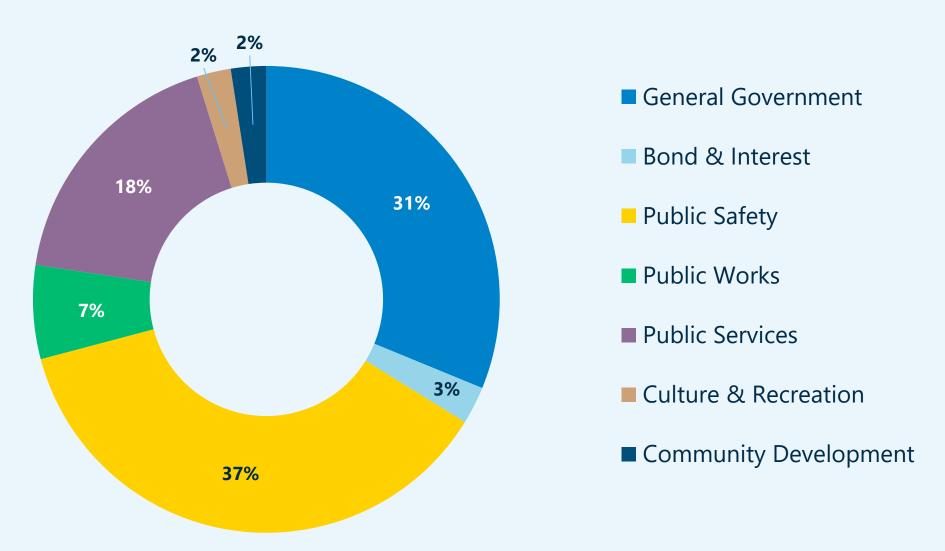
