## A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 24-304(b) OF THE SEDGWICK COUNTY CODE ON SOLID WASTE

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-3410, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas ("Board") is authorized to adopt resolutions and regulations for the storage, collection, transportation, processing, and disposal of solid waste in Sedgwick County.

**WHEREAS**, the Board has previously adopted a resolution that provided "Hazardous waste or construction and demolition waste as defined [in the Sedgwick County Code] shall not be accepted at any transfer station."

WHEREAS, the Board deems it appropriate to amend Section 24-304(b) of the Sedgwick County Code to allow construction and demolition materials to be received at any transfer station.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, THAT:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 24-304(b) of the Sedgwick County Code is amended to read as follows:

Hazardous waste as defined herein shall not be accepted at any transfer station.

**SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the Board.
