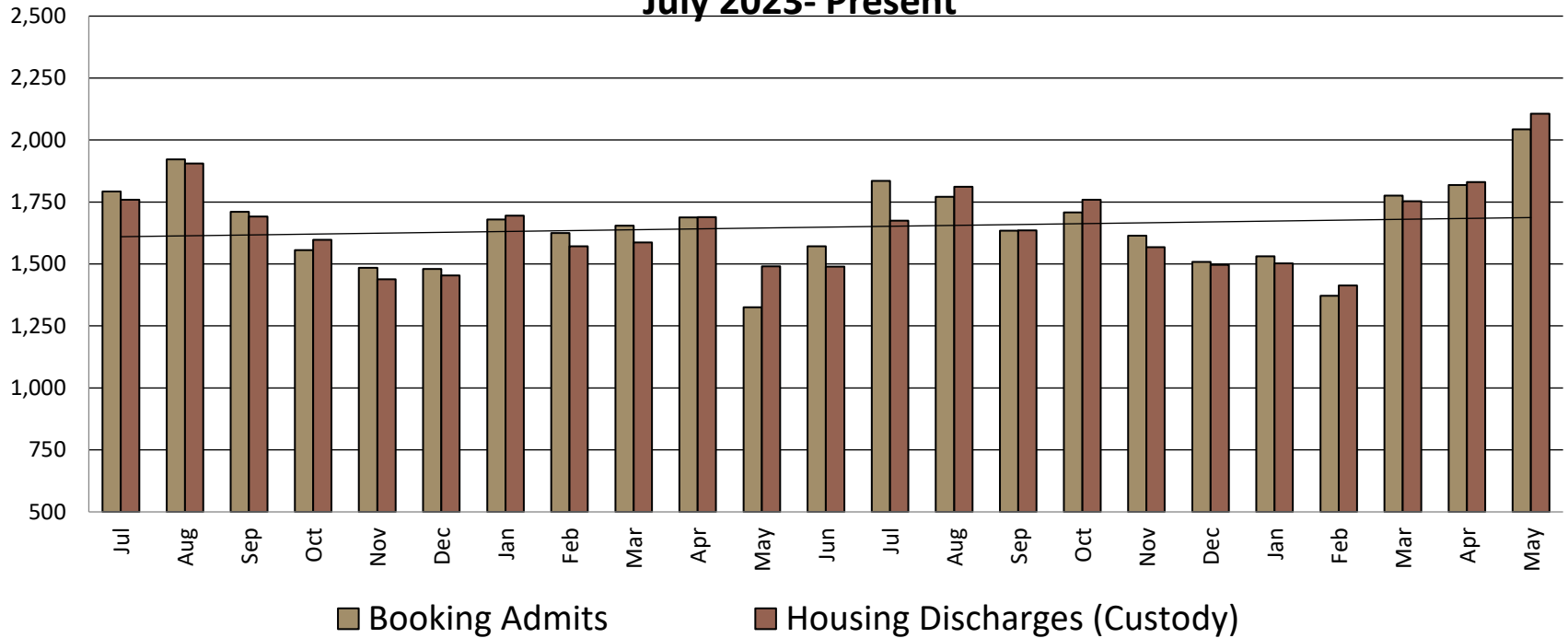

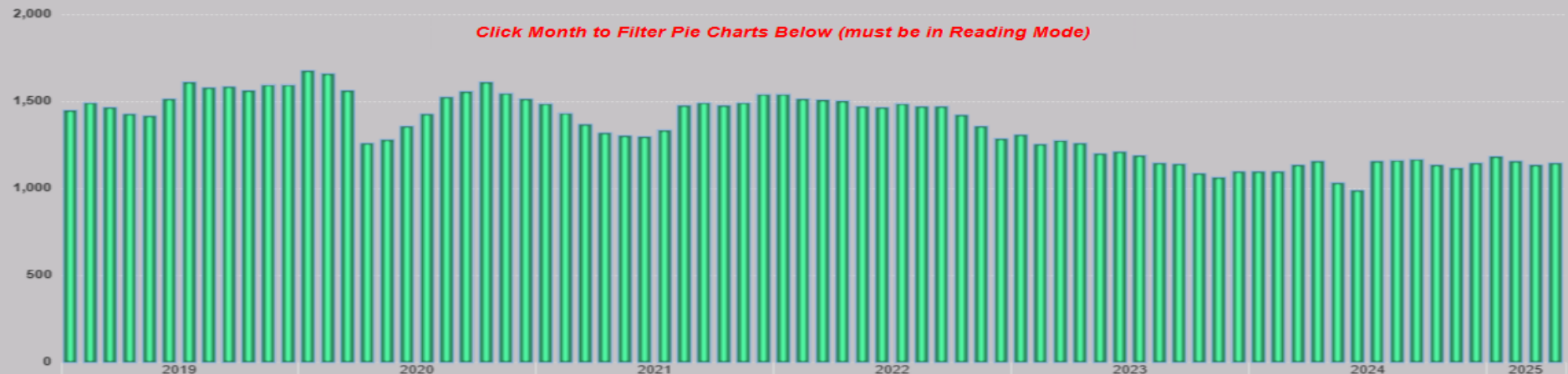

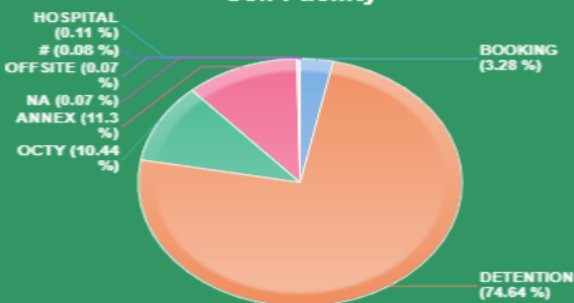

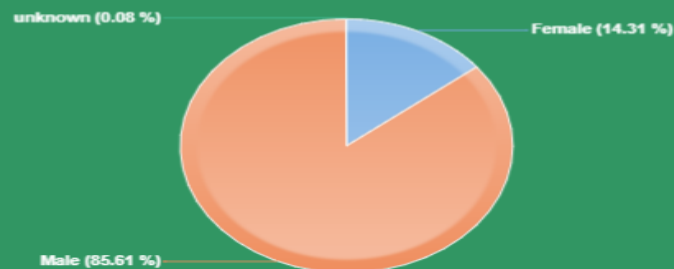

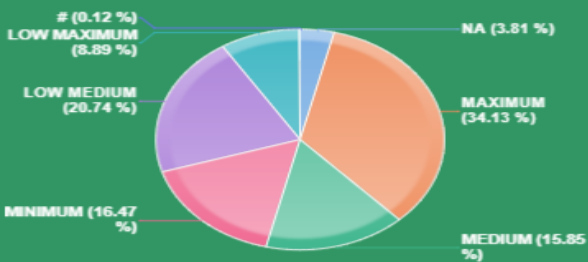

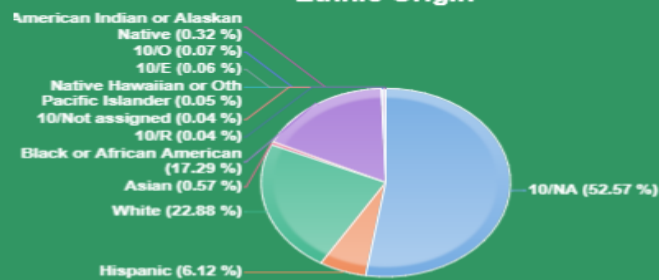

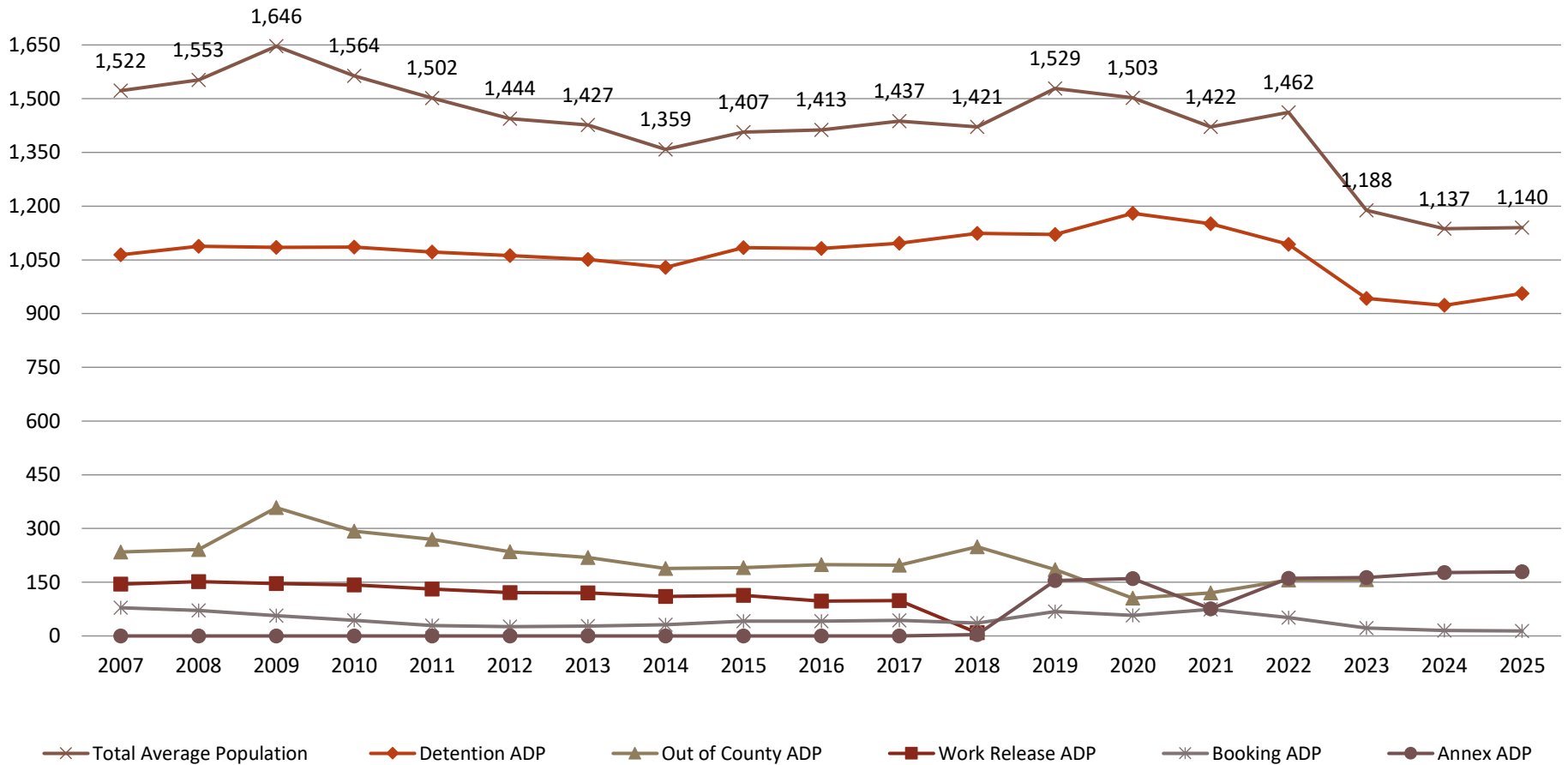

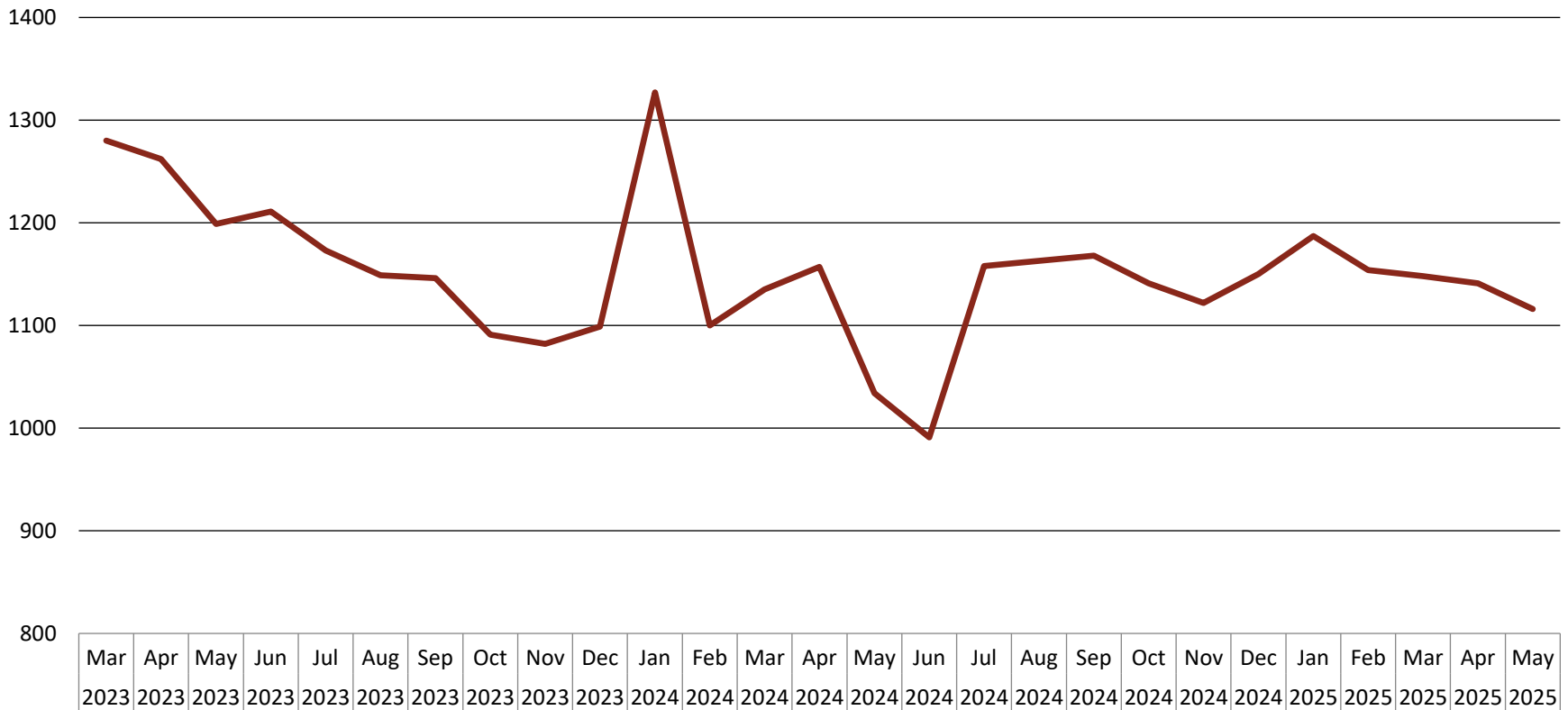

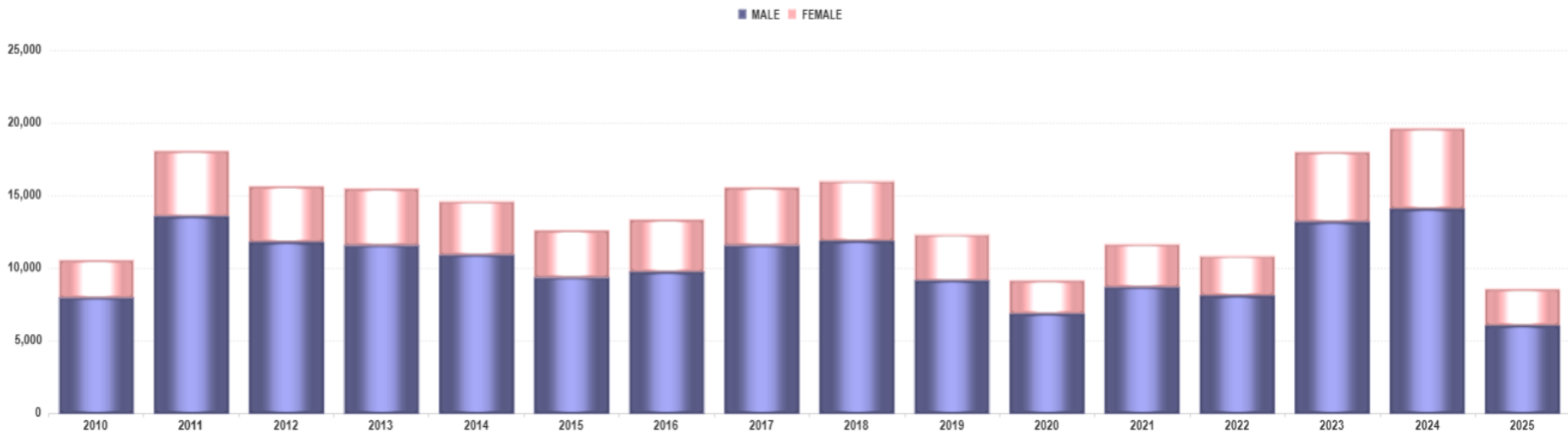

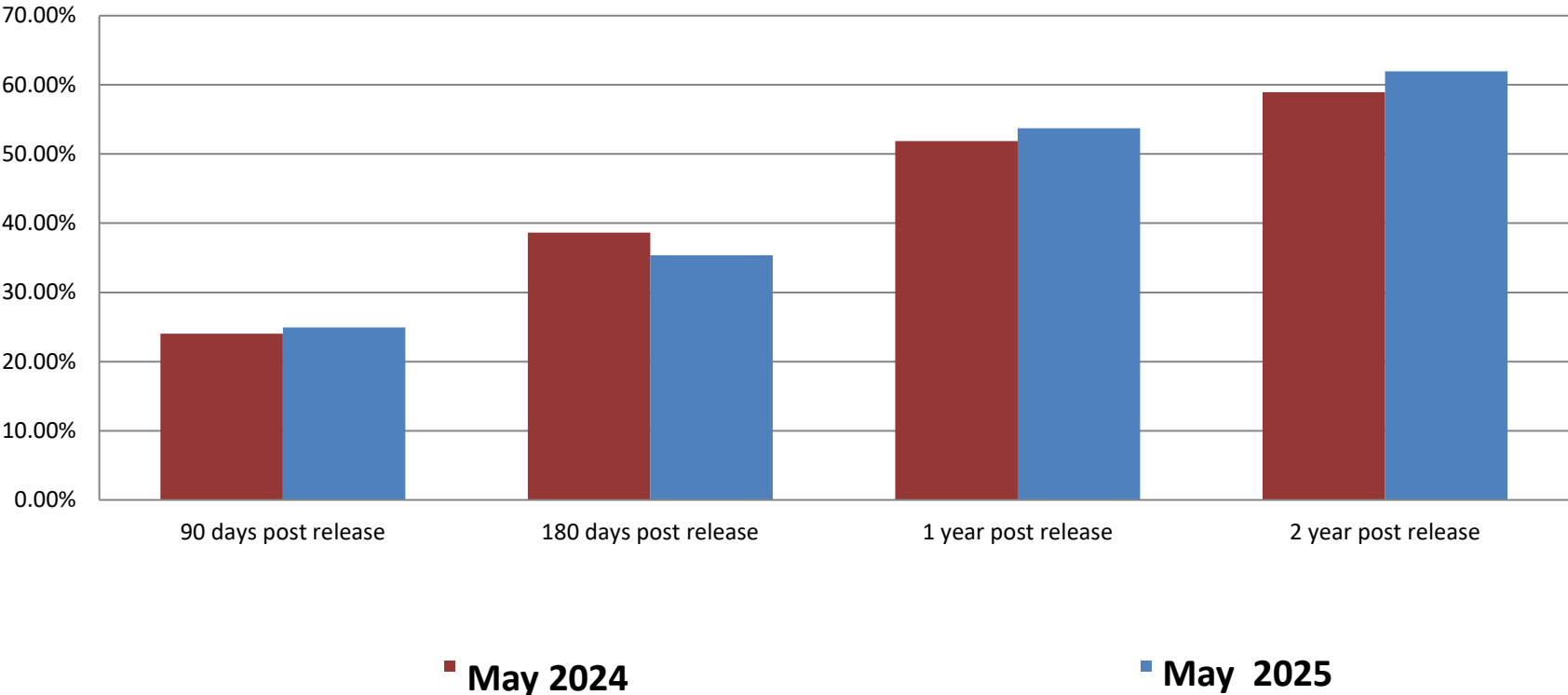

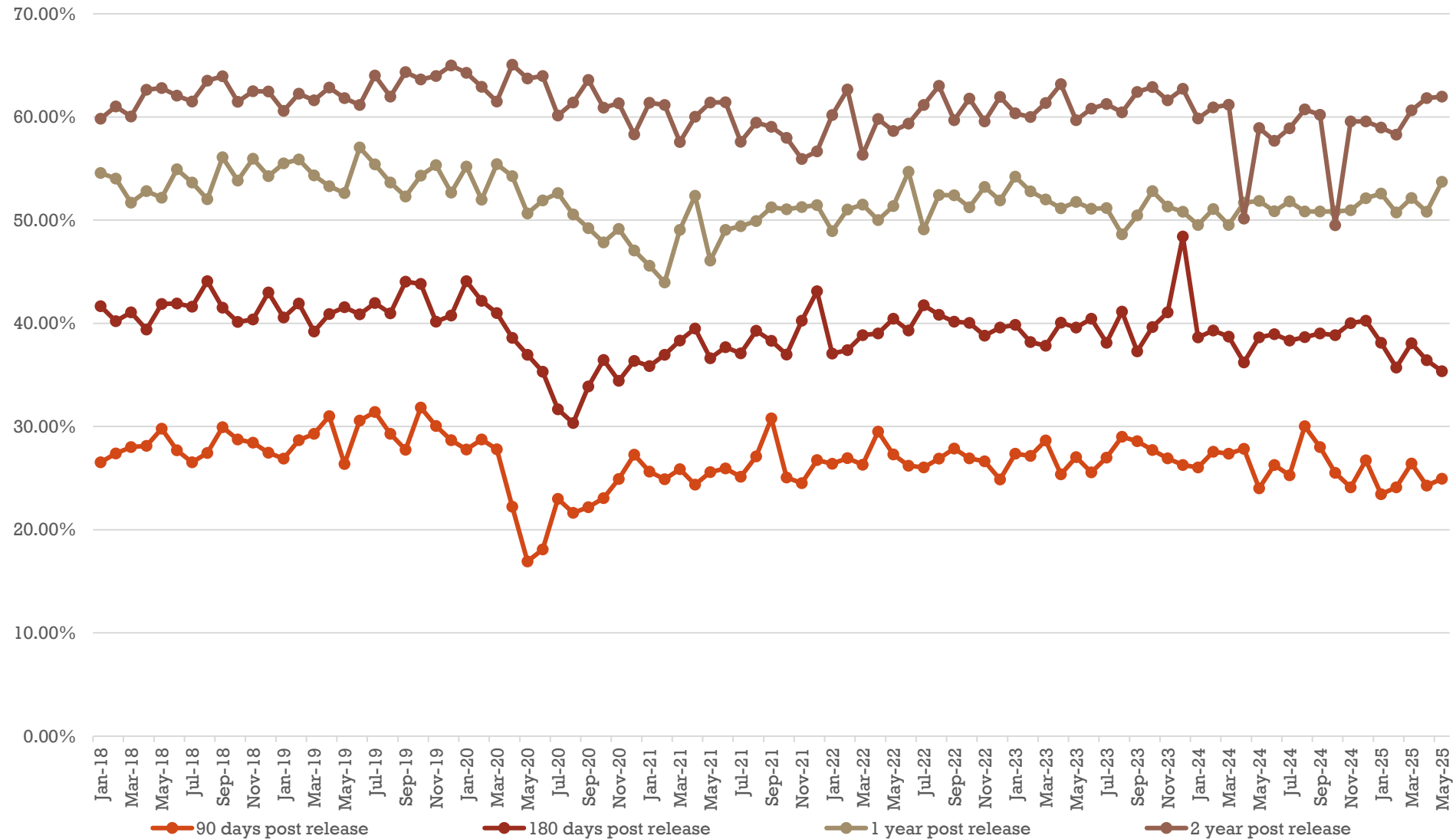


Percent of Released Inmates Rearrested

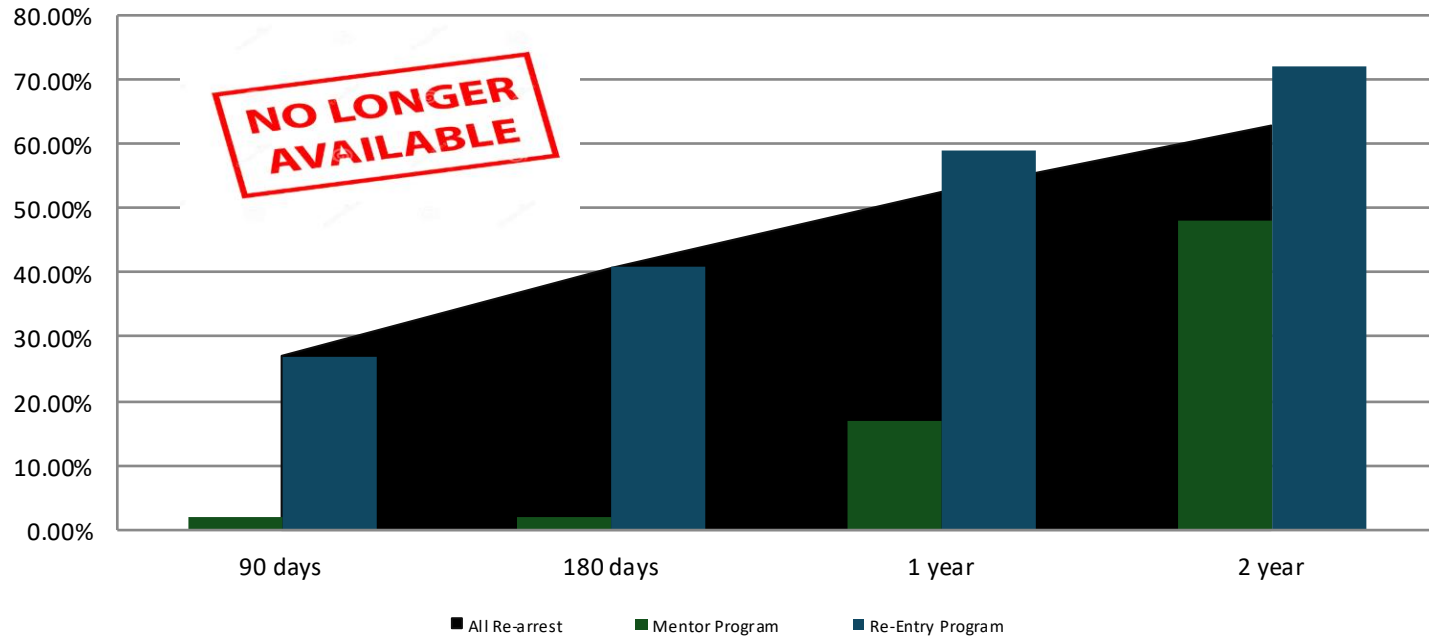

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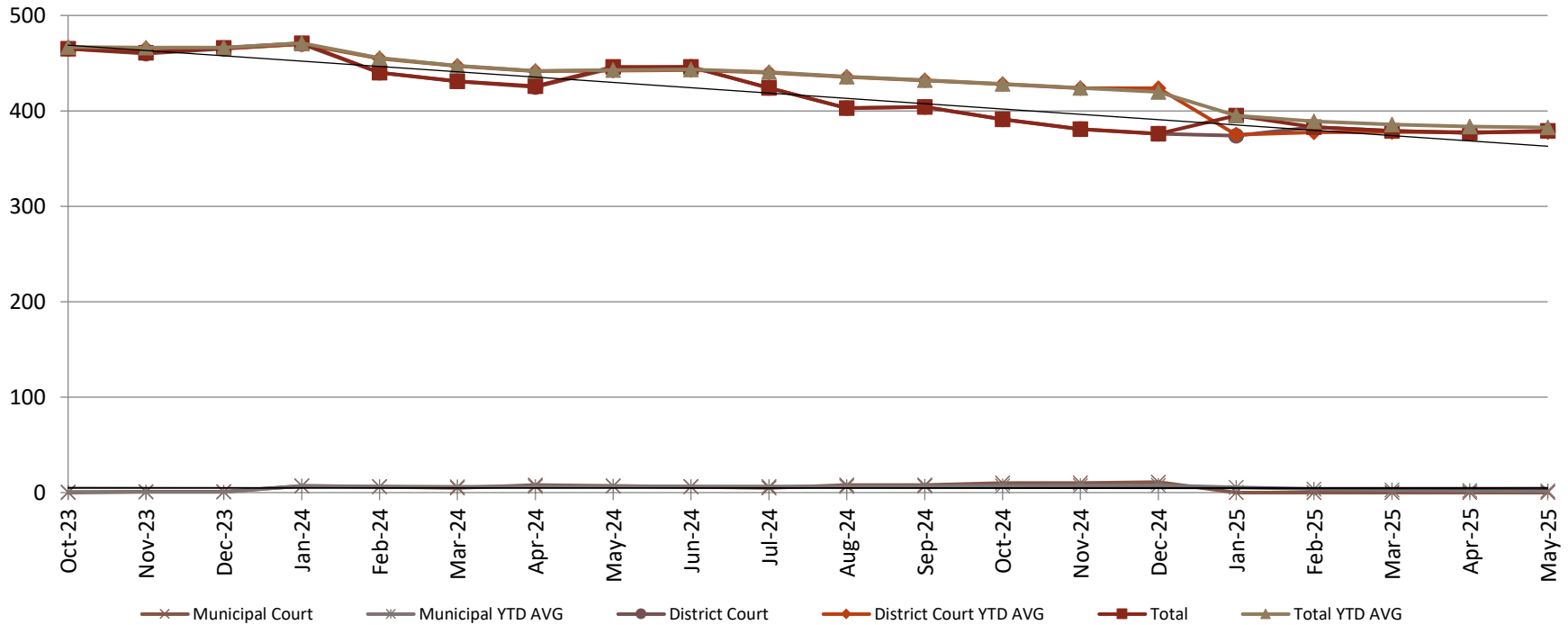

Pretrial Services Program (PSP) Monthly ADP: May 2023 - present

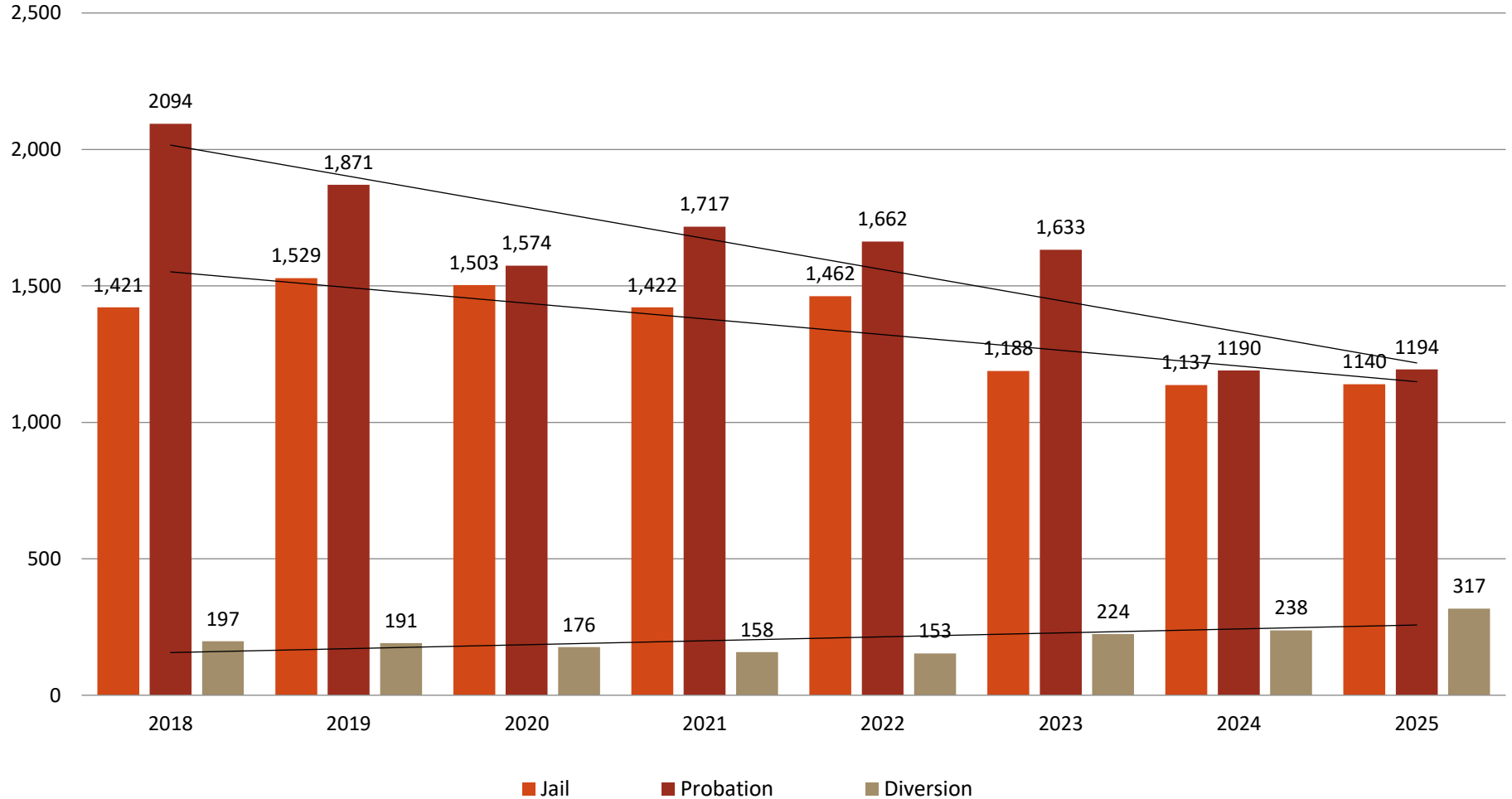

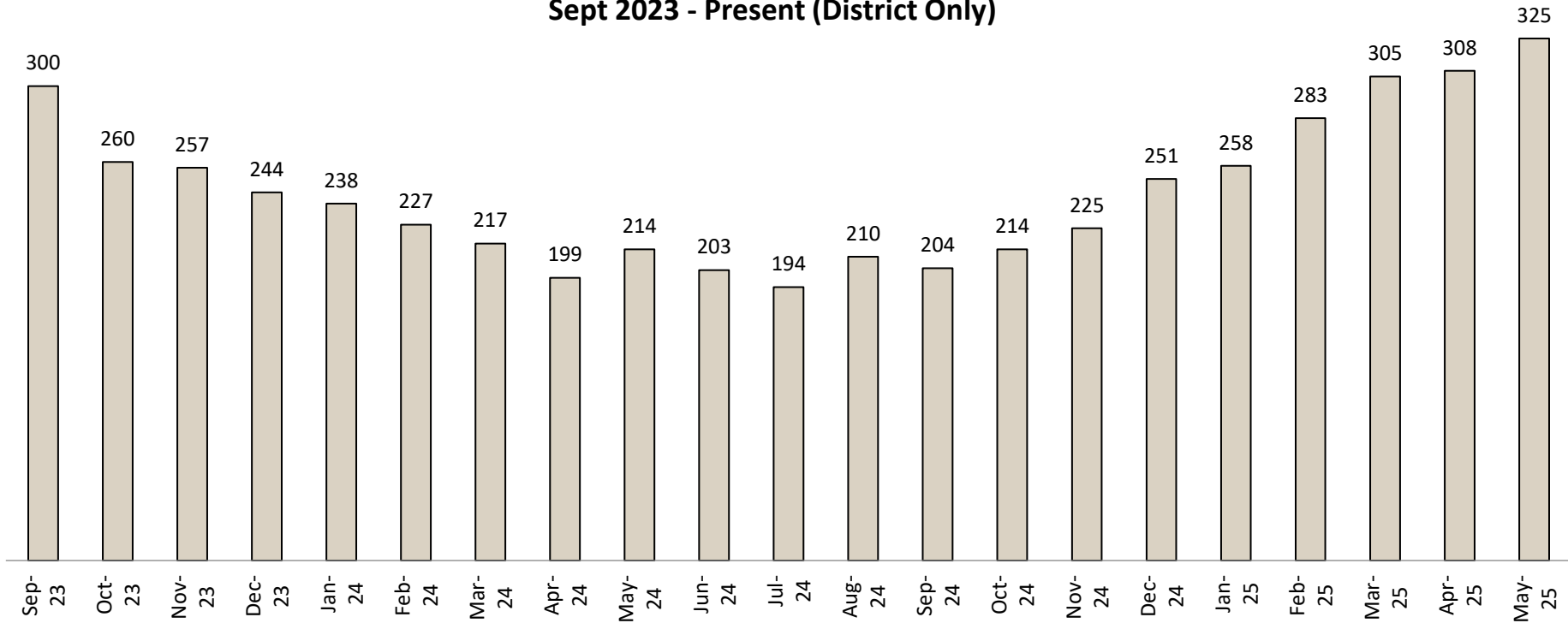

Total Annual ADP: 2018 - present



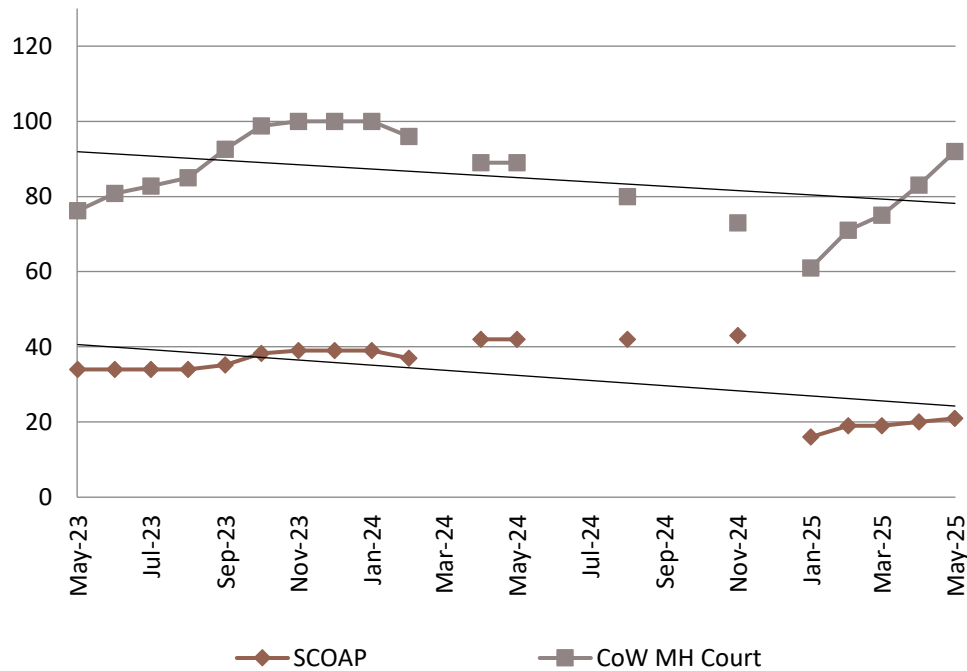
Diversion - Active Caseload

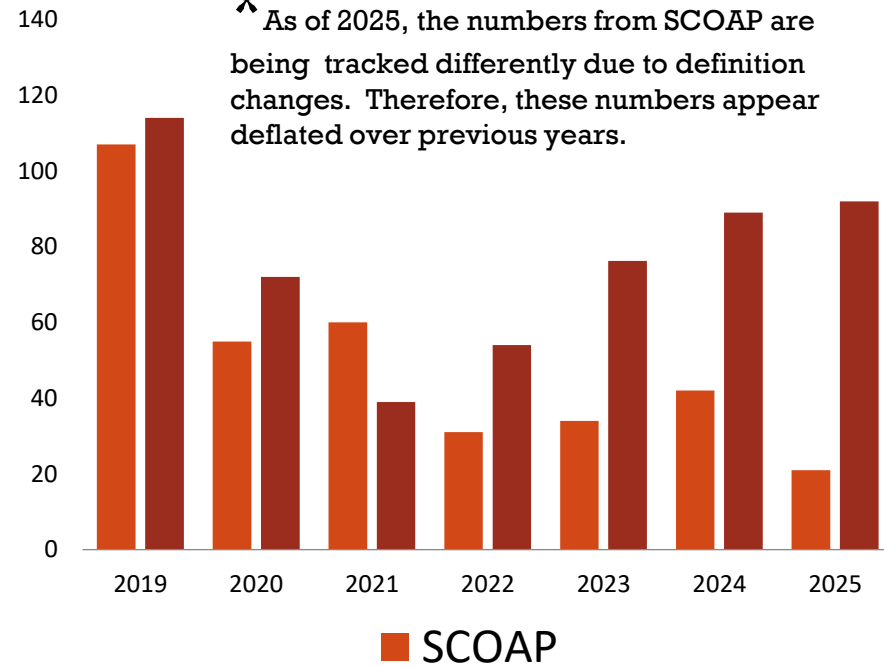
Mental Health - ADP May 2023- present

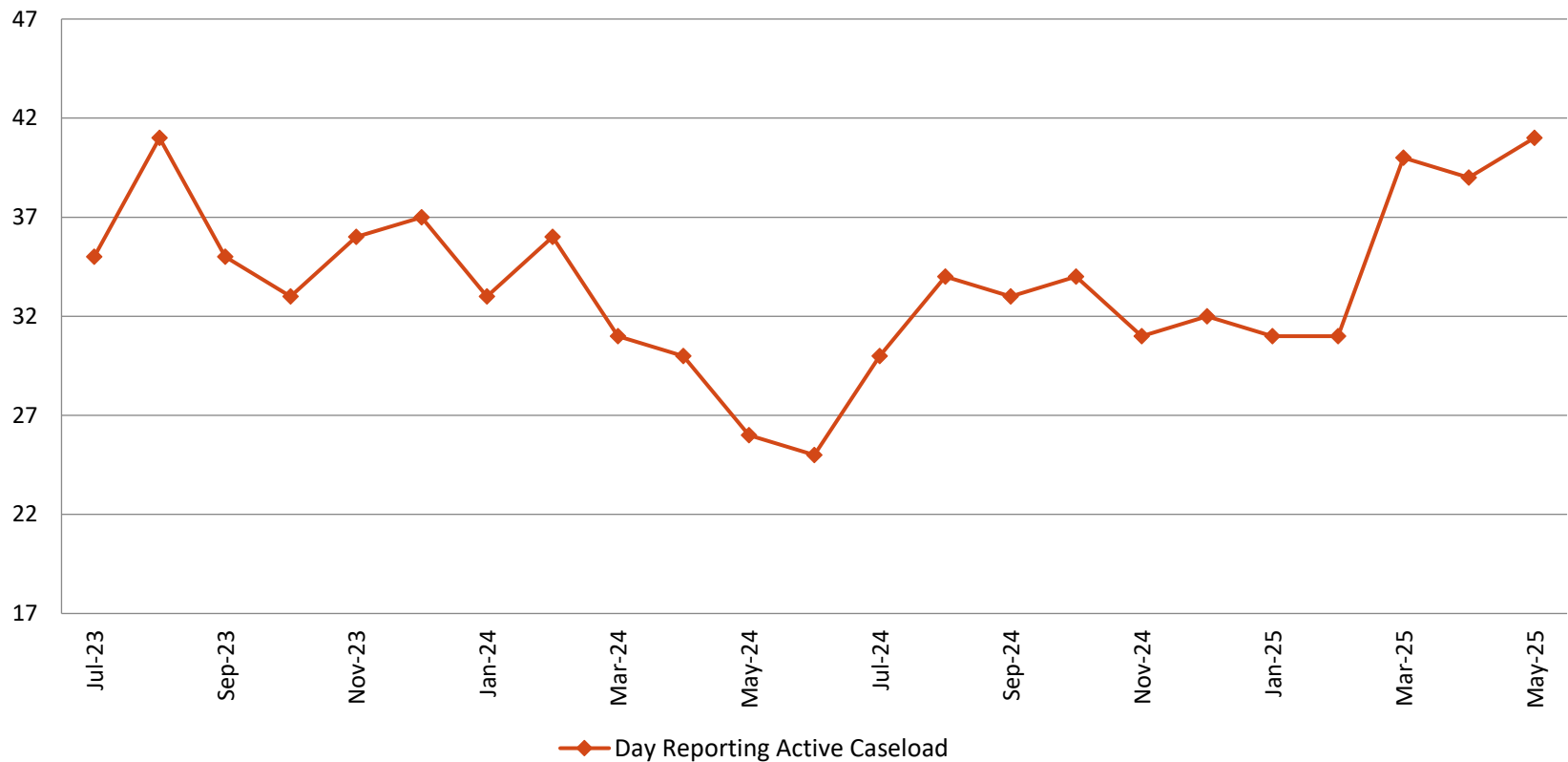

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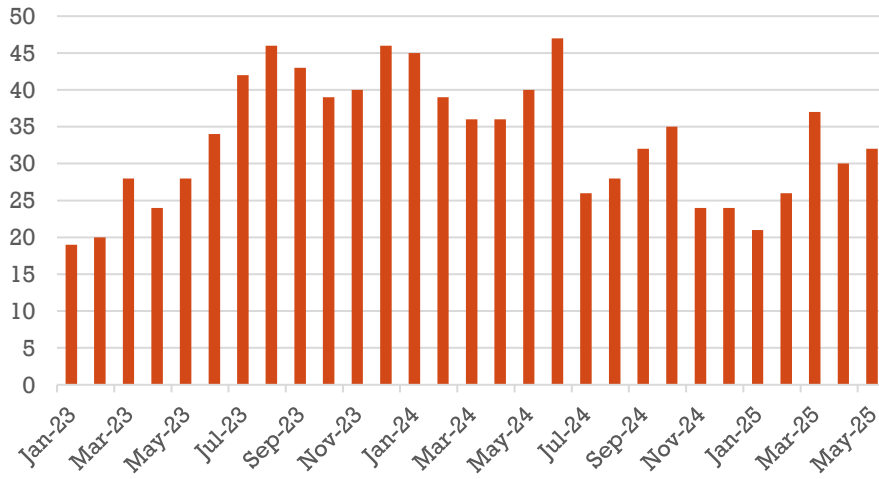
Day Reporting - Active Caseload Jan 2023- present



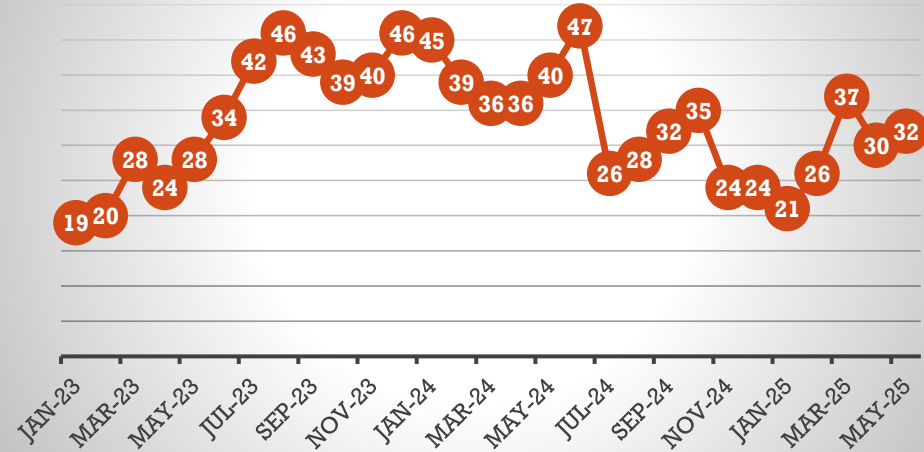

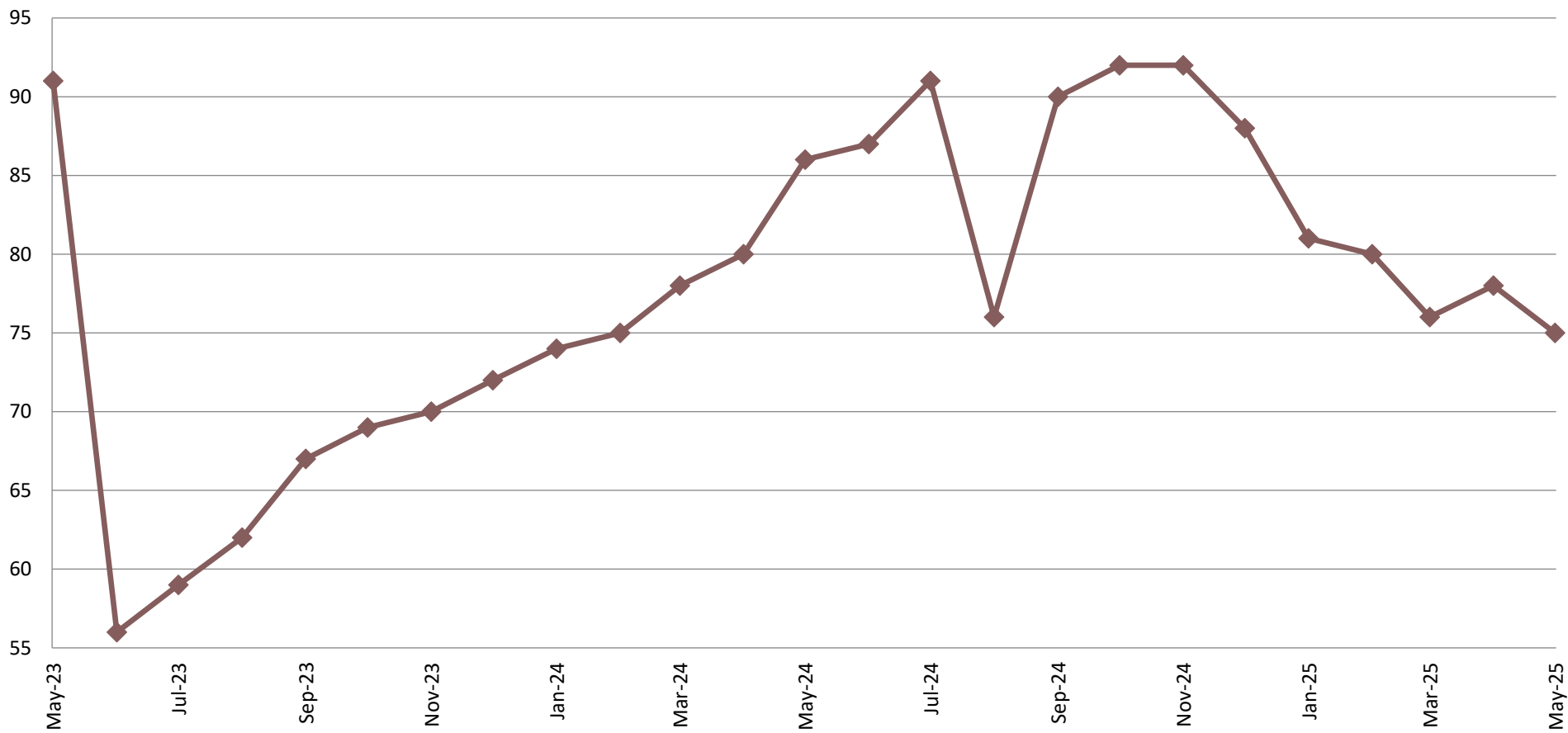

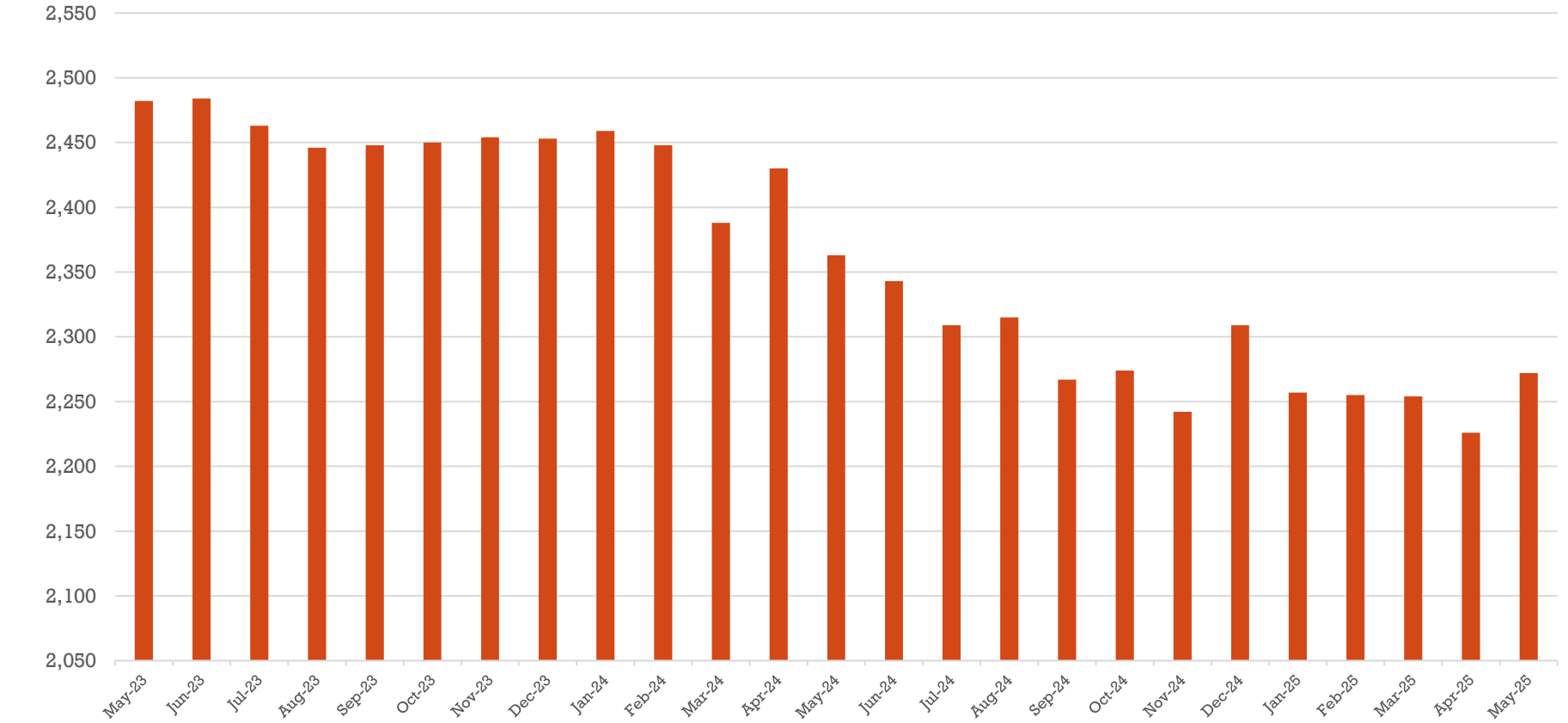
District Court Probation: Pre-Sentence Investigation 2023- present

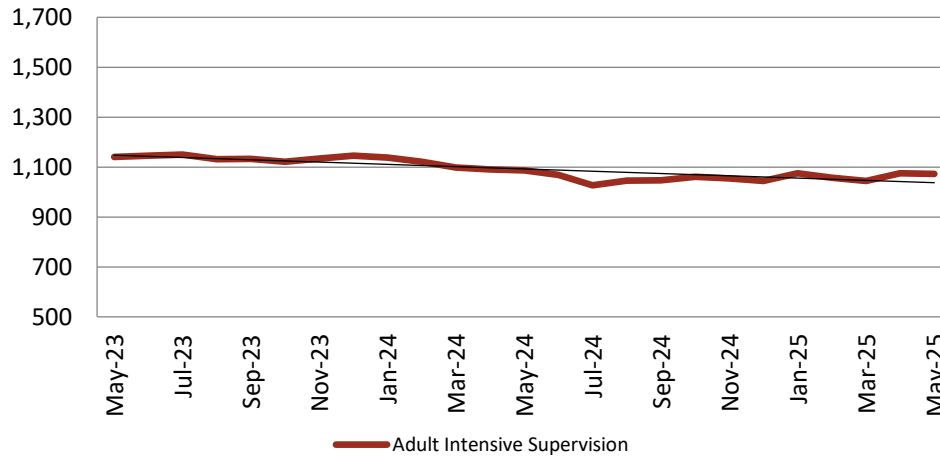

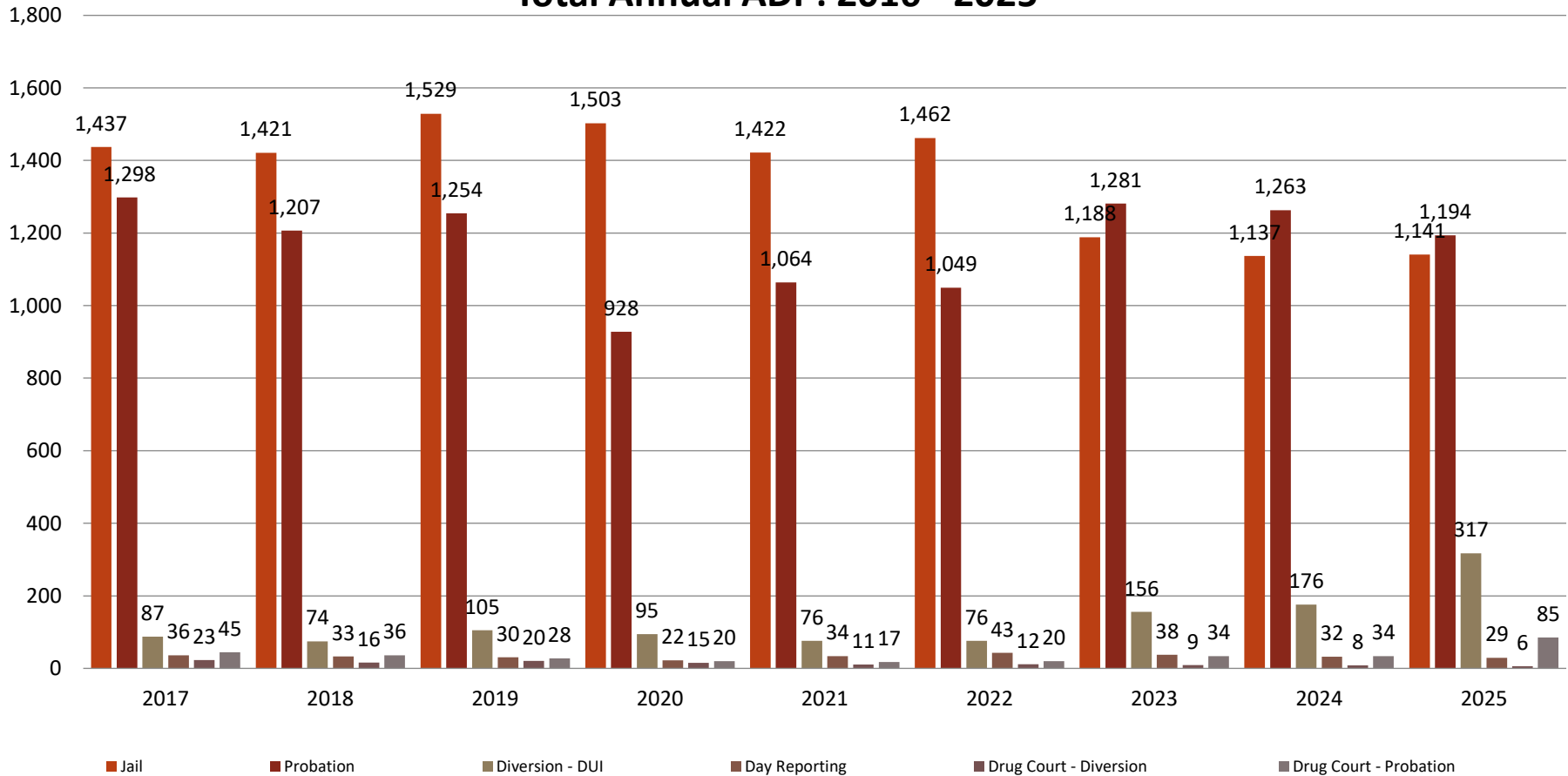

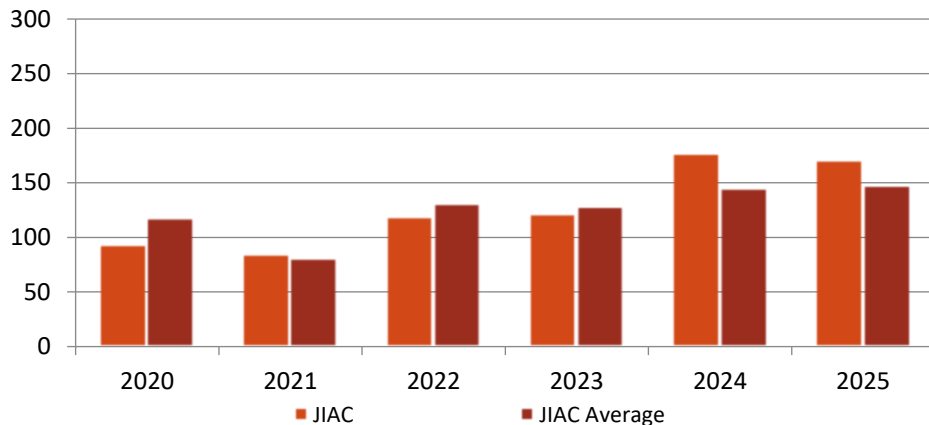

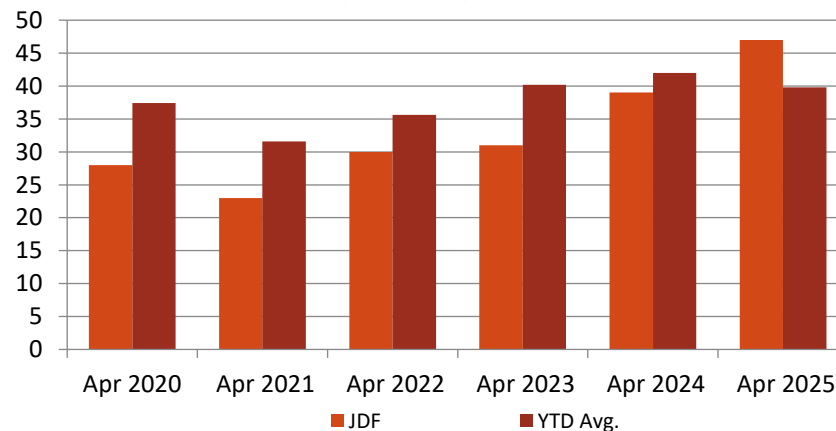

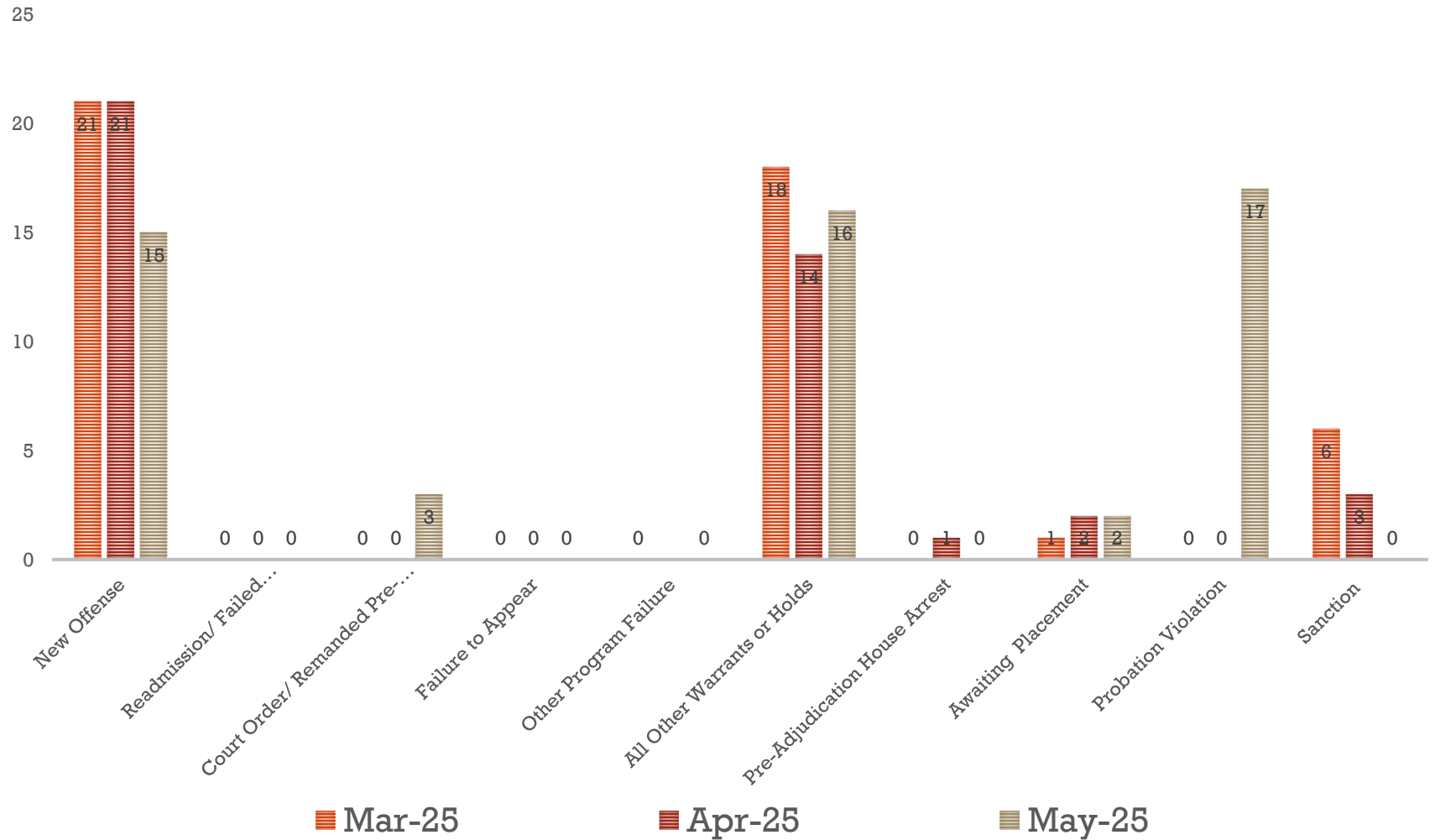
