

Access My Immunization Record

Access your record electronically within minutes using the secure online KSWebIZ Public Portal at: myvaccinerecord.ks.gov





Visit the KSWebIZ Public Portal link above or scan the QR Code with your smart phone and:

- Select who the request is for by selecting me or dependent.
- Enter your or your minor (age 0 through 17 years) child's name, date of birth, and gender.
- Mobile phone number or email address used when vaccinated.



Security and protection of patient records is very important. The KSWebIZ Public Portal uses two-factor authentication. When you enter your information and a match is found in KSWebIZ, you will be texted or emailed a code to enter and confirm your identity before you can access the record.



KSWebIZ Public Portal is a free service by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment Immunization Program. This is an official record of immunizations received in Kansas that can be saved or printed. This record can be used as proof of immunizations for daycare, school, camp, work, travel, etc.



When using the KSWebIZ Public Portal to access your (or your minor child's) immunization record, information entered must be an exact match with the KS Immunization Information System (KSWebIZ). Immunization records printed from the KSWebIZ Public Portal may not be complete. The records include what has been reported to KSWebIZ.
