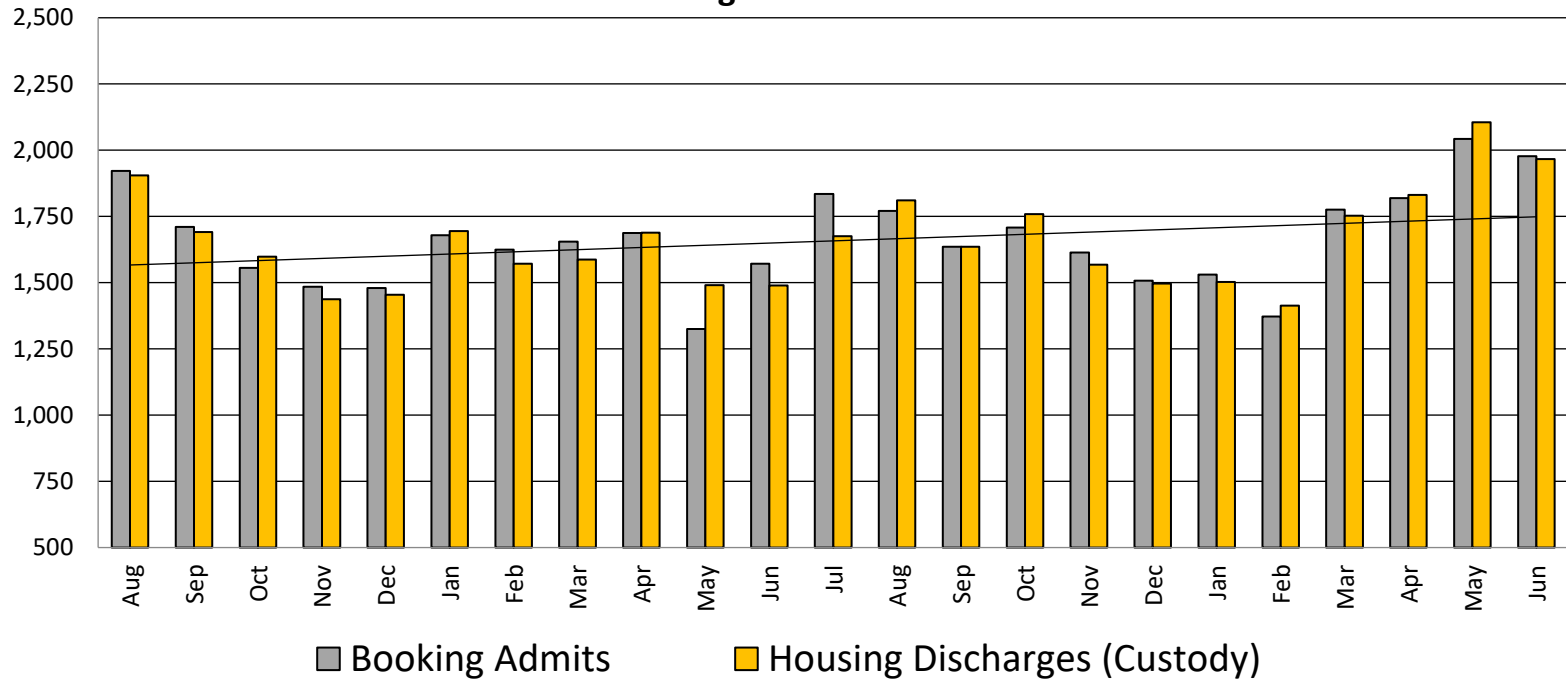

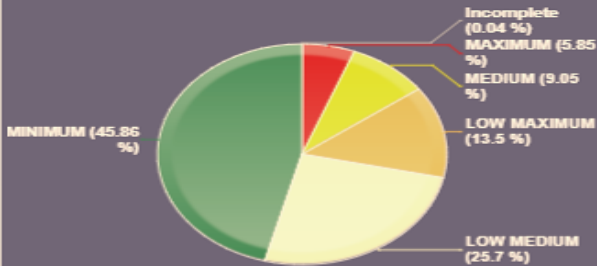

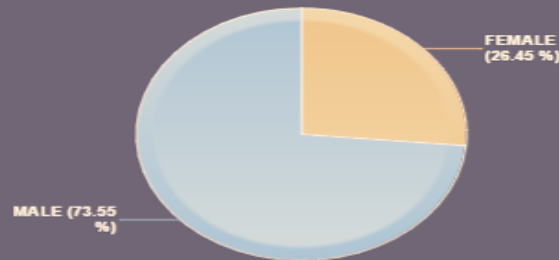

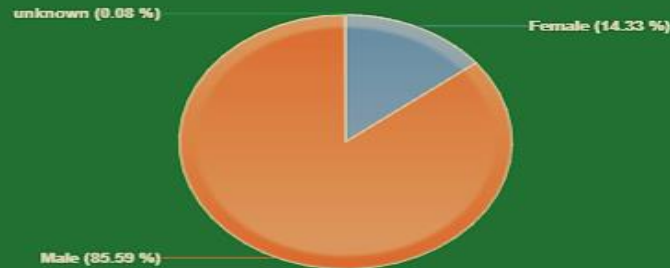

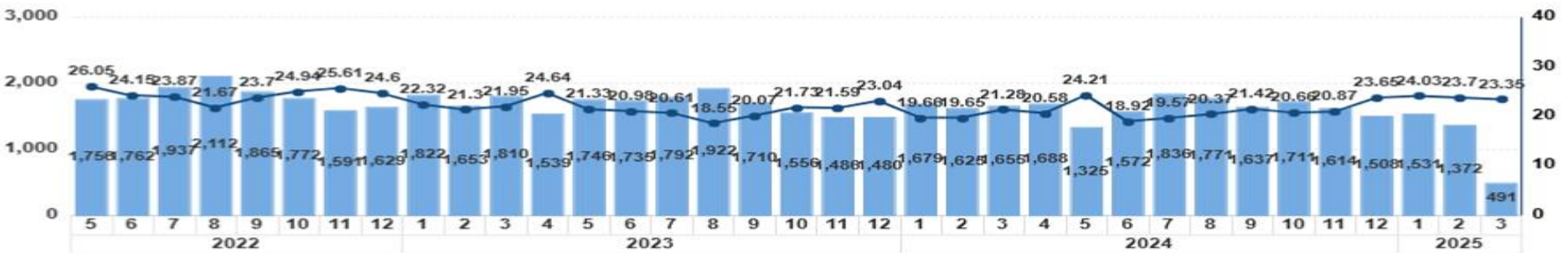
Booking Count and ALOS by Calendar year

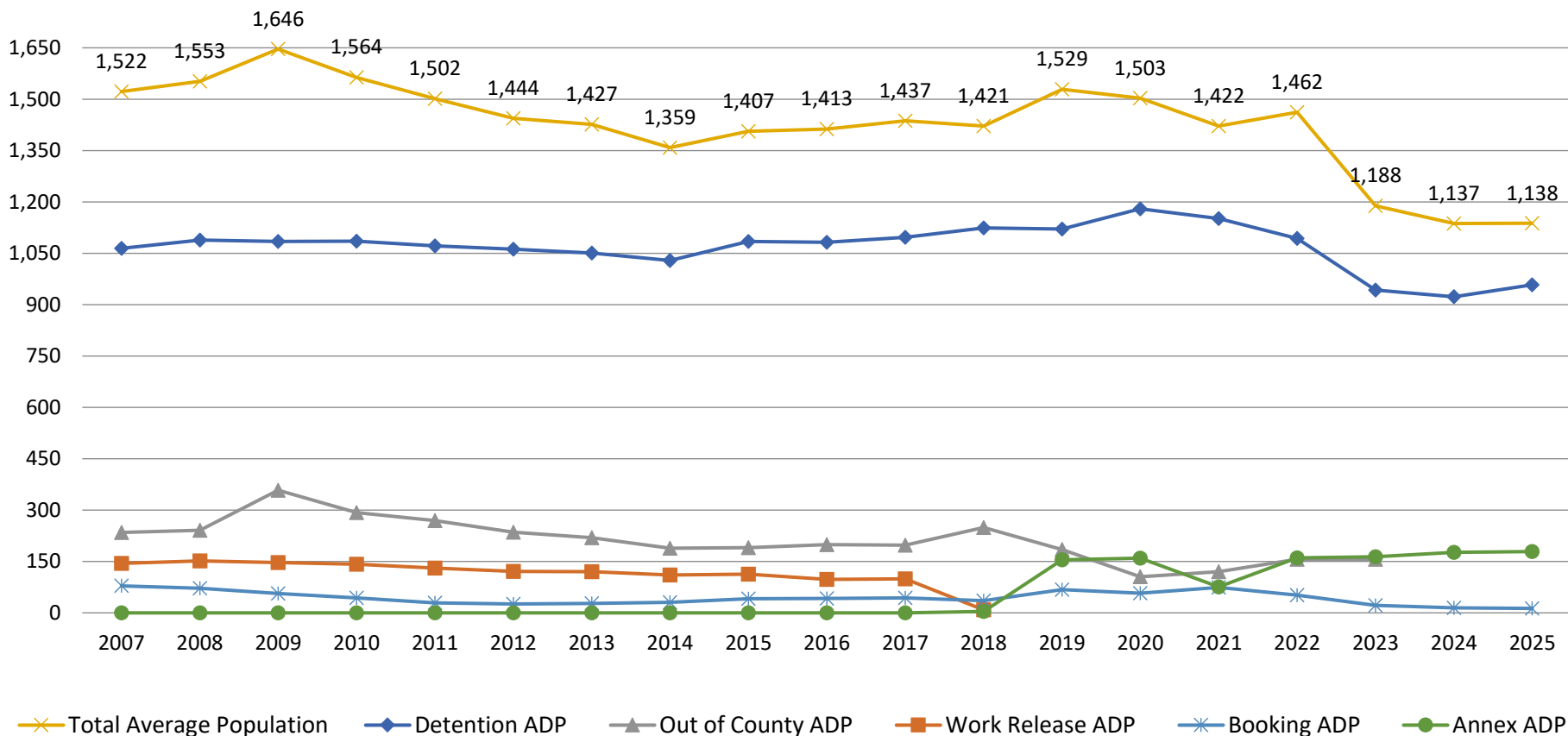

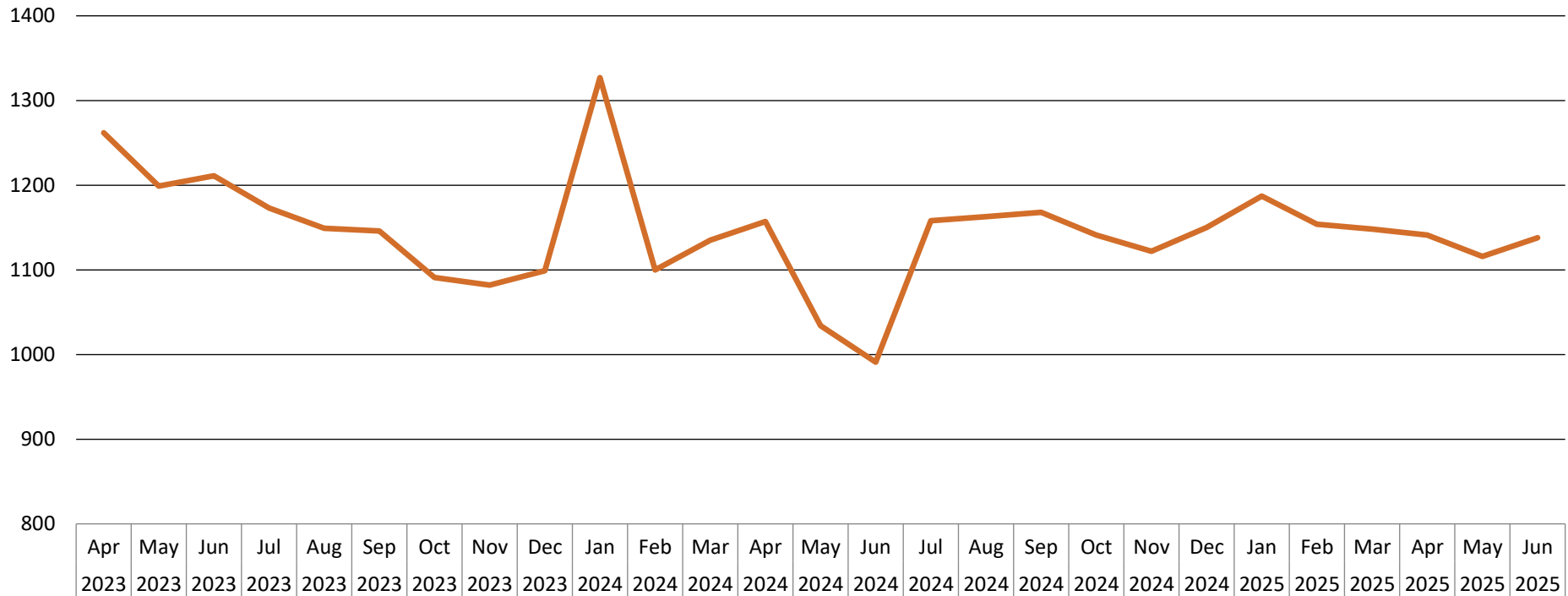

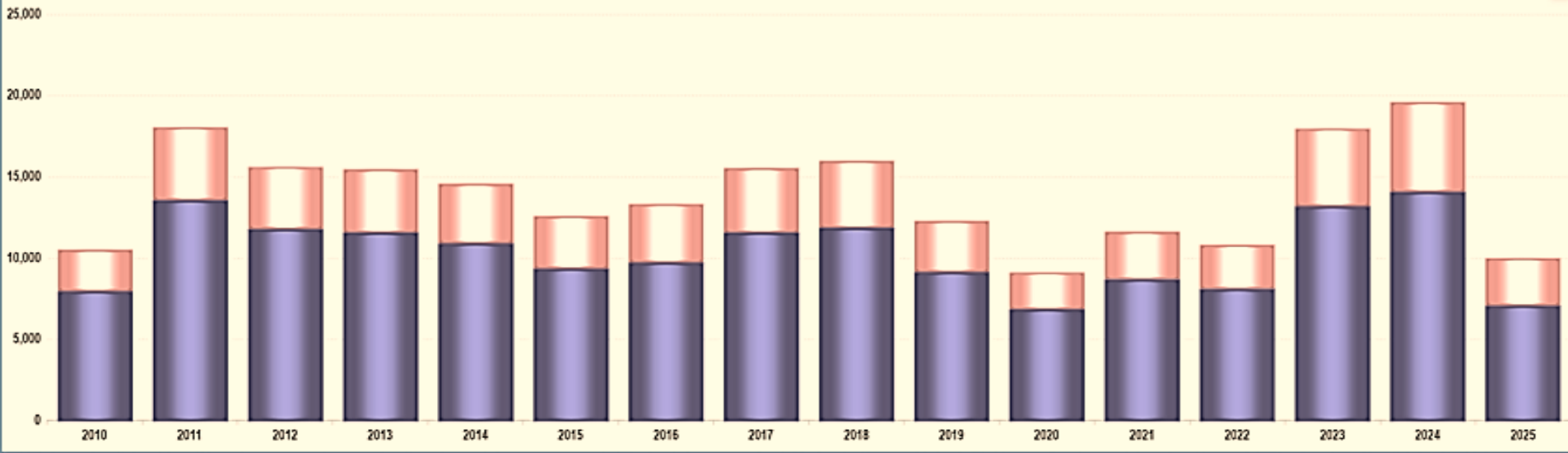

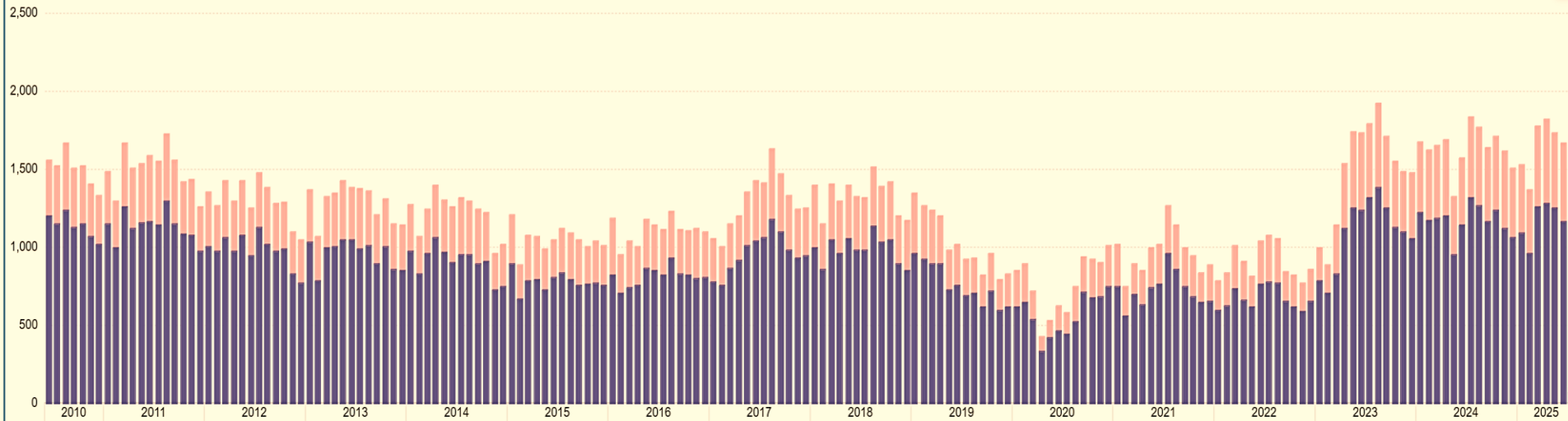
Booking by Year

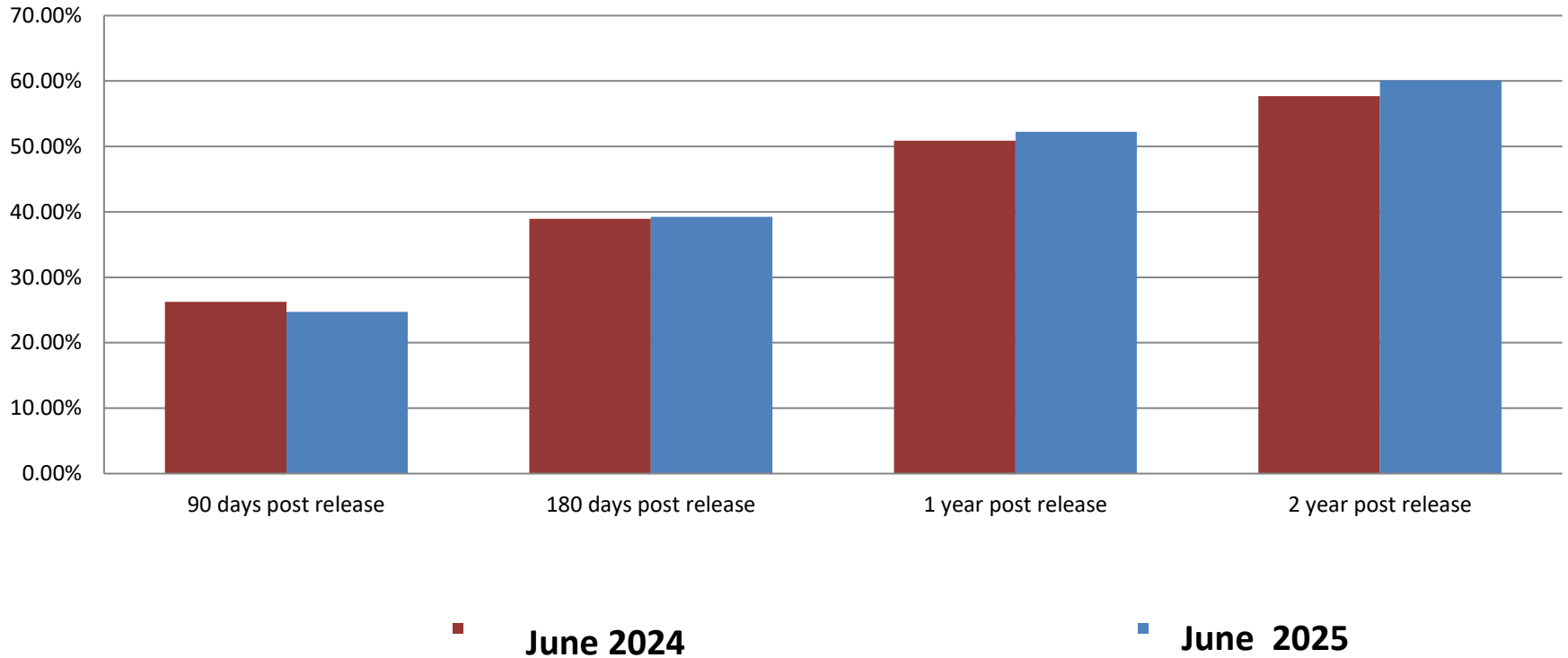

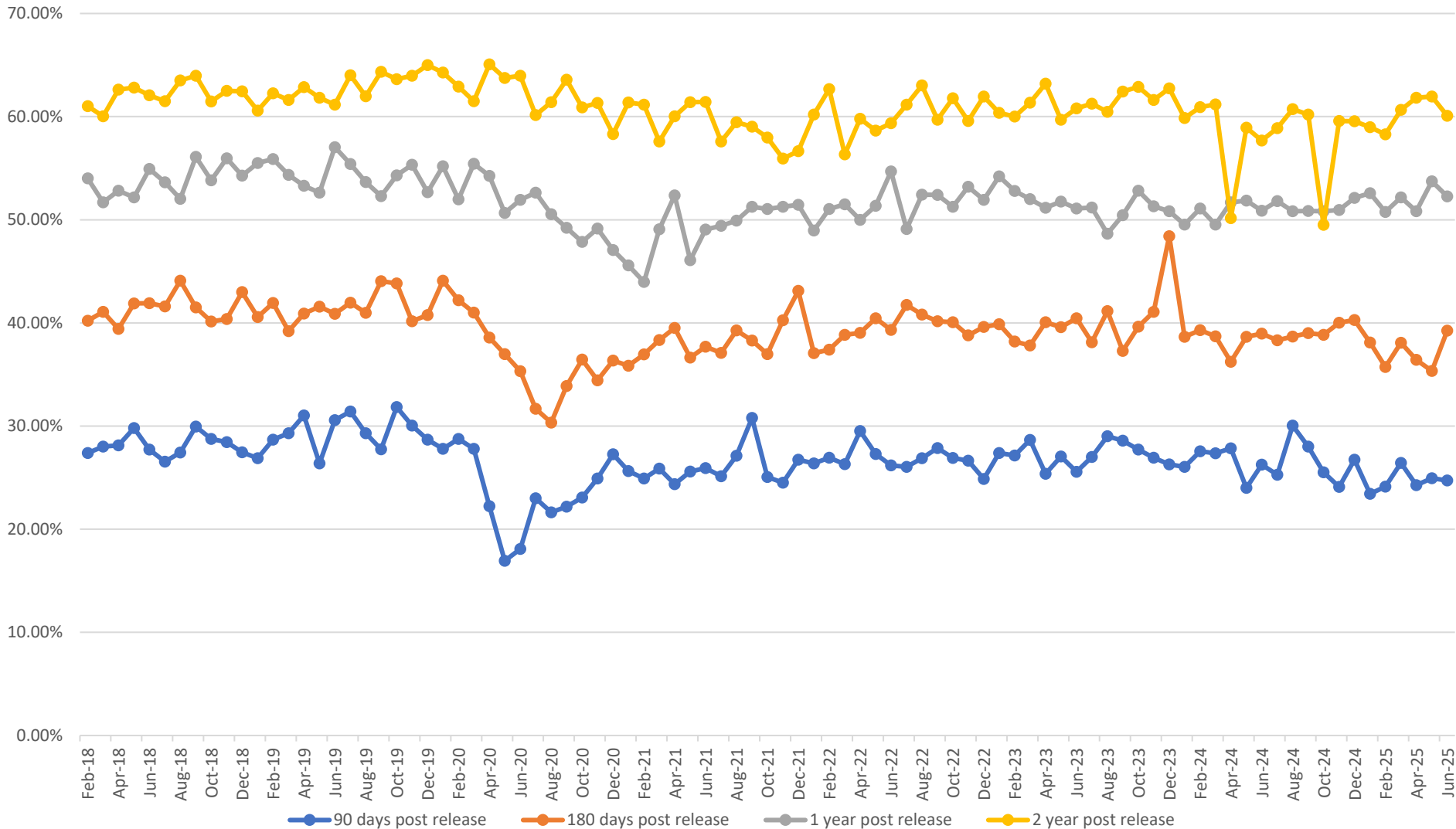
Percent of Released Inmates Rearrested June 2024 and 2025



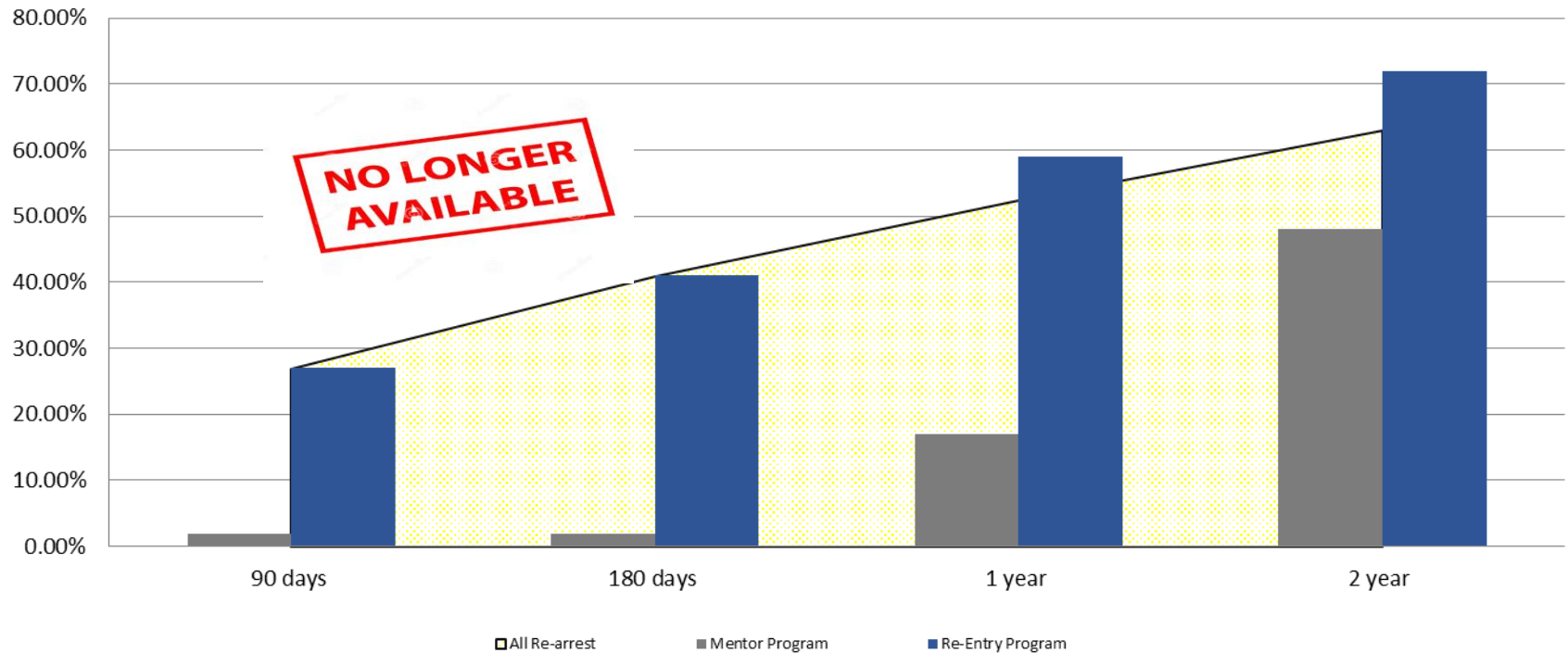

Recidivism 2018 - Present



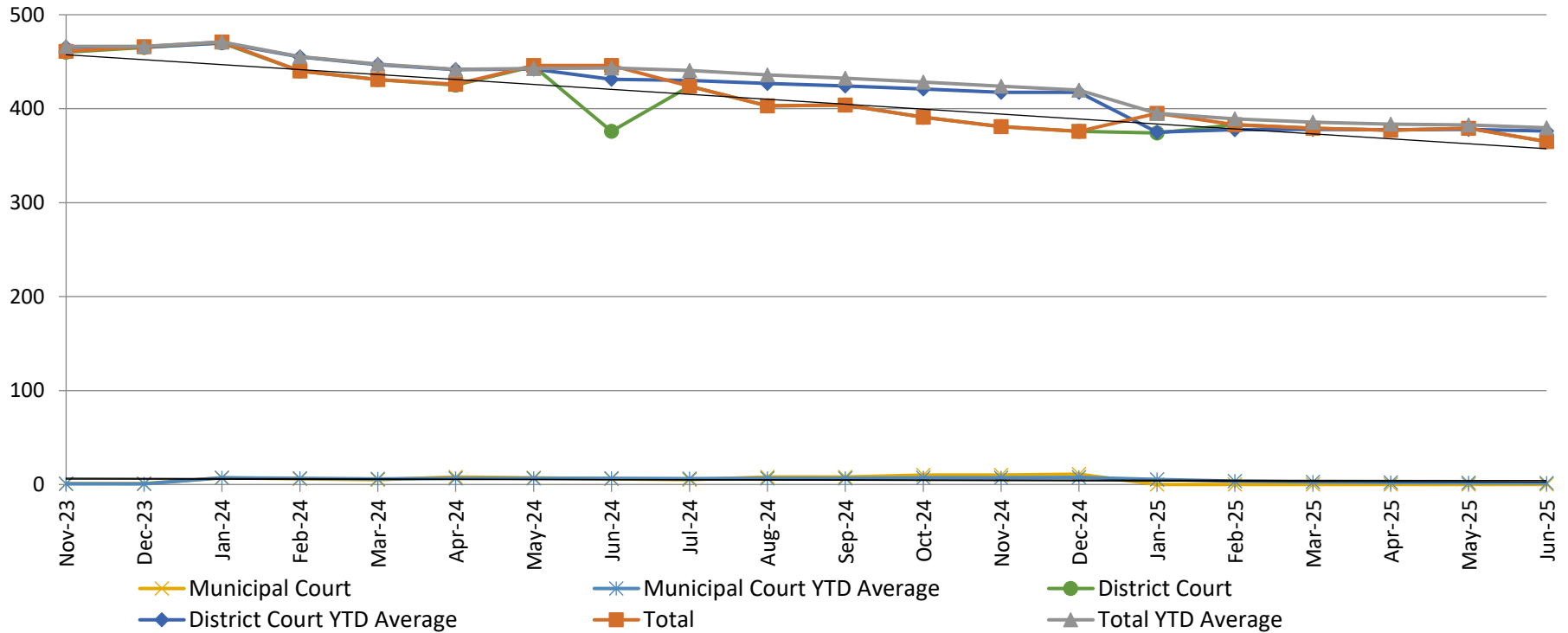

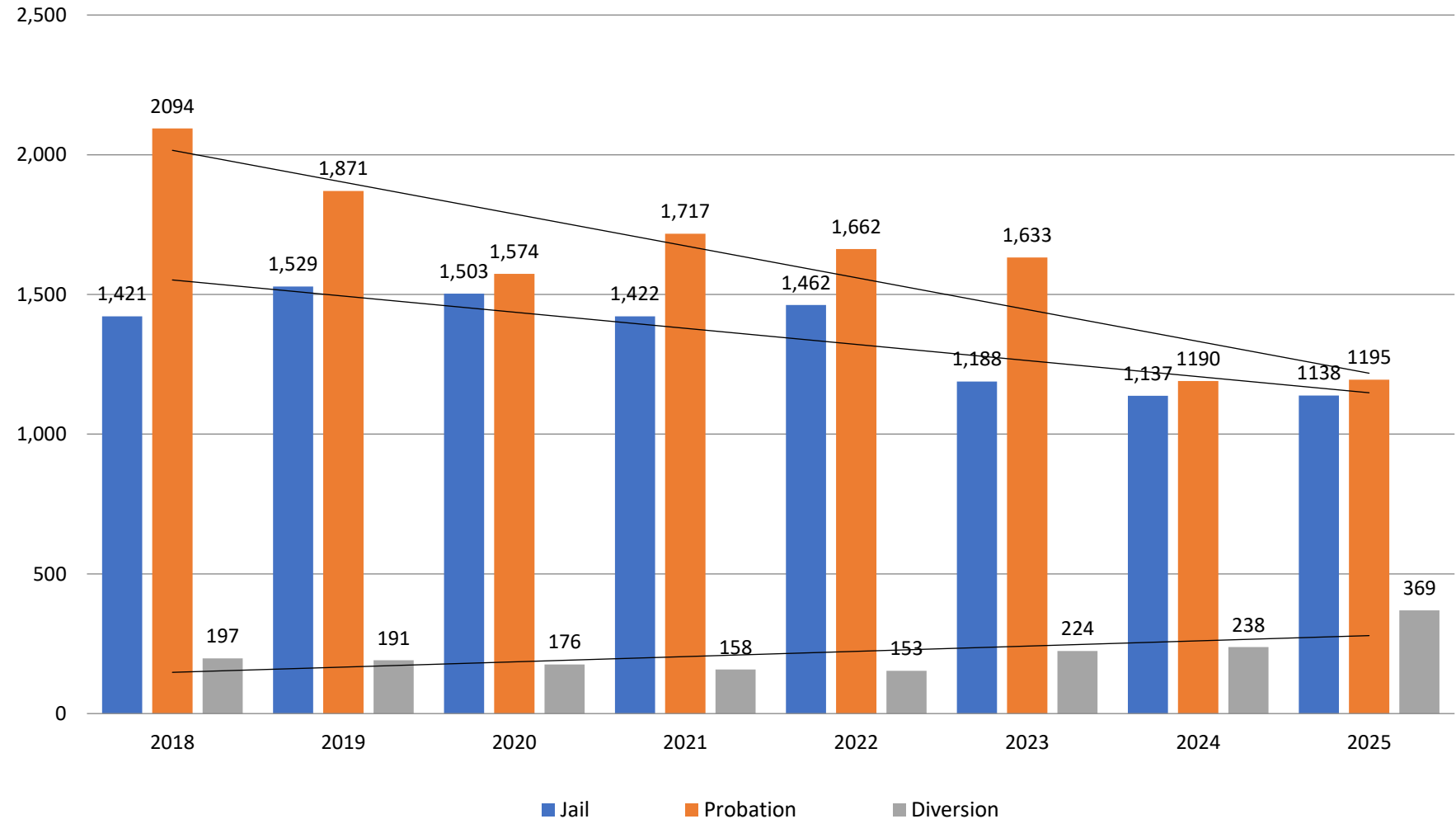

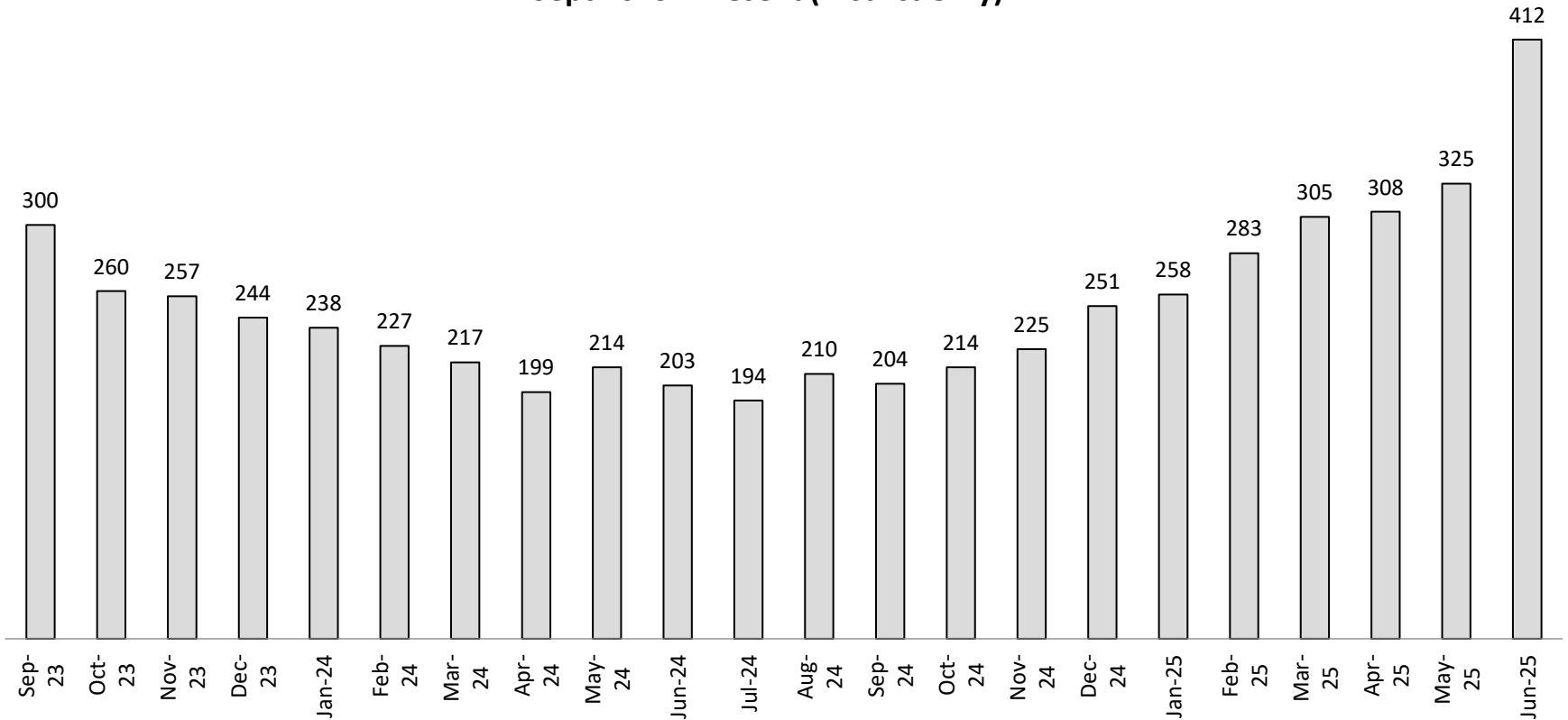

Diversion - Active Caseload

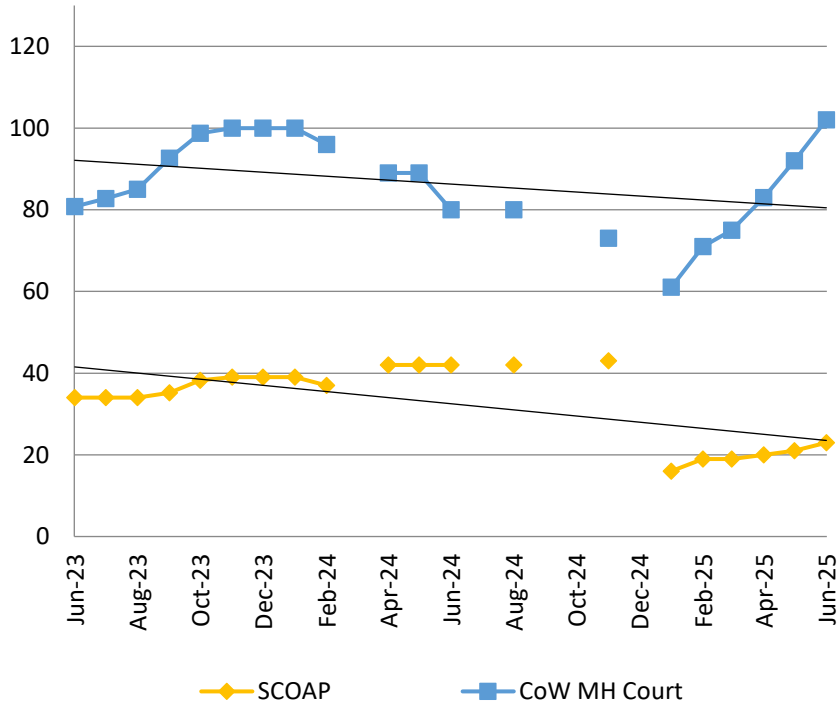

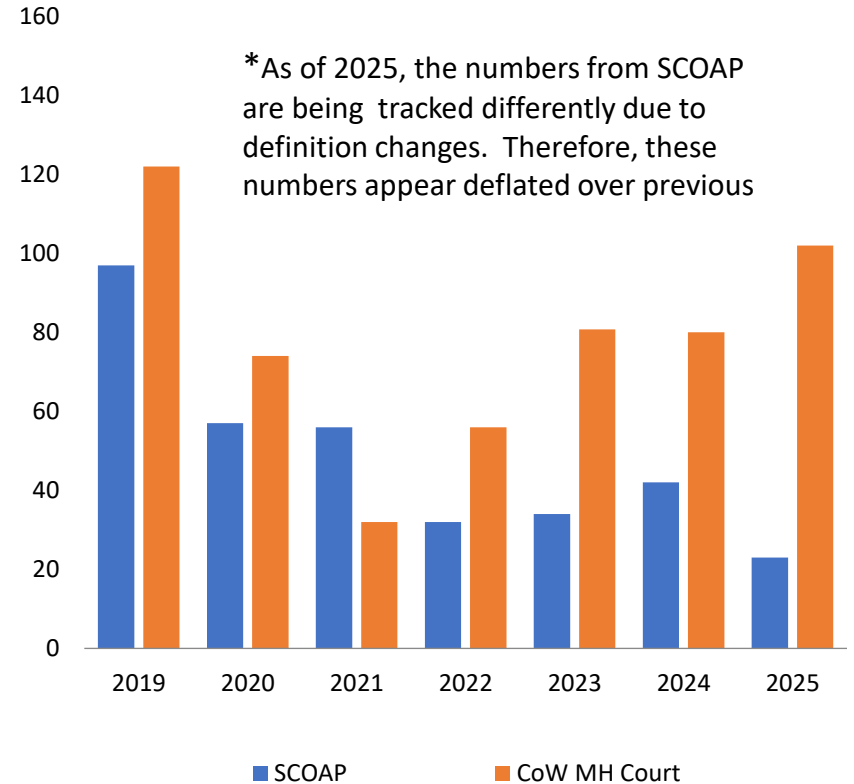

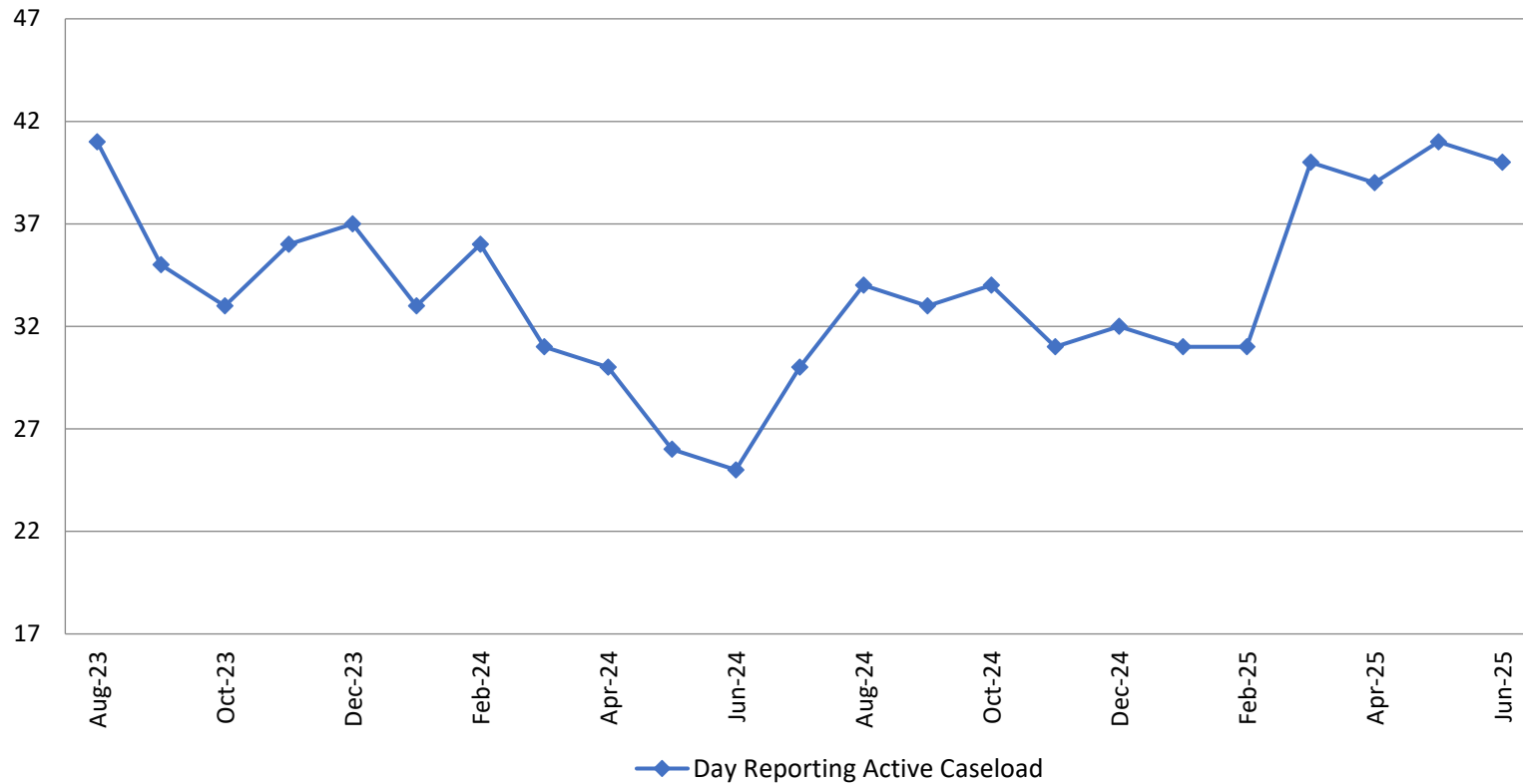


Mental Health ADP Year over Year - June Totals

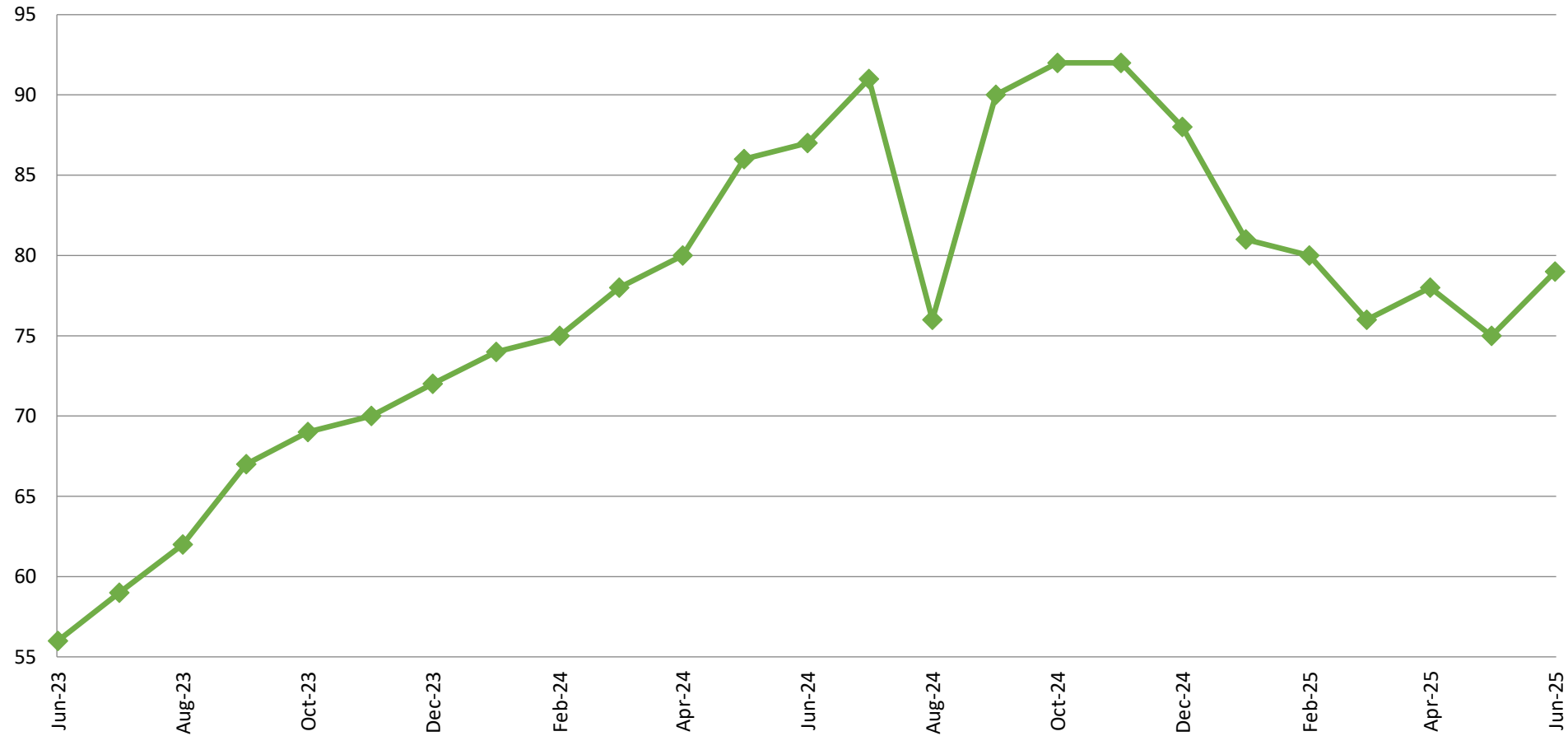

District Court Probation: Pre-Sentence Investigation 2023- present



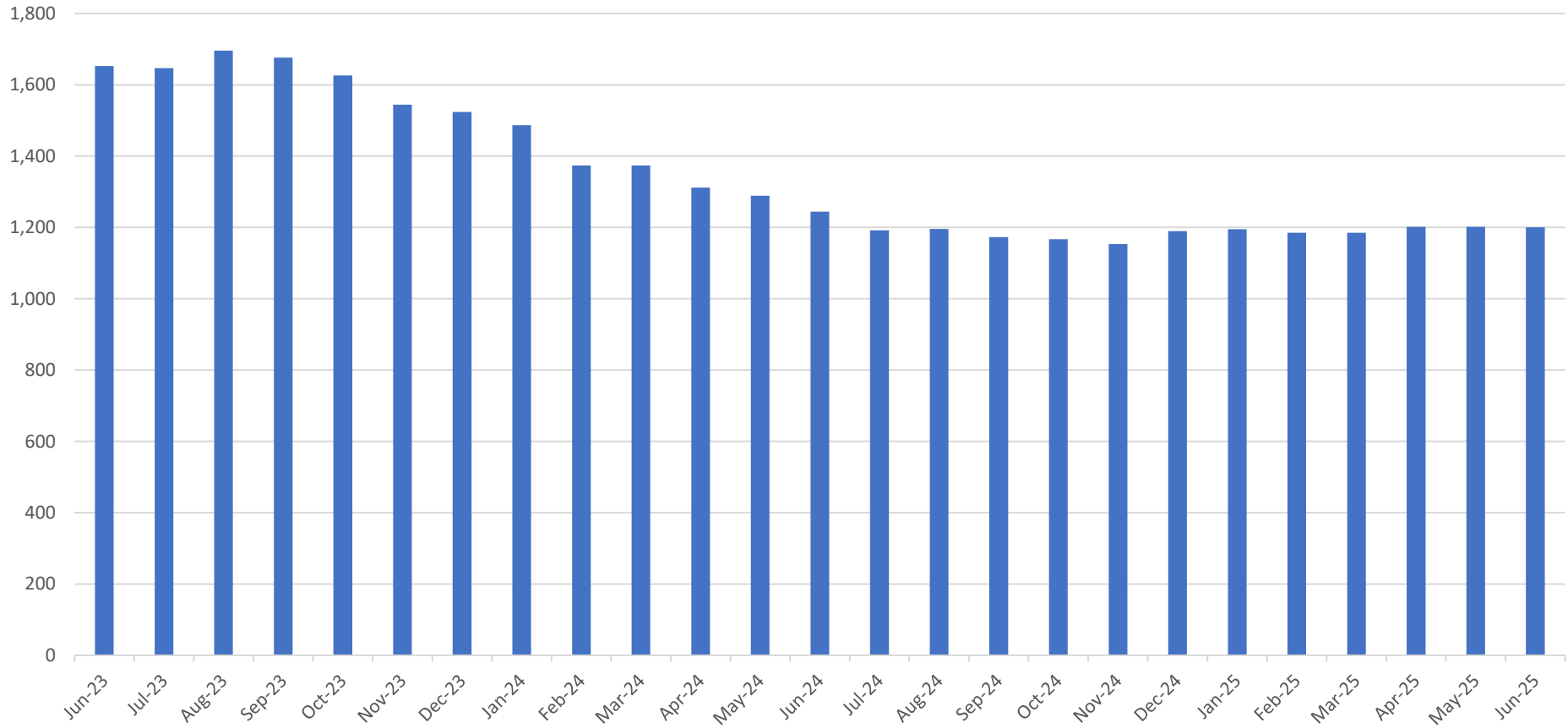

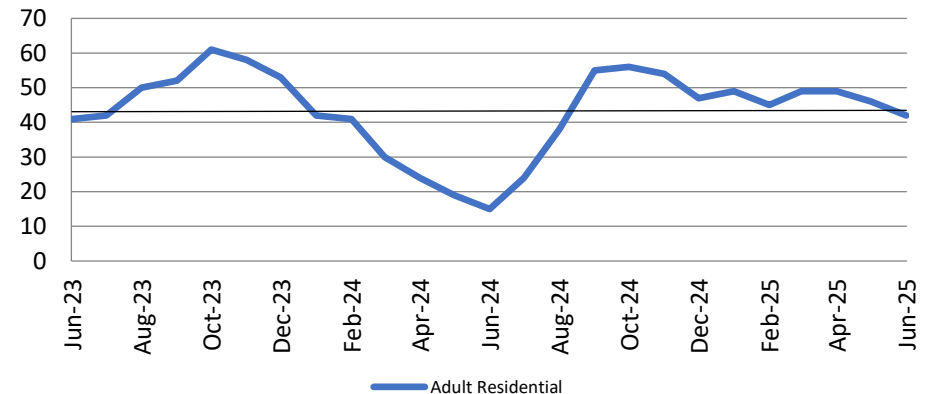

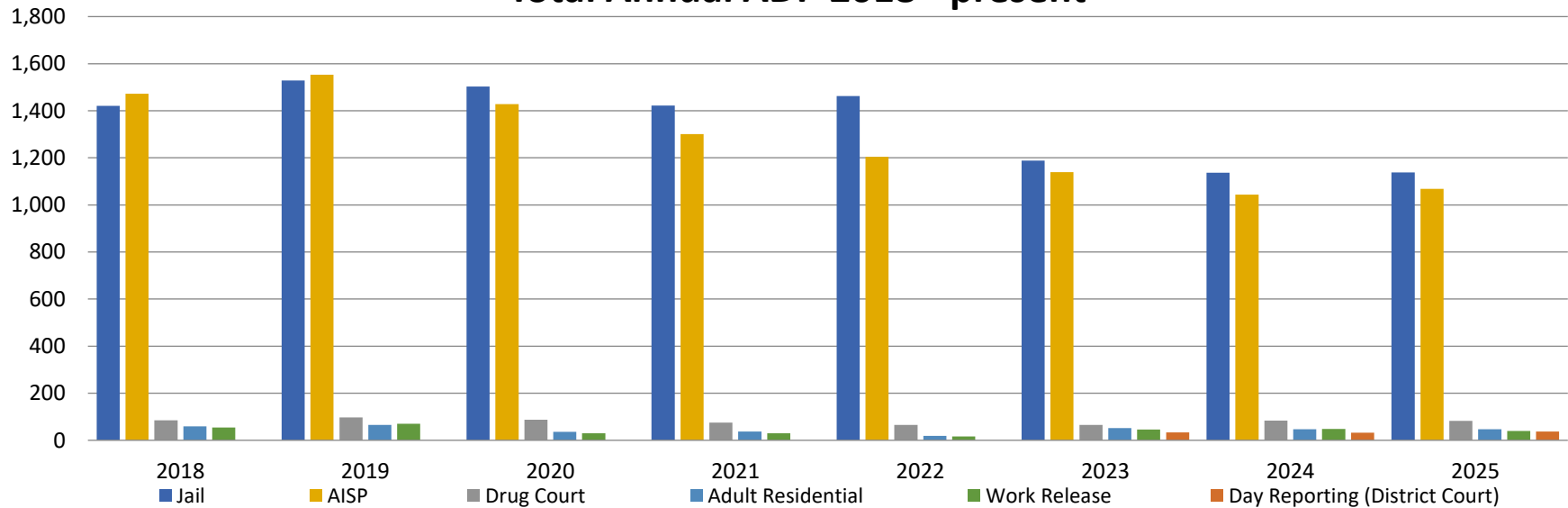

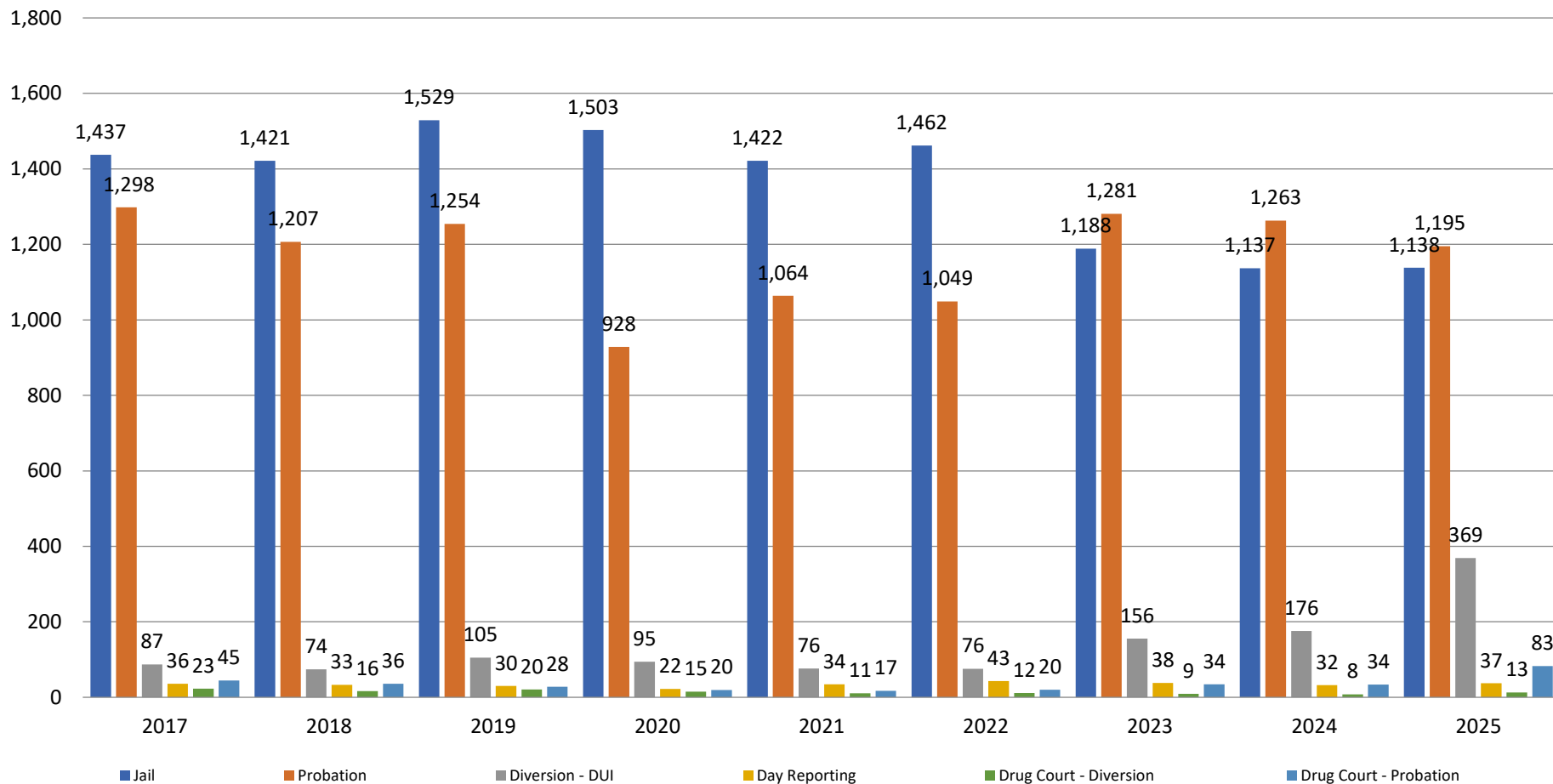

Total Annual ADP: 2017 - 2025

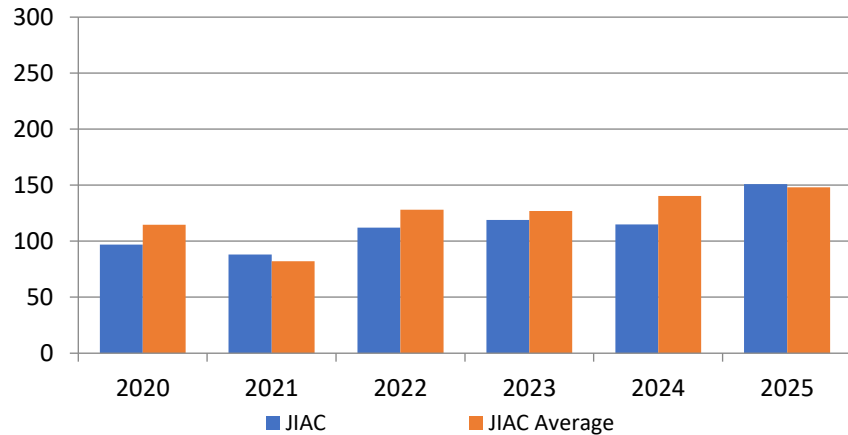

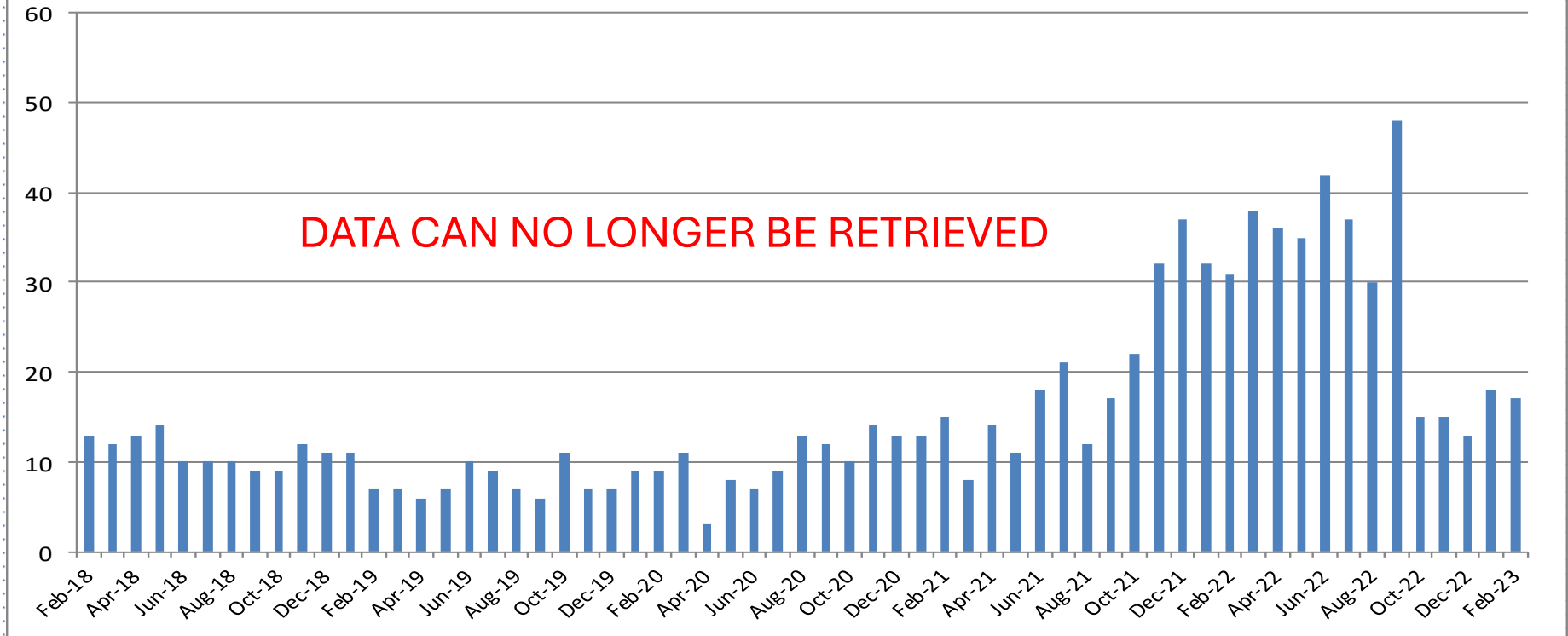
