Average retention is 8 months.

Two Success Stories

**Two patients have been in the program since the beginning (17 months) and
have the longest DUP of all patients (72 months)**

Patient 1 – obtained independent housing and transportation, became involved
in community groups, and graduated from therapy.

QPR increased from 24 to 39 since starting services.

Patient 2 – developed insight into their mental health diagnosis and was able to
identify paranoia as a symptom, obtained independent housing, expunged past
legal convictions, and successfully advocated to become his own payee.

QPR increased from 33 to 58 since starting services.
