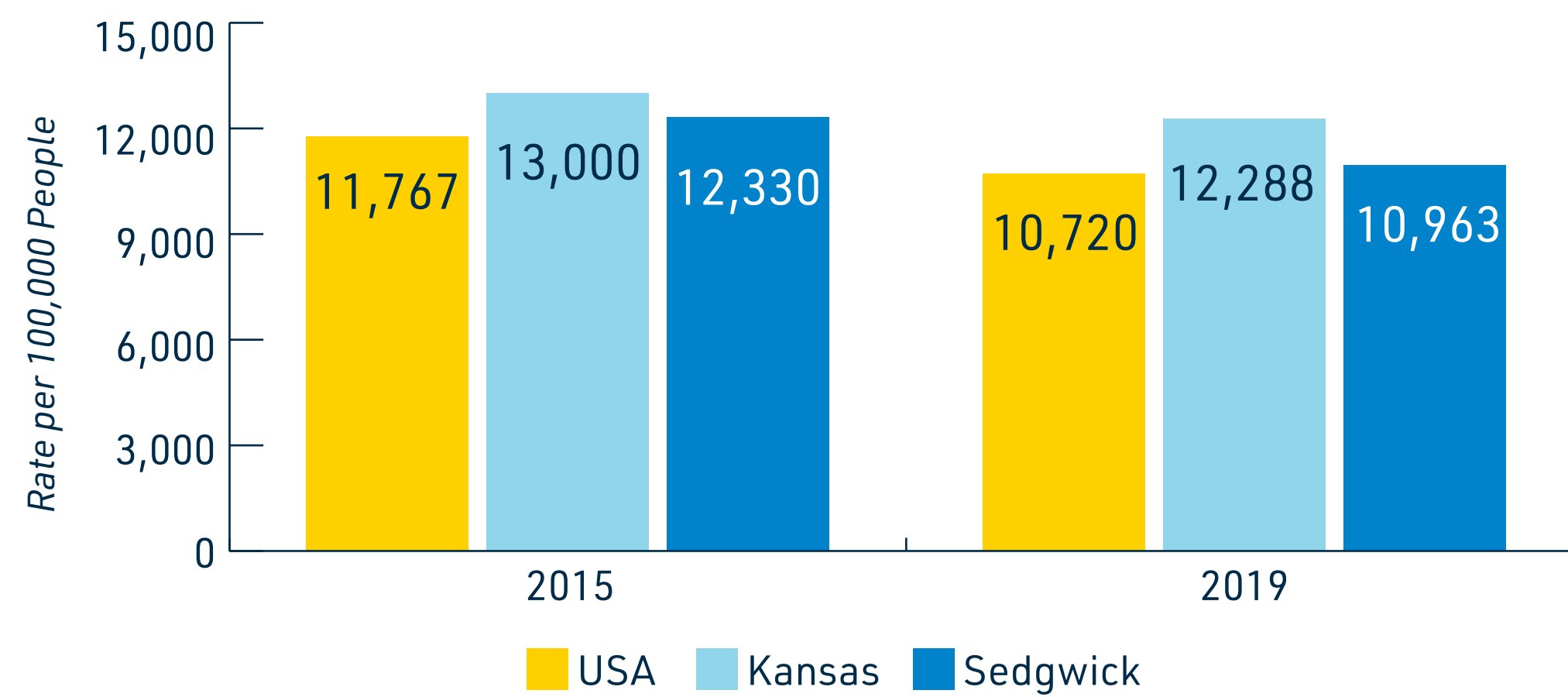


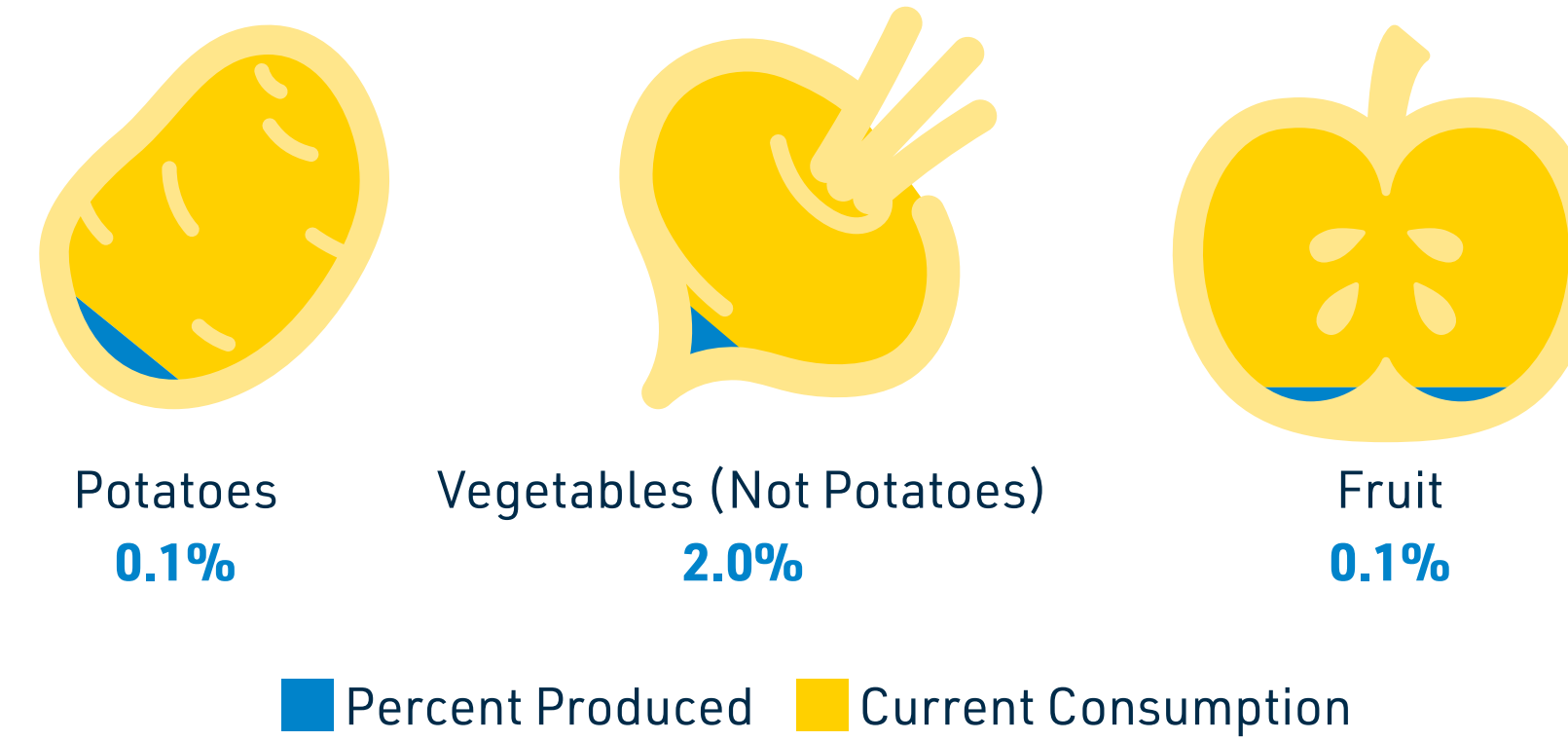

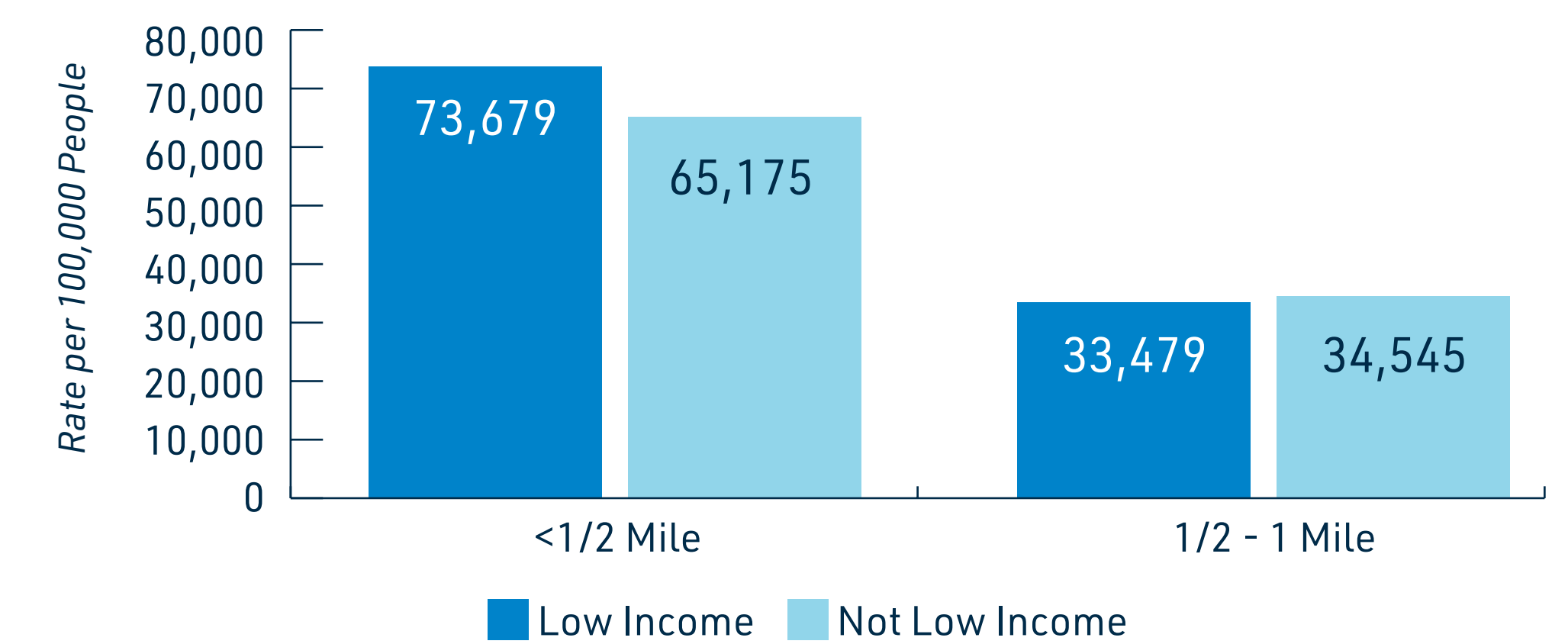

SEDGWICK COUNTY FOOD PRODUCTION/CONSUMPTION



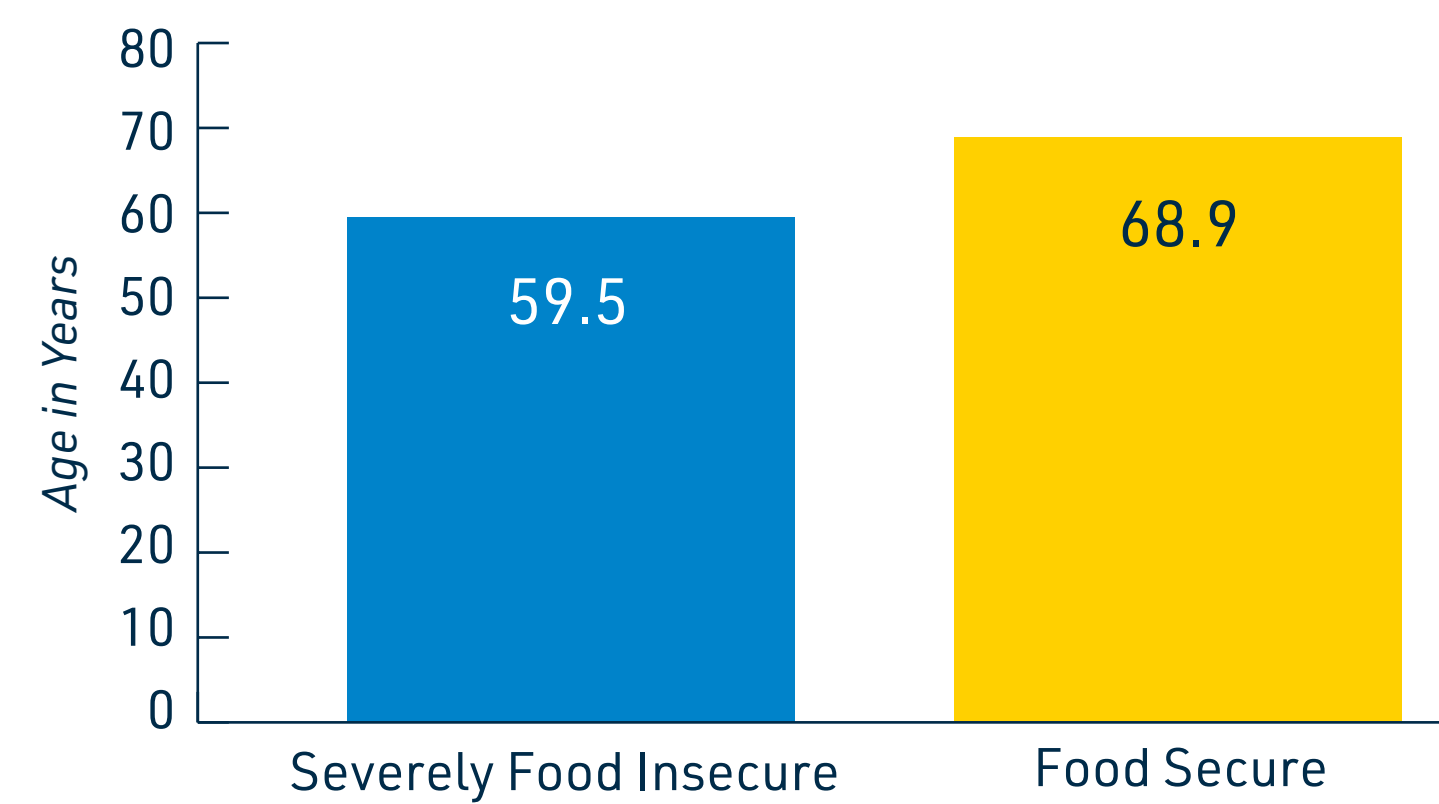

SEDGWICK COUNTY RESIDENTS BY RESIDENTIAL DISTANCE FROM A SUPERMARKET



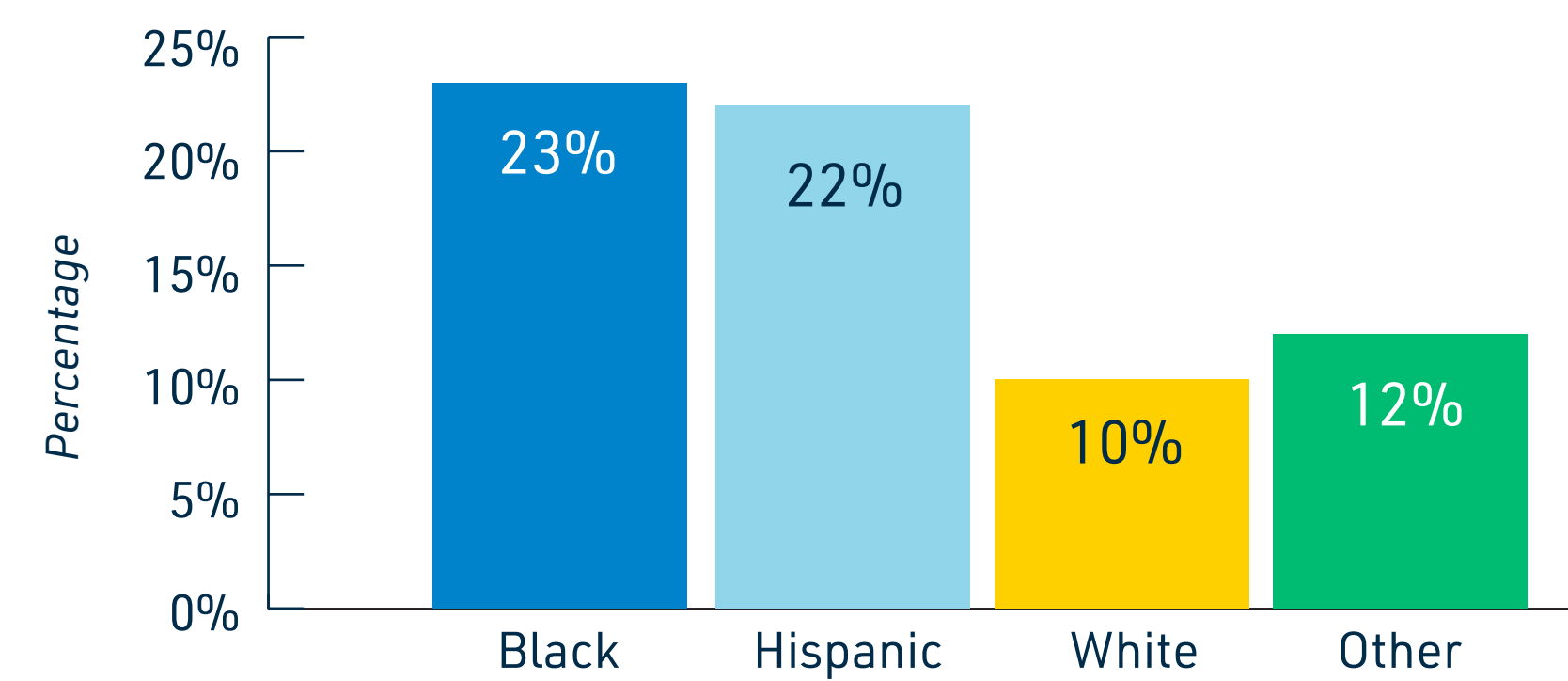

AVERAGE LIFE EXPECTANCY AMONG PEOPLE REPORTING FOOD INSECURITY IN CANADA



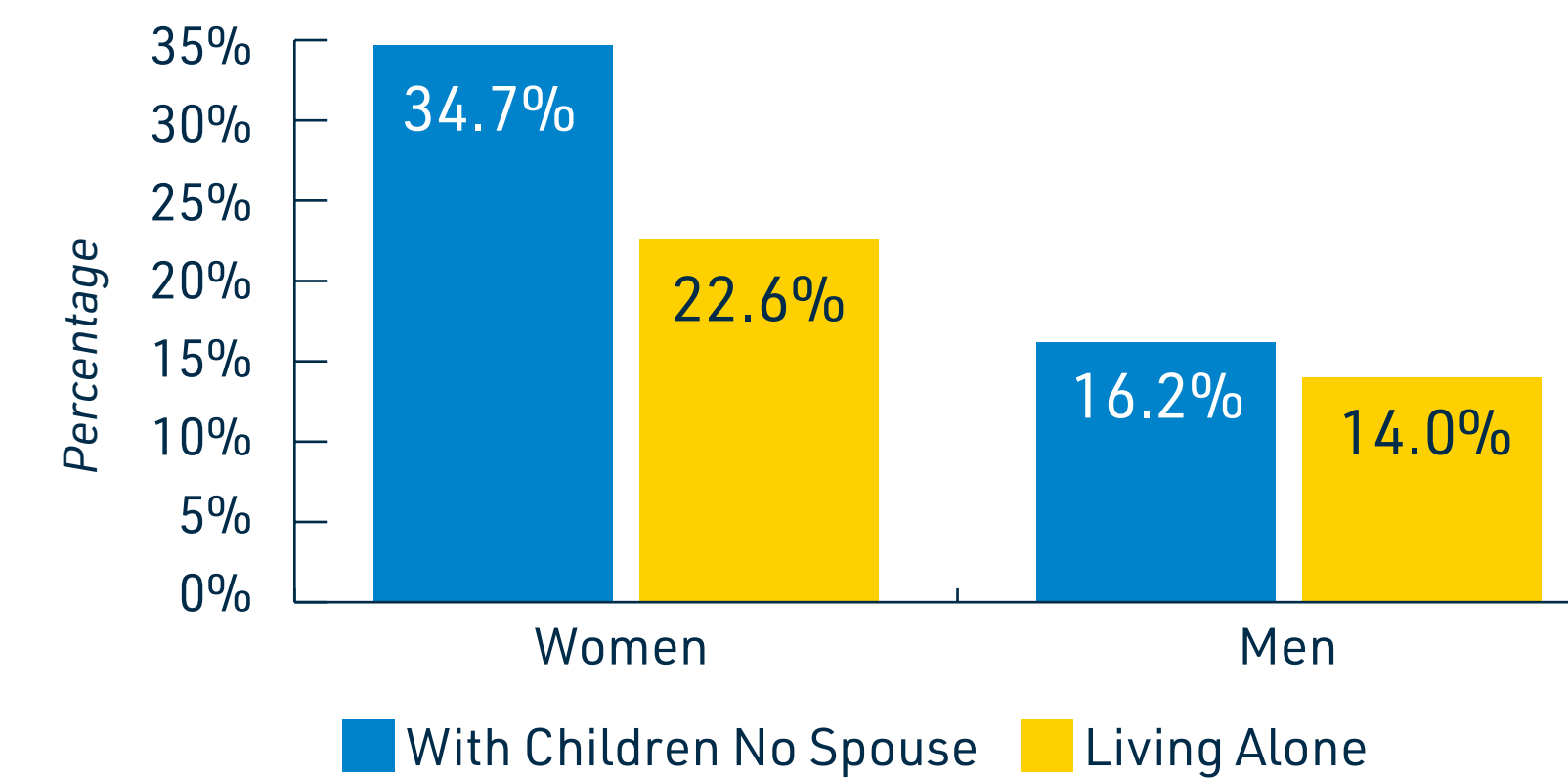

PERCENTAGE OF US RESIDENTS WHO ARE FOOD INSECURE BY GENDER



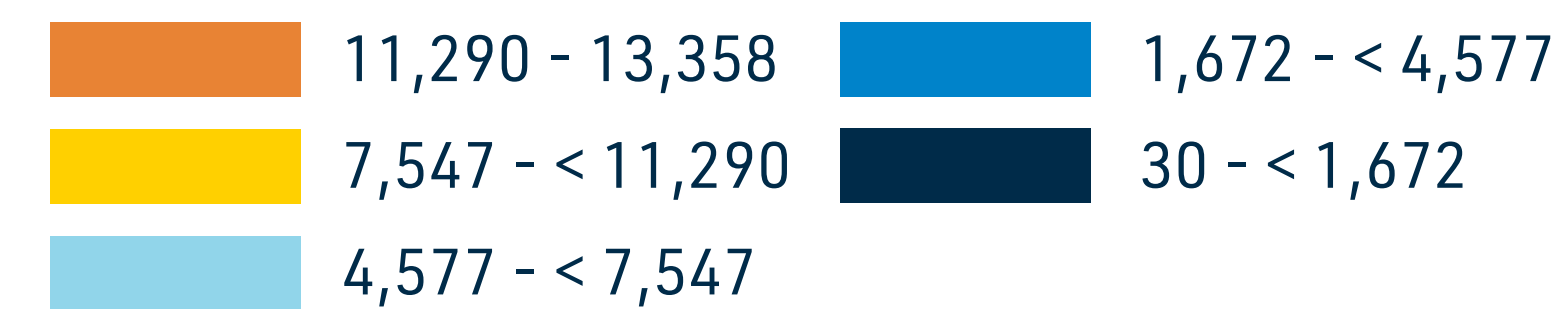
