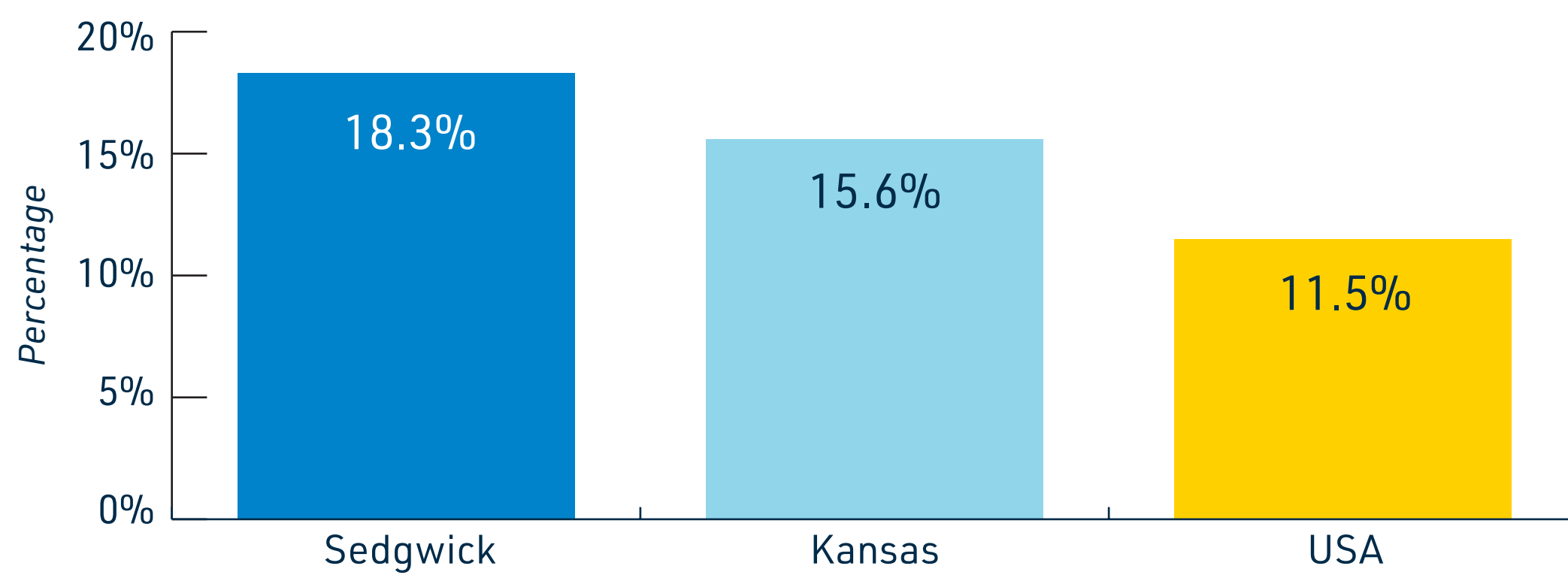


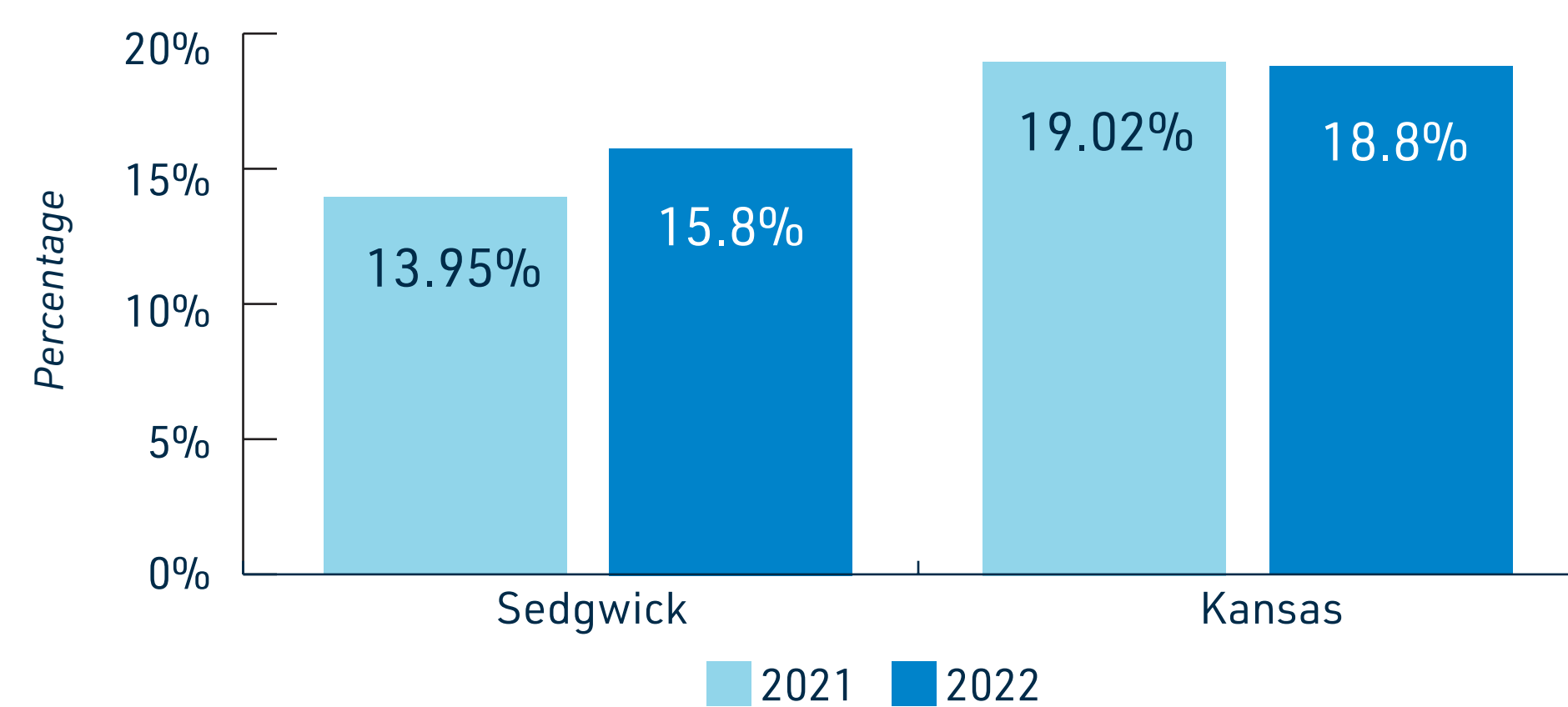

PERCENT OF CURRENT SMOKERS, 2021



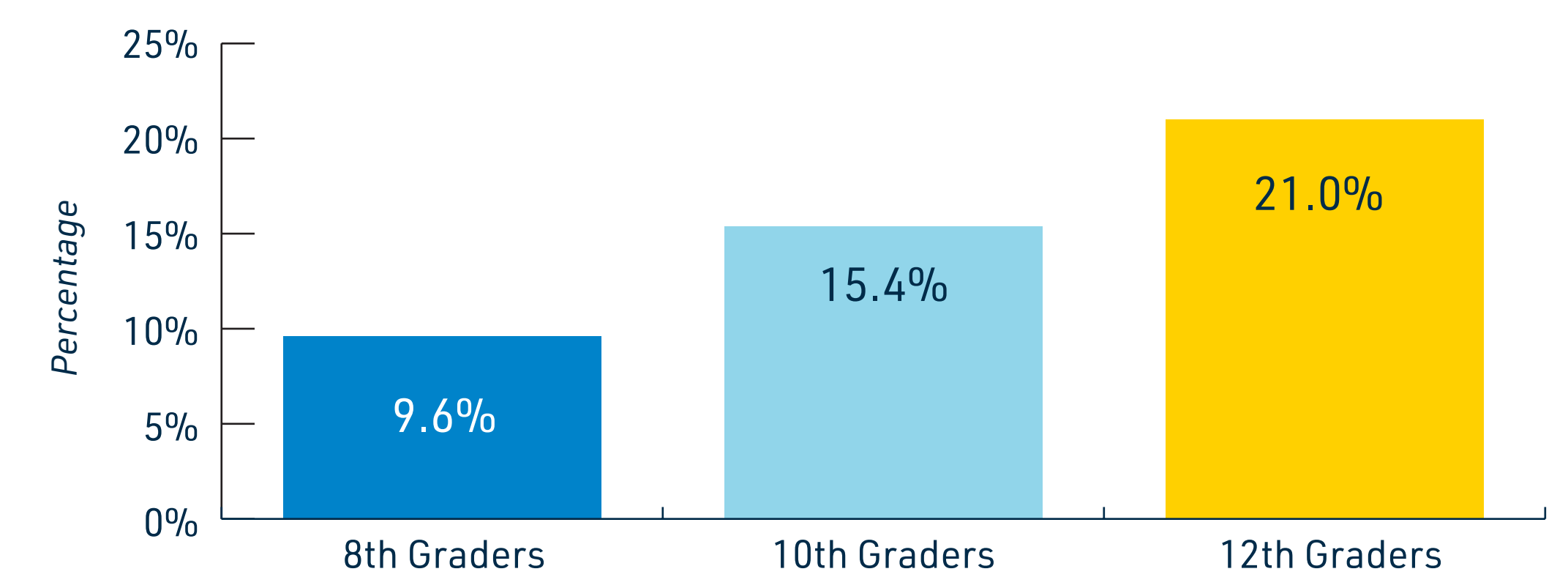

WHO HAVE TRIED VAPING AT LEAST ONCE



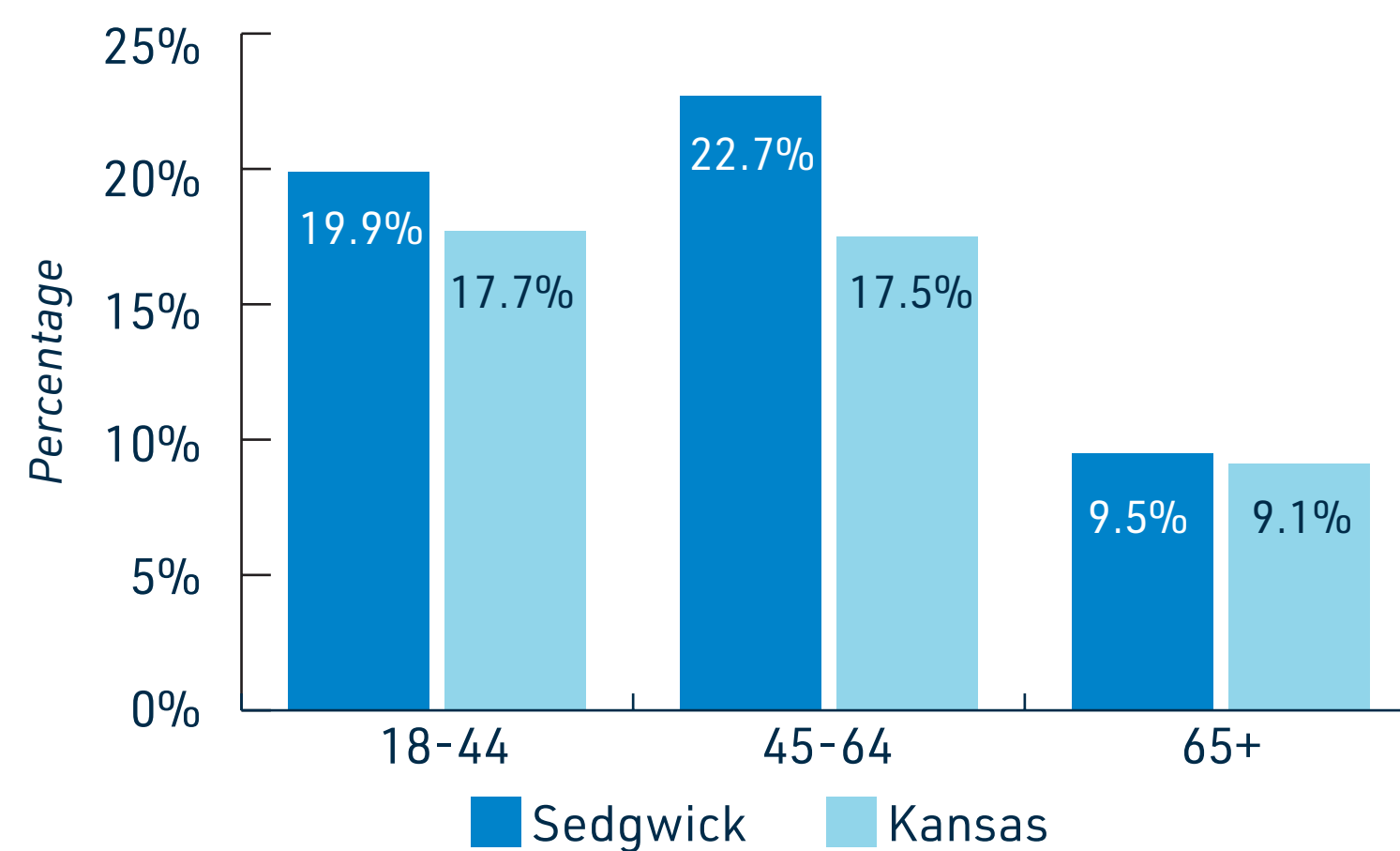

VAPING NICOTINE WITHIN THE PAST YEAR



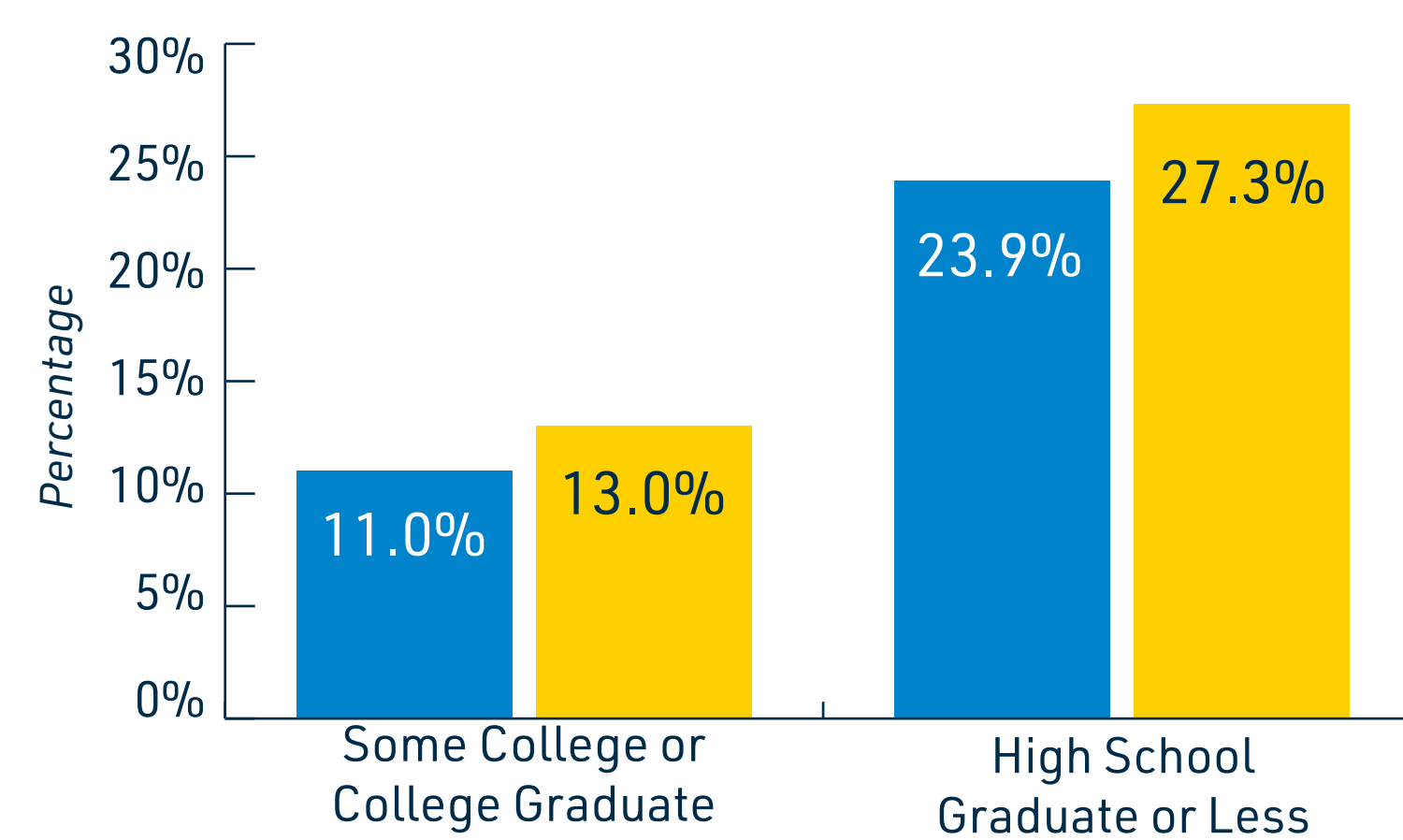

BY AGE, 2021



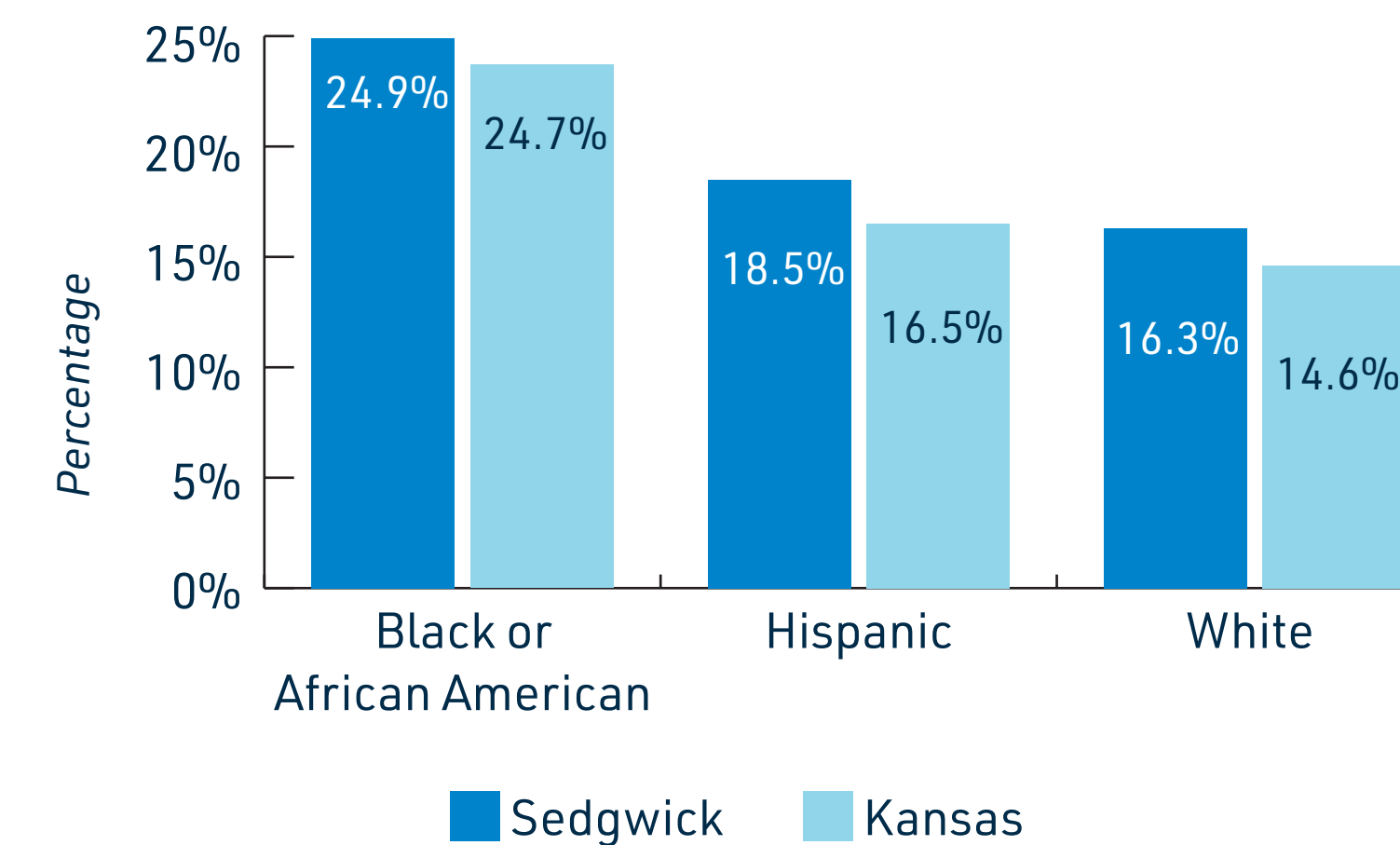

BY EDUCATION LEVEL



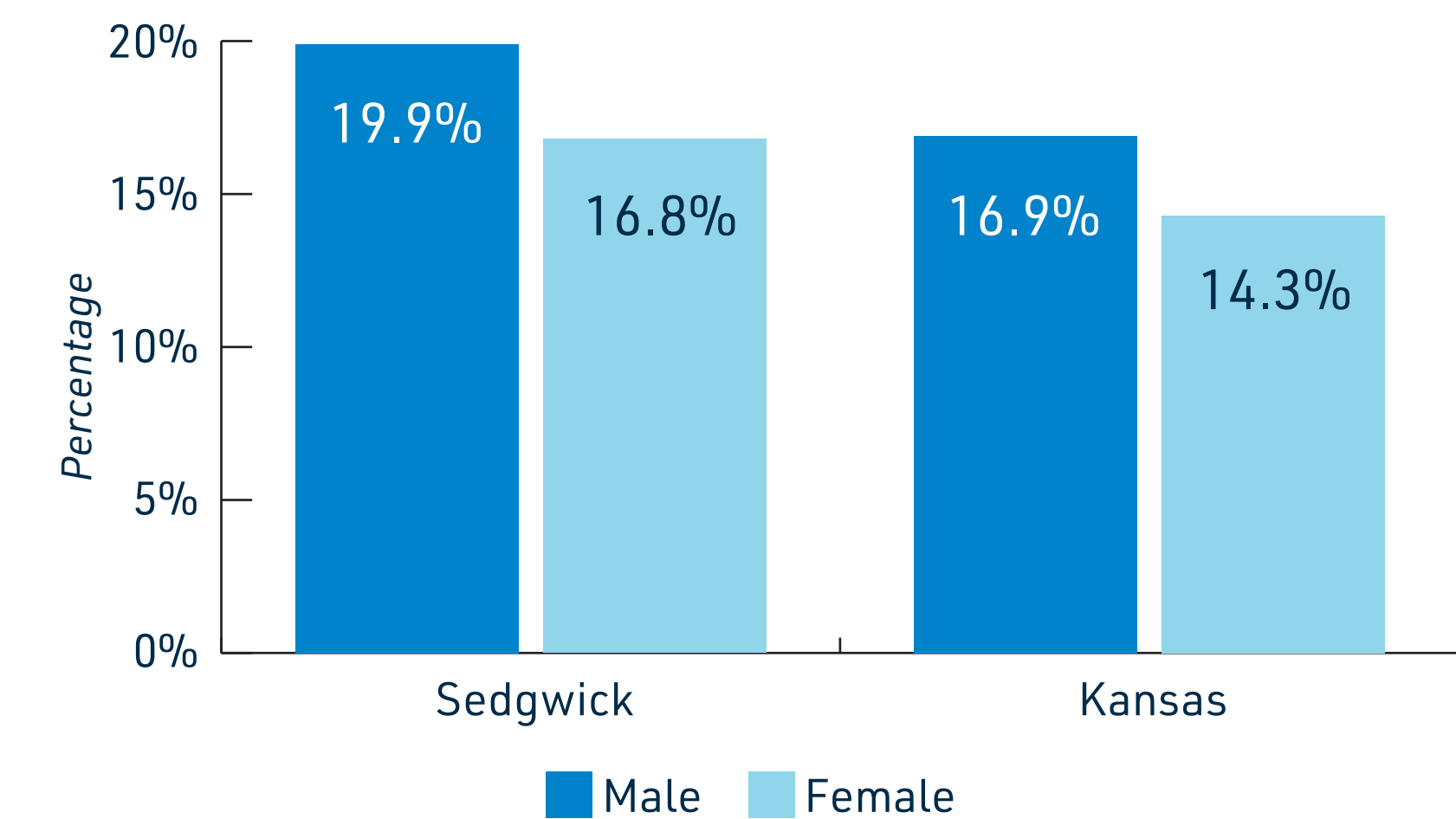

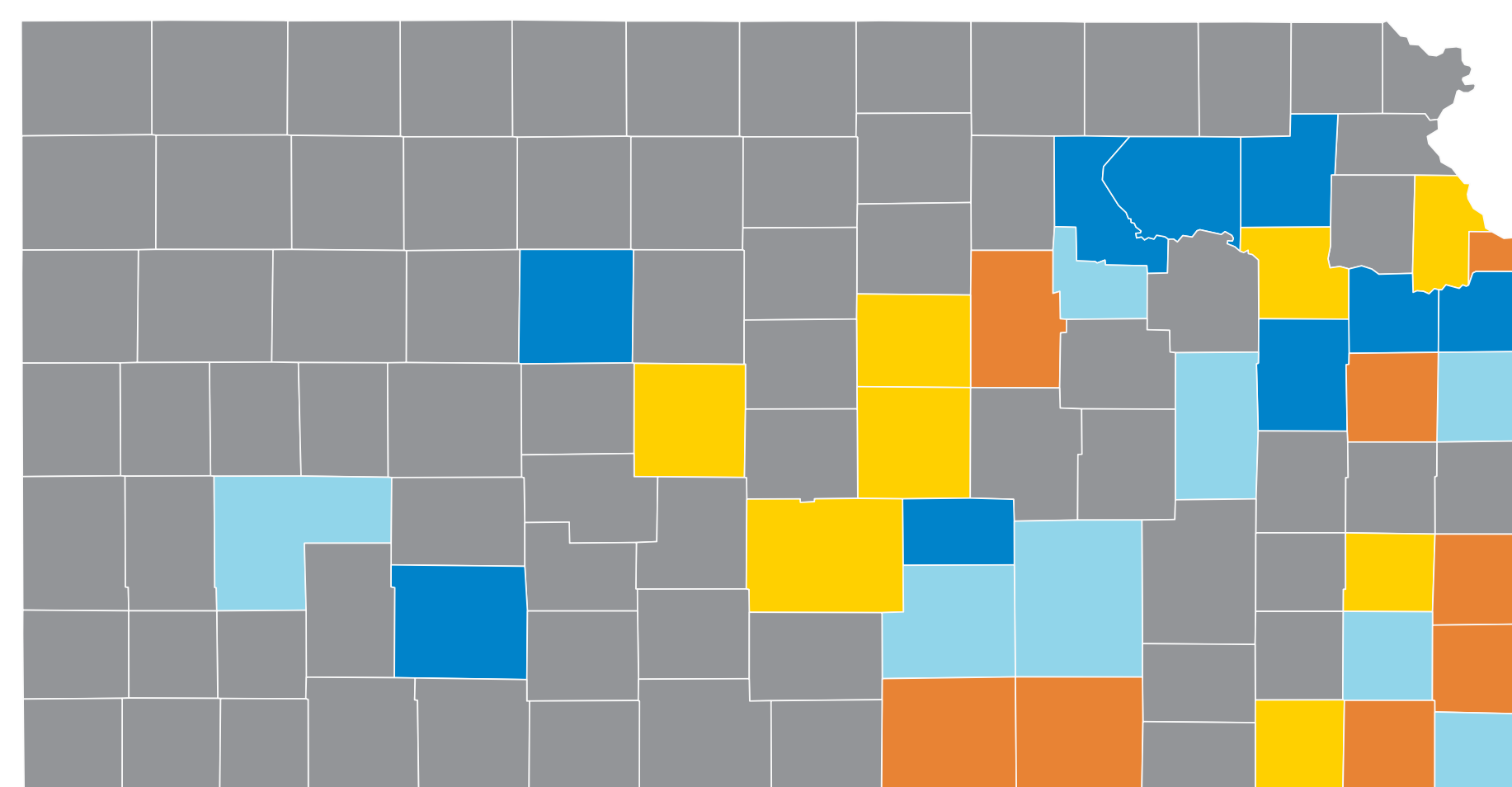
PERCENTAGE OF KANSANS WHO SMOKE
BY SEX



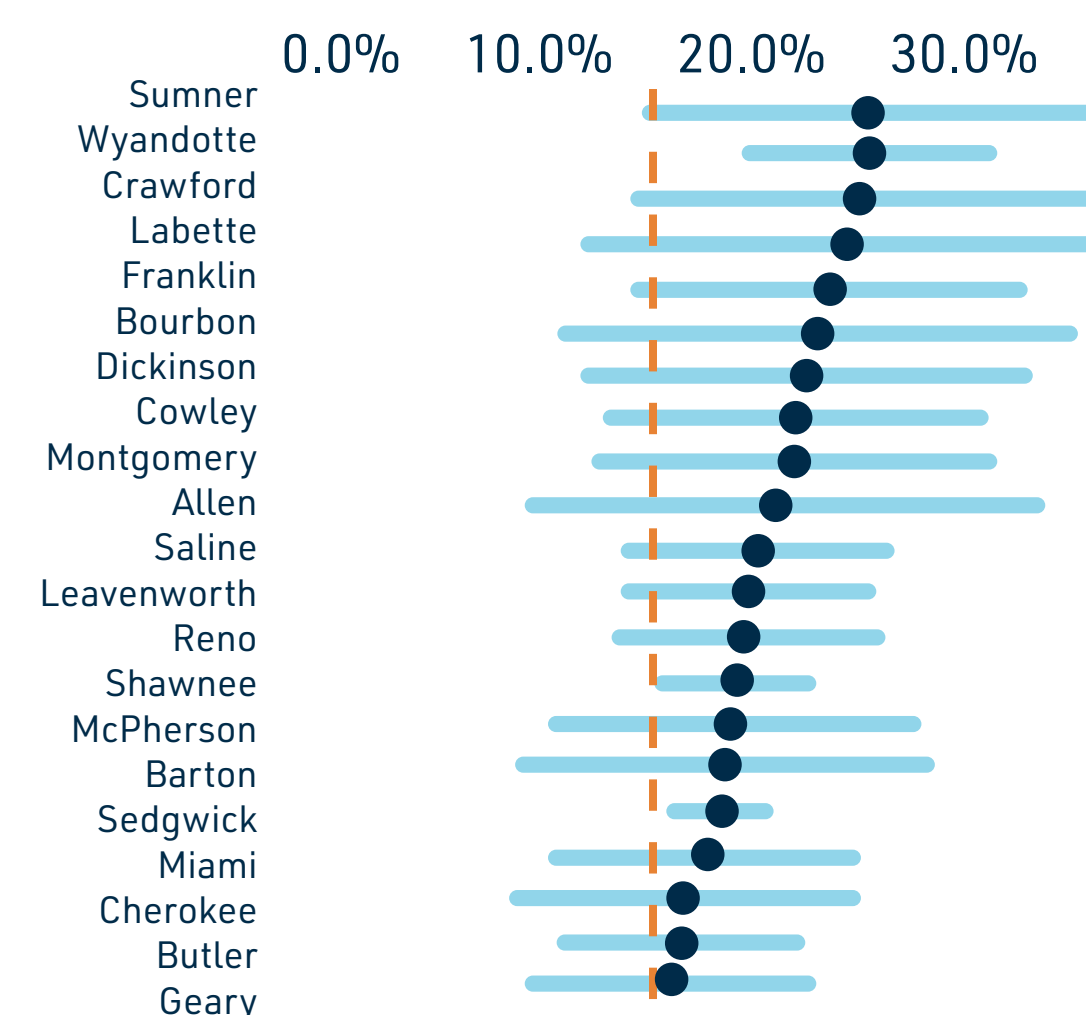
