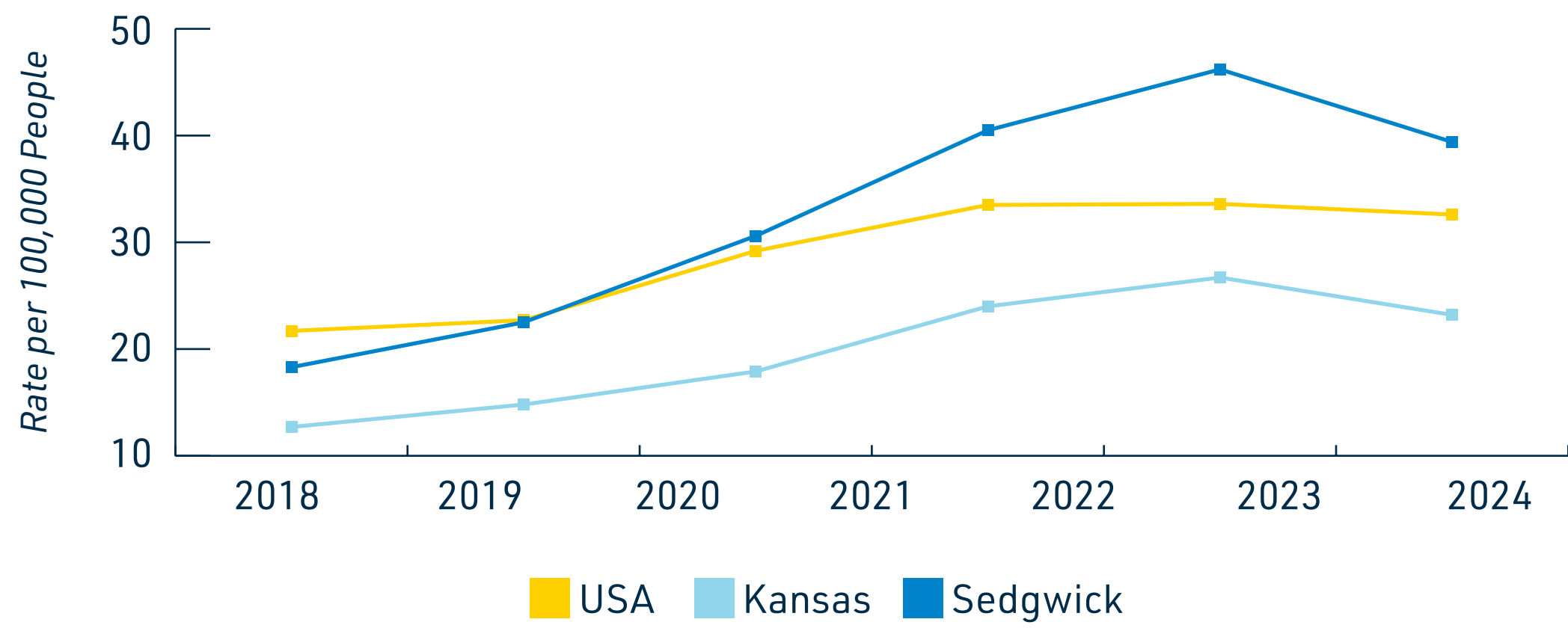


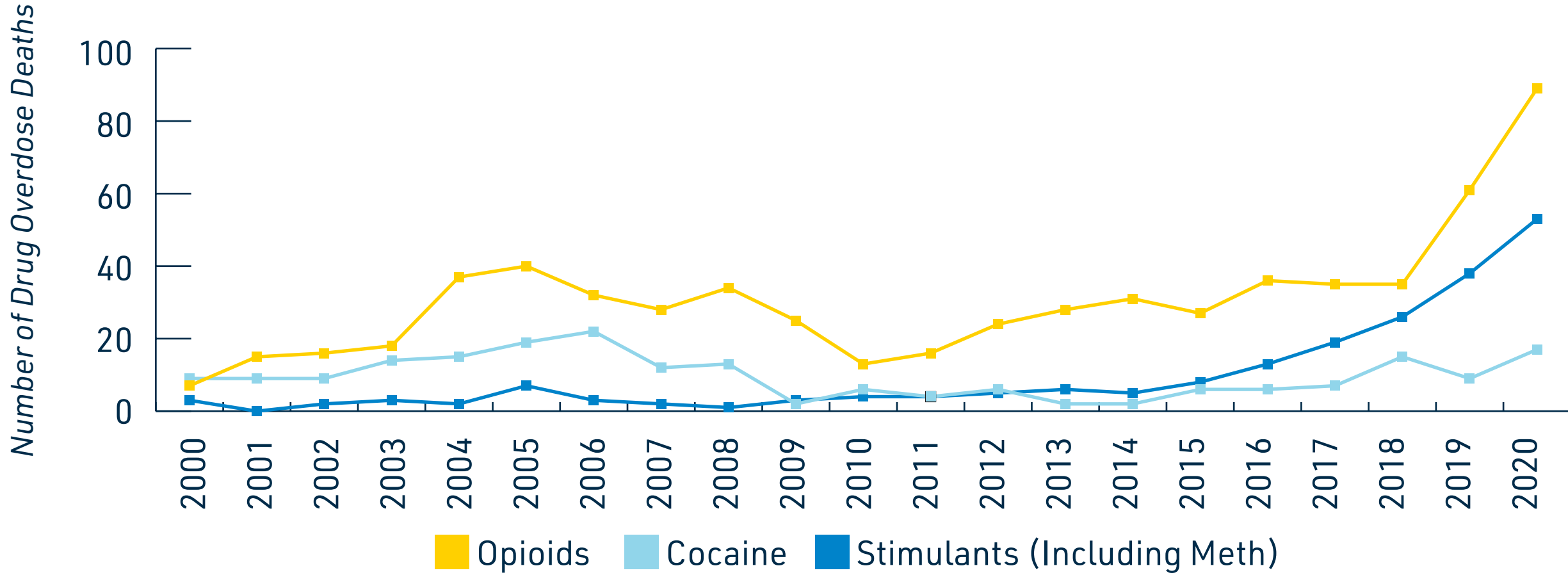

DRUG OVERDOSE DEATH RATE



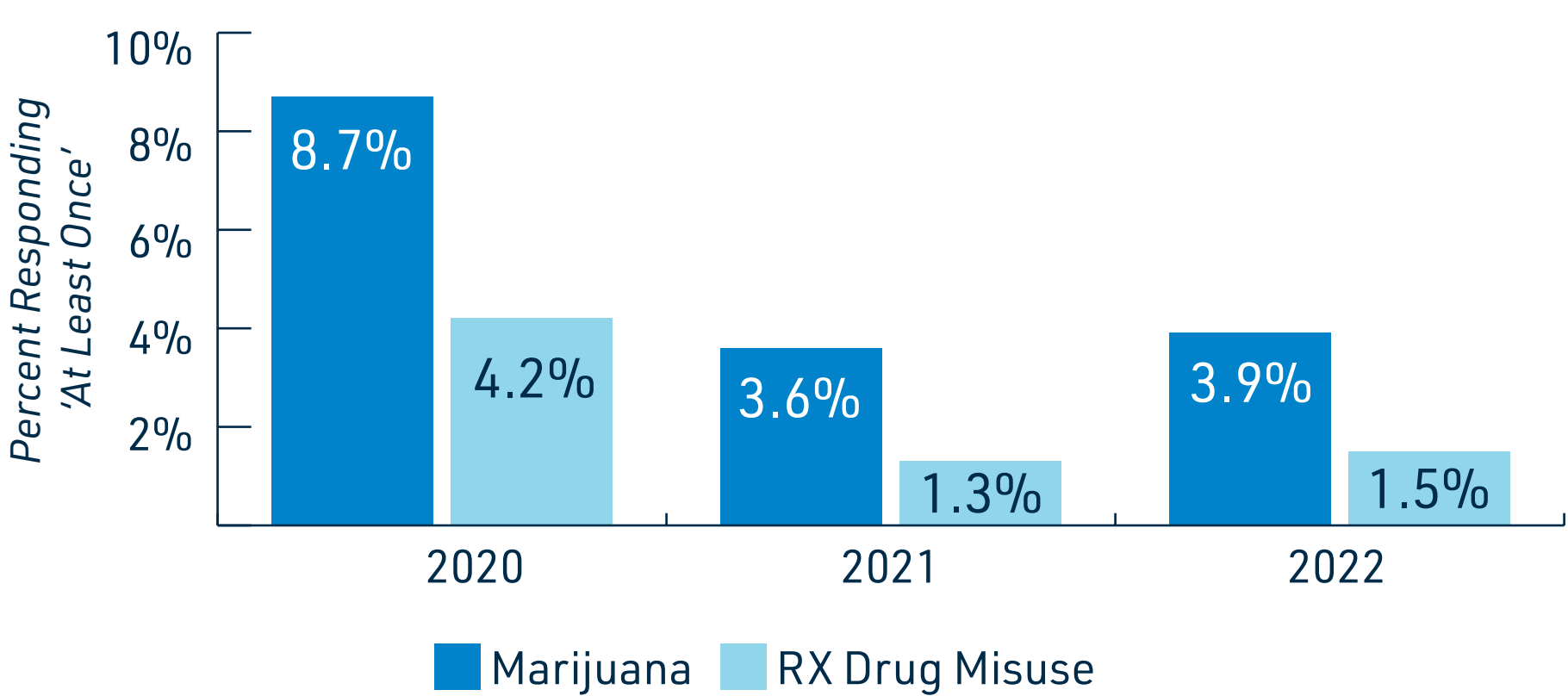

BY DRUG TYPE



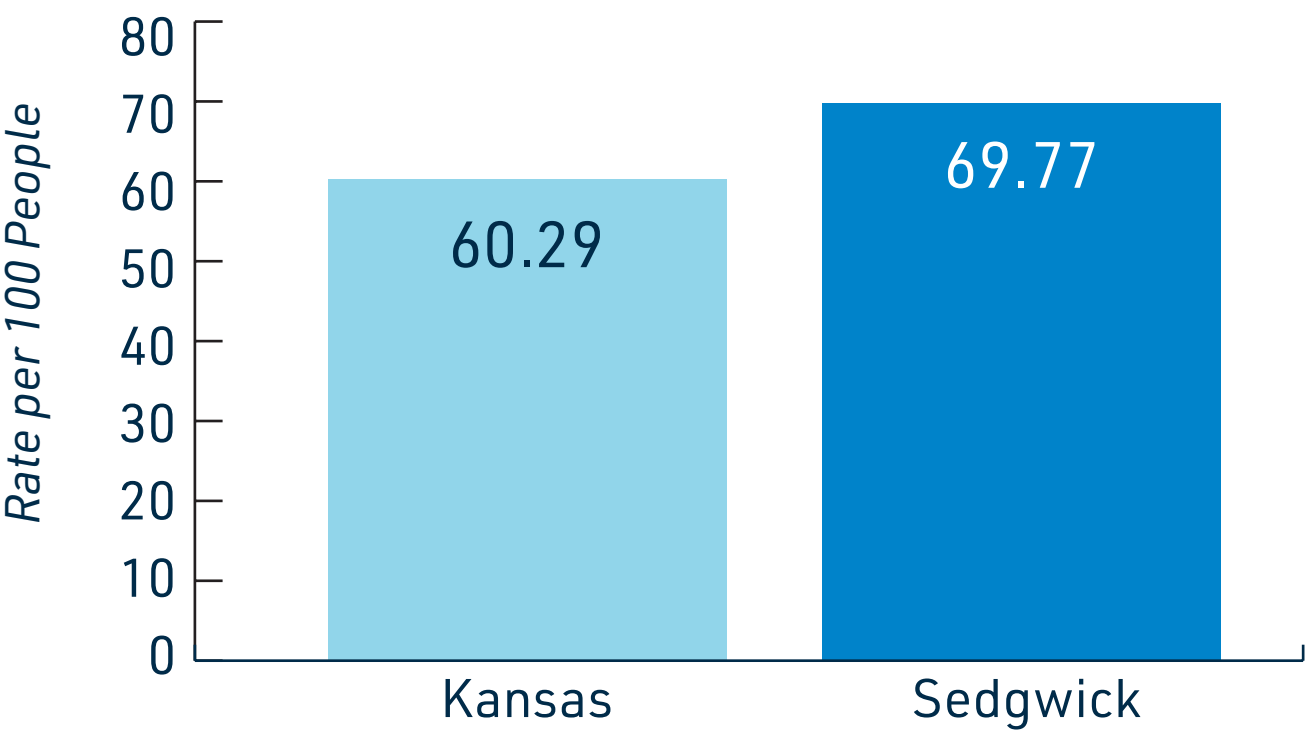

30-DAY SUBSTANCE USE



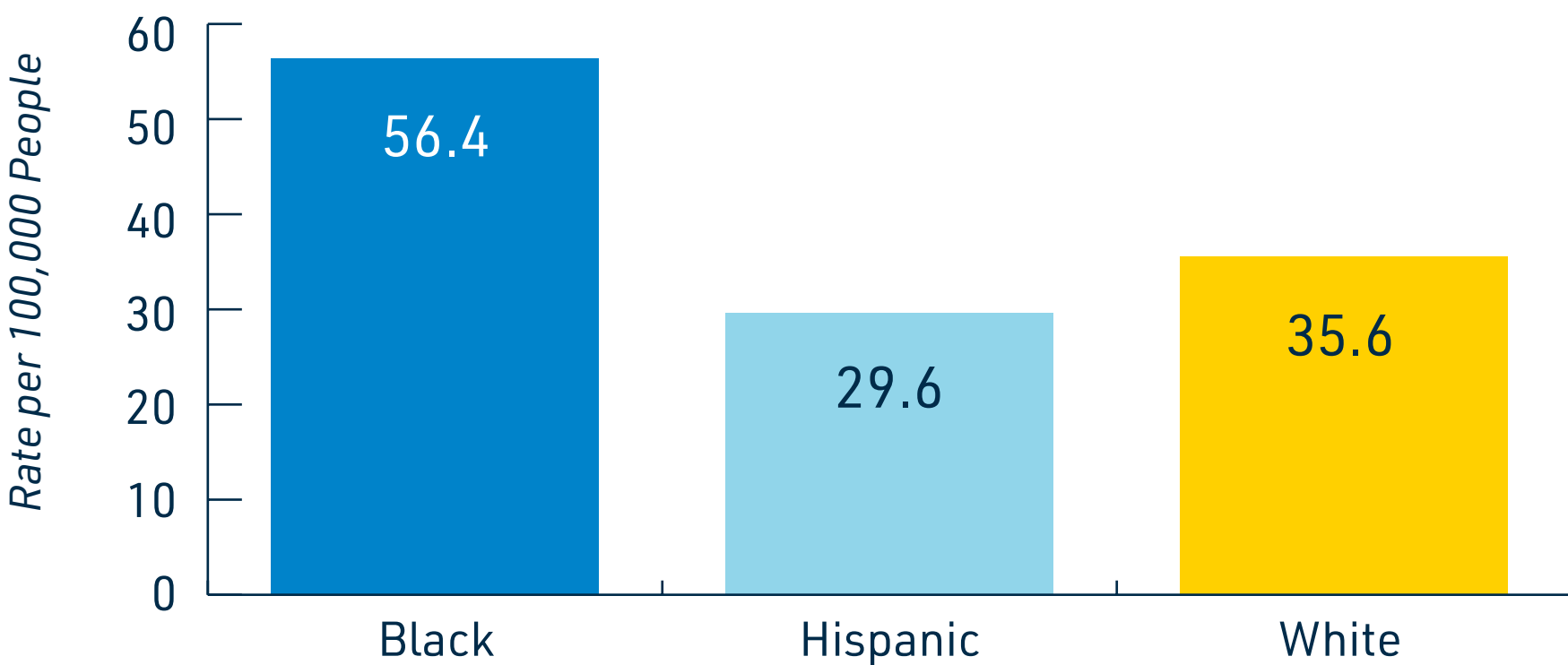

OPIOID PRESCRIPTIONS



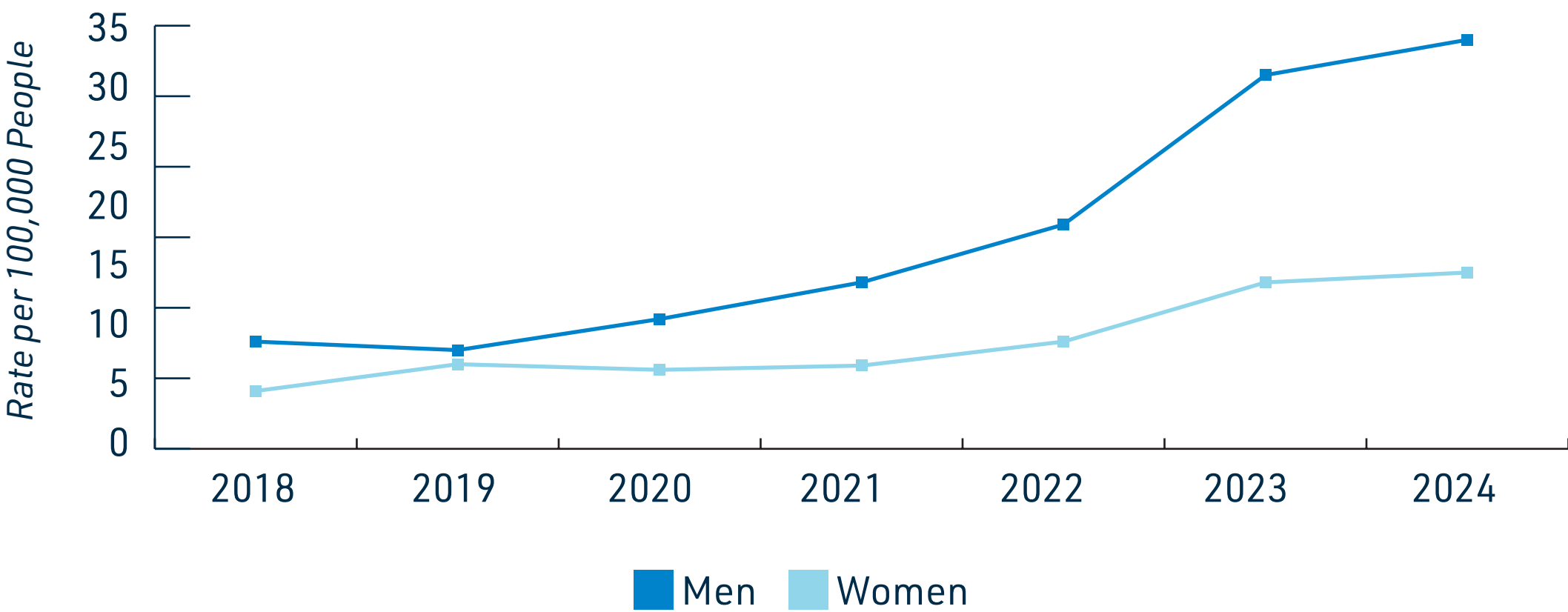

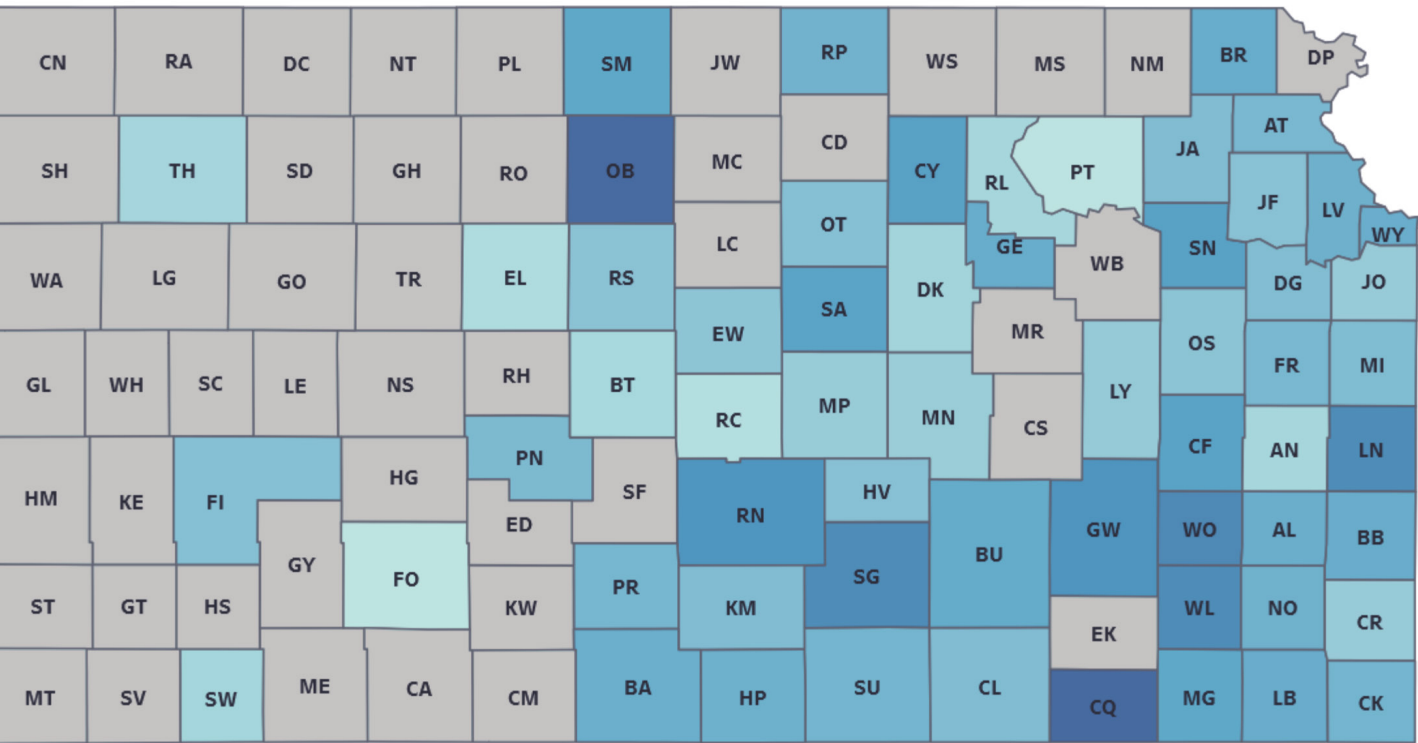

KANSAS COUNTIES DRUG POISONING DEATHS

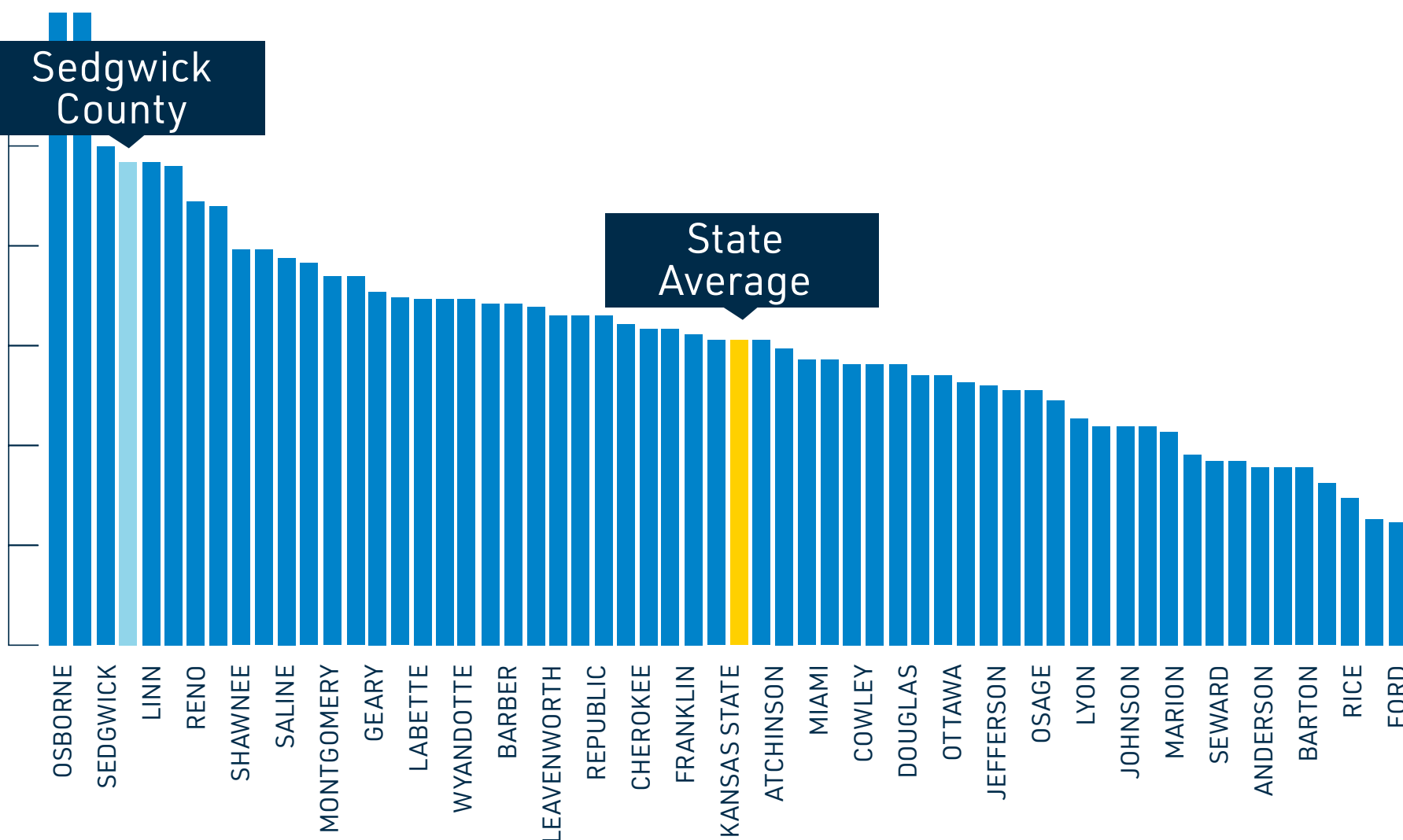
