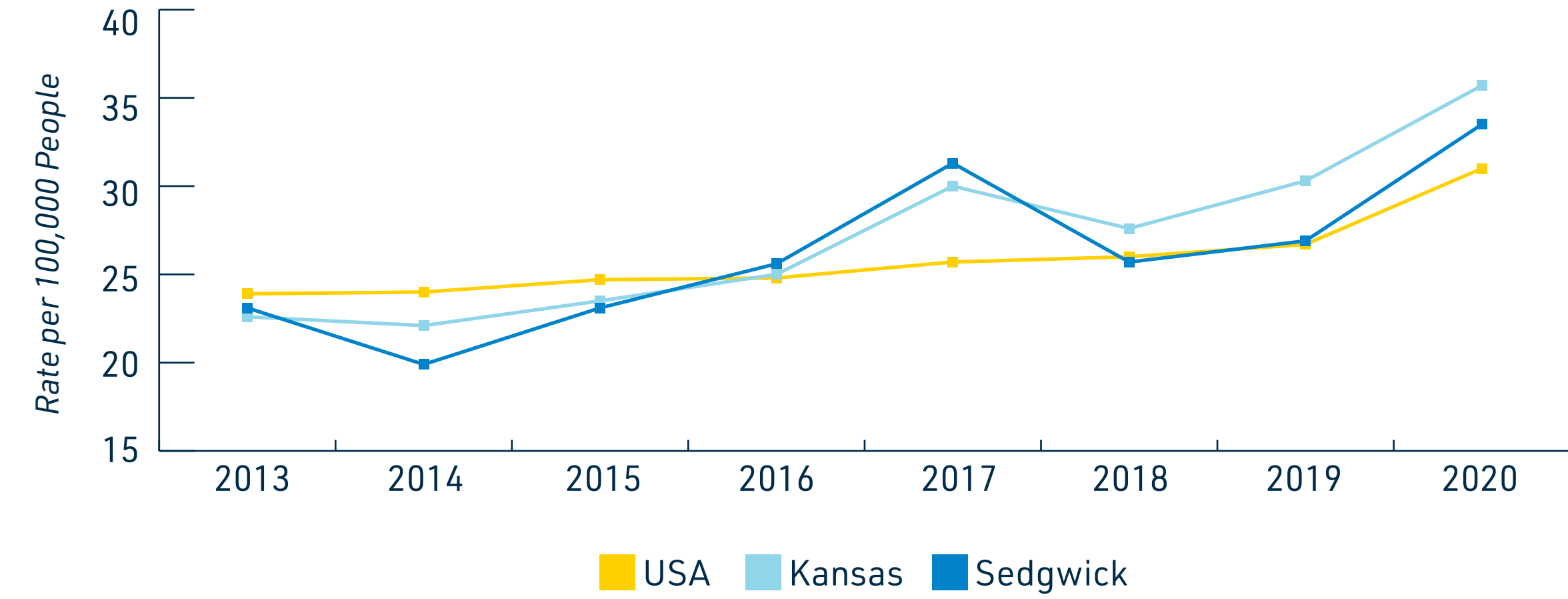


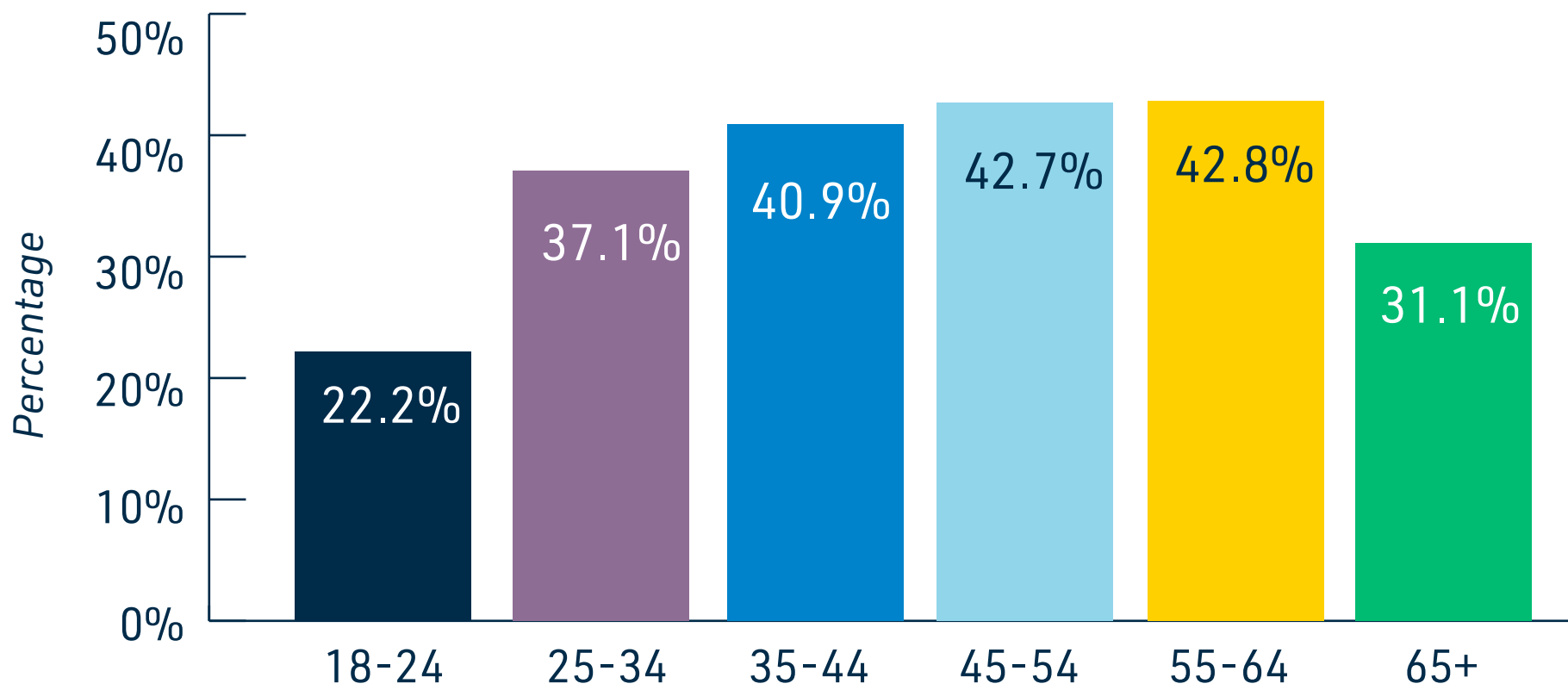

DEATH RATE FROM DIABETES



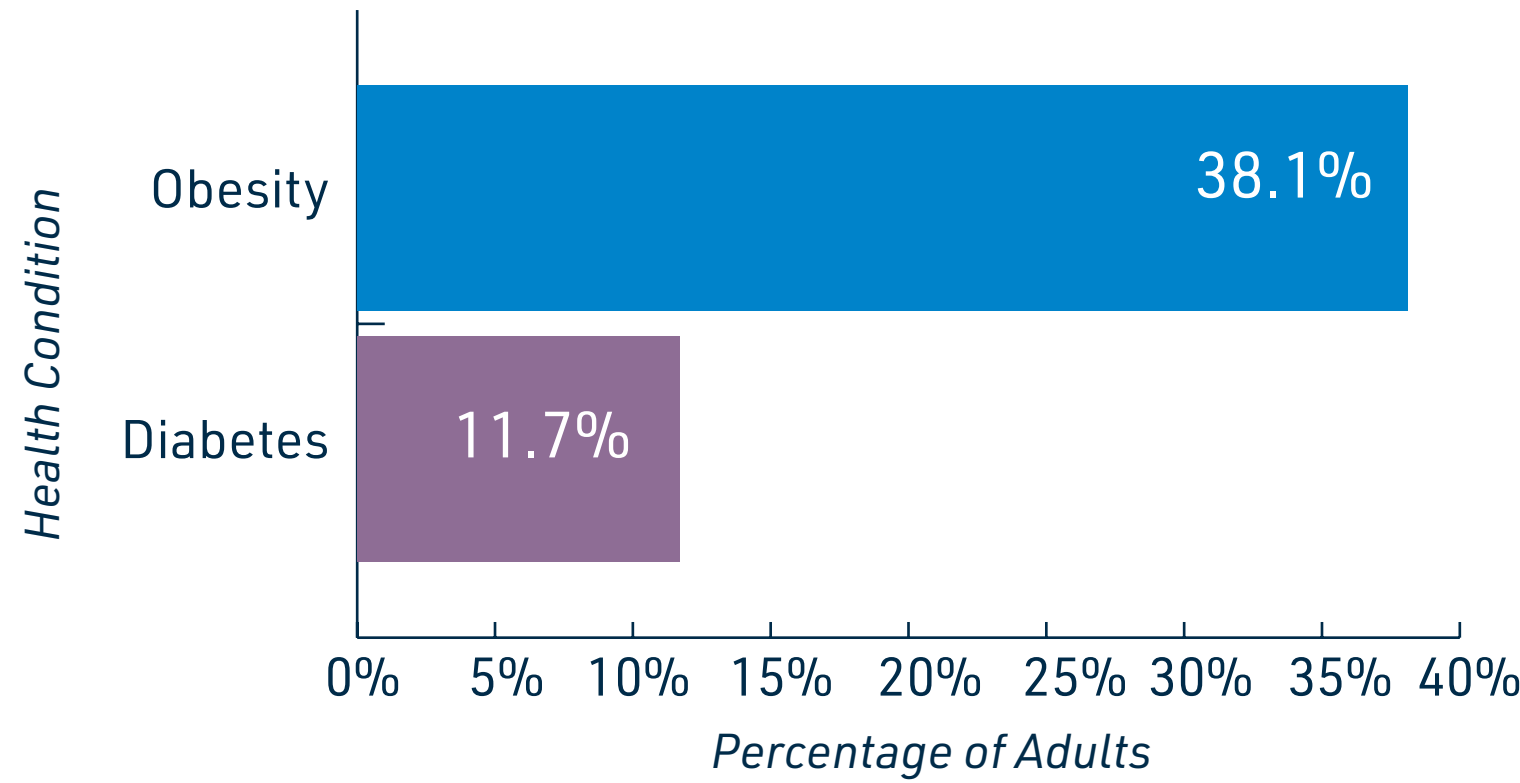

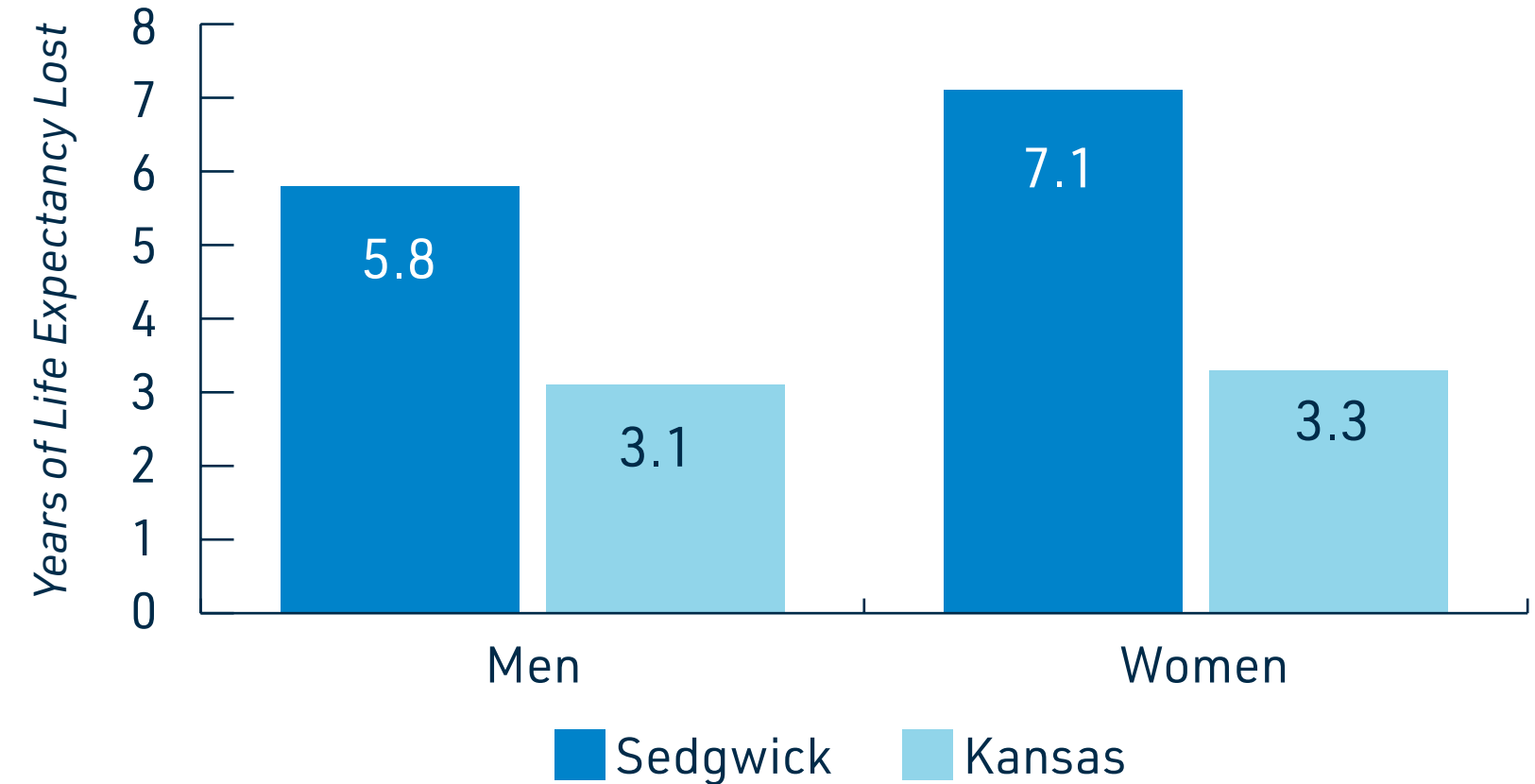

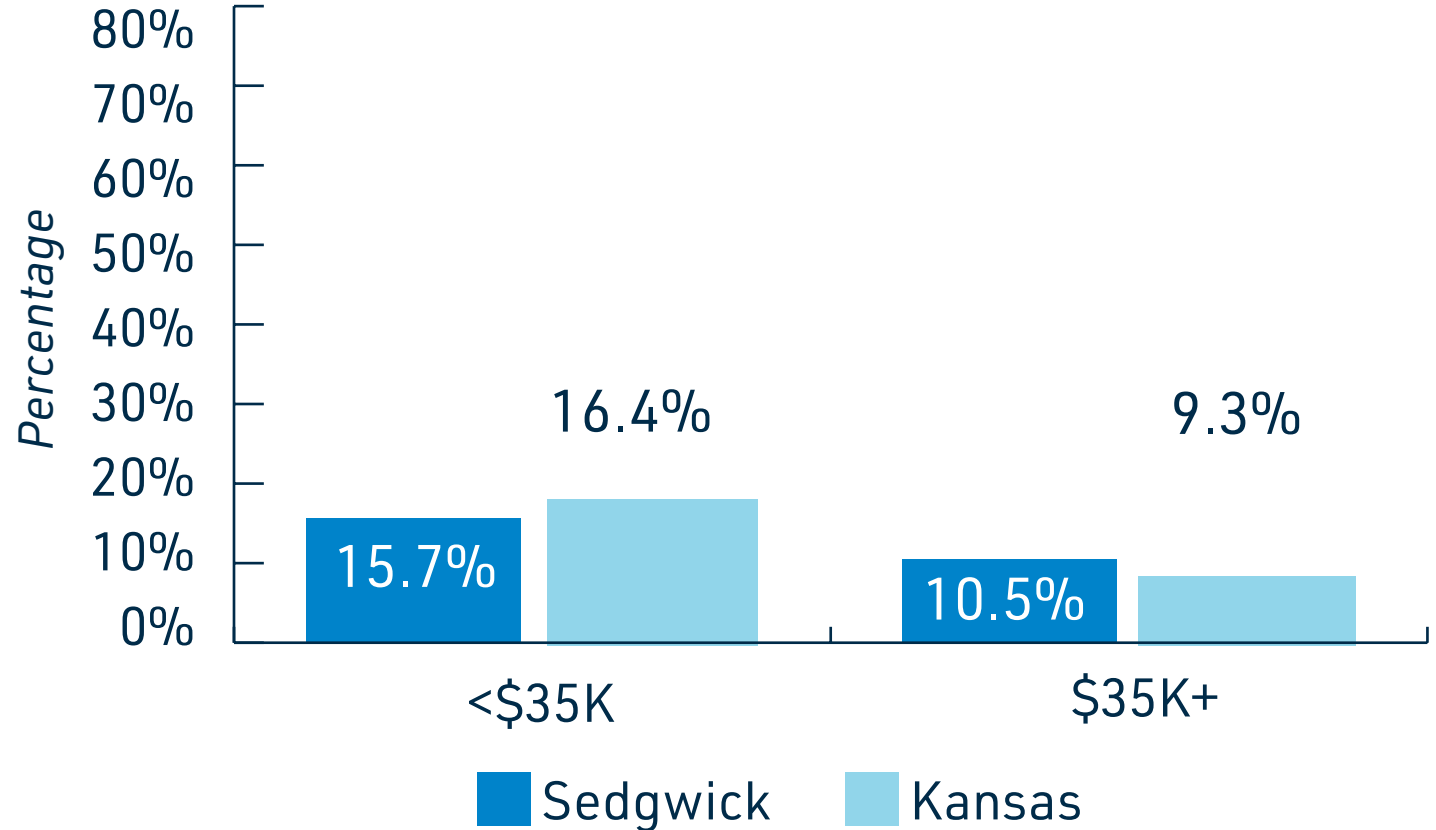

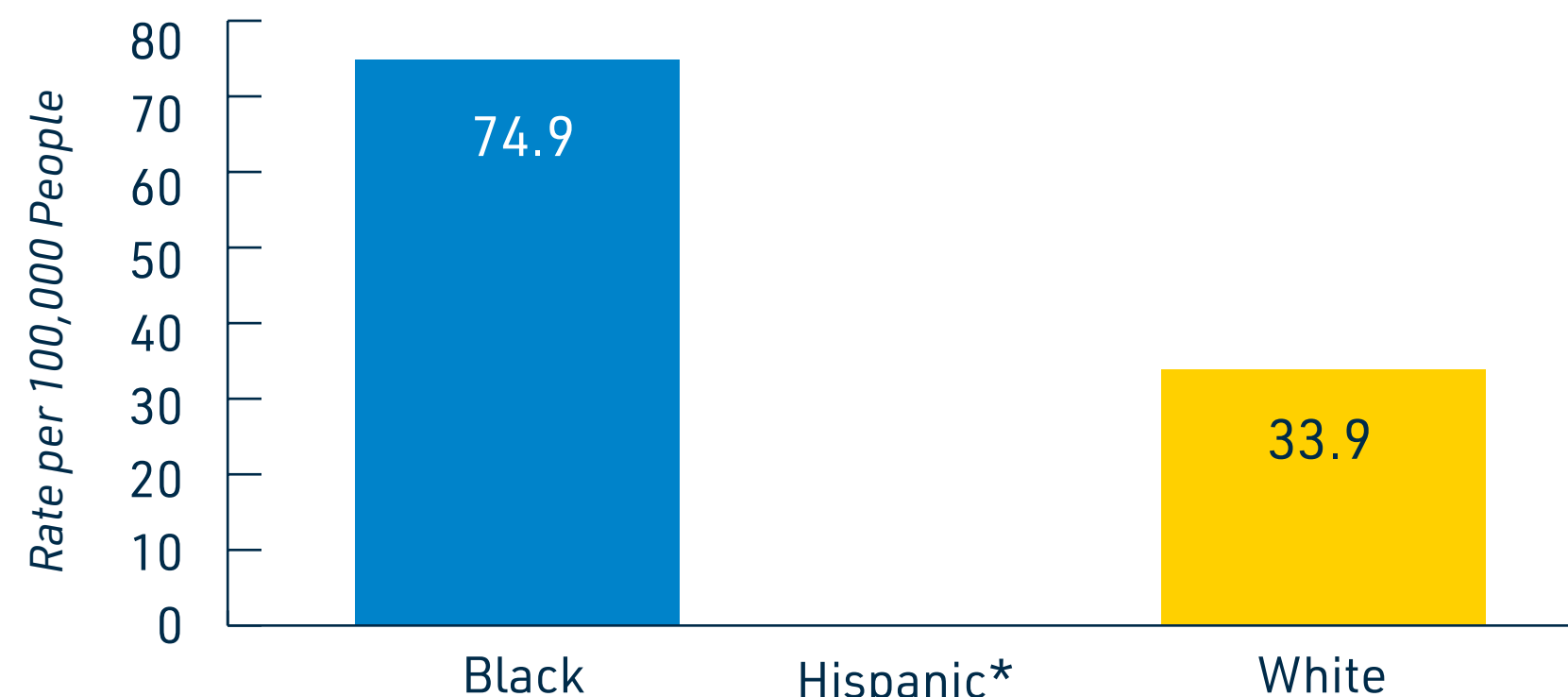

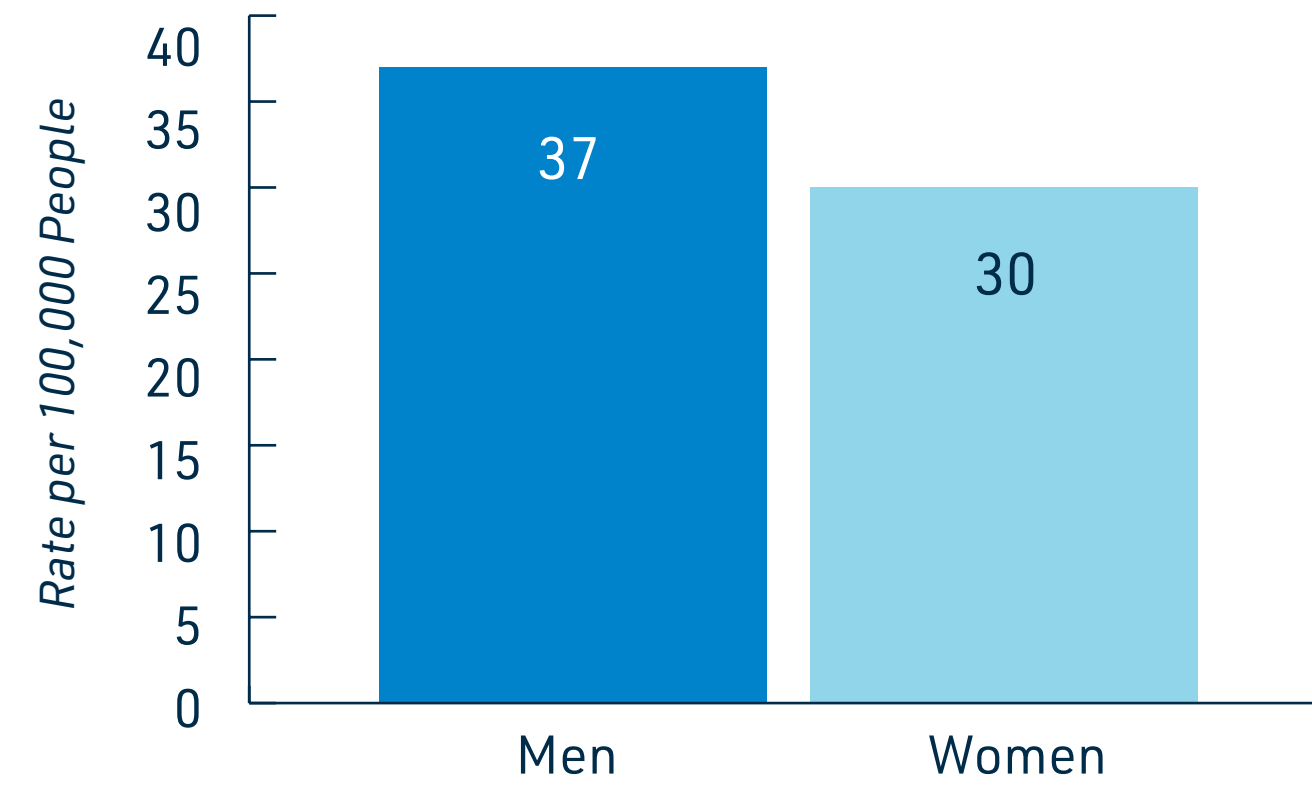
SEDGWICK COUNTY: DIABETES MORTALITY RATE

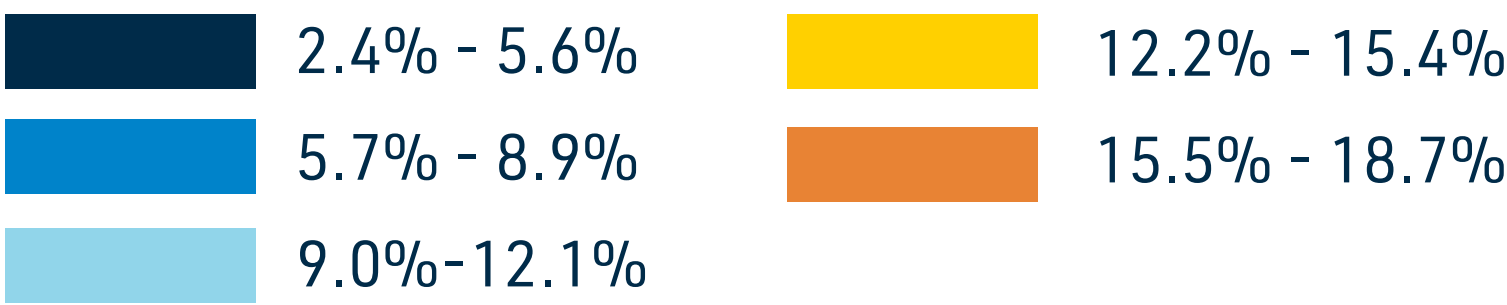
