

Ron Paschal Bio

Ron Paschal is a Deputy District Attorney who supervises the Juvenile Division of the Office of the District Attorney. As the supervisor of the division, Mr. Paschal oversees the Offender/Child In Need of Care (CINC) programs of the office at 1900 E. Morris in Wichita. He also serves as Ethics Coordinator of the Office of the District Attorney. Mr. Paschal has been with the District Attorney's Office since 1997. He has extensive jury trial experience both as a prosecutor and as defense counsel. He lectures frequently at the State and National level on topics such as attorney ethics and trial advocacy.

Mr. Paschal completed his undergraduate degree in the Administration of Justice from Wichita State University and his Juris Doctorate degree from Washburn University School of Law. He is currently president of the Kansas County and District Attorneys Association and chairman of the Kansas Criminal Justice Section Grievance and Ethics Committee for the Kansas Board of Discipline for Attorneys. Mr. Paschal is currently a member of the American Bar Association, the Kansas County and District Attorney's Association, and the Wichita Bar Association.
