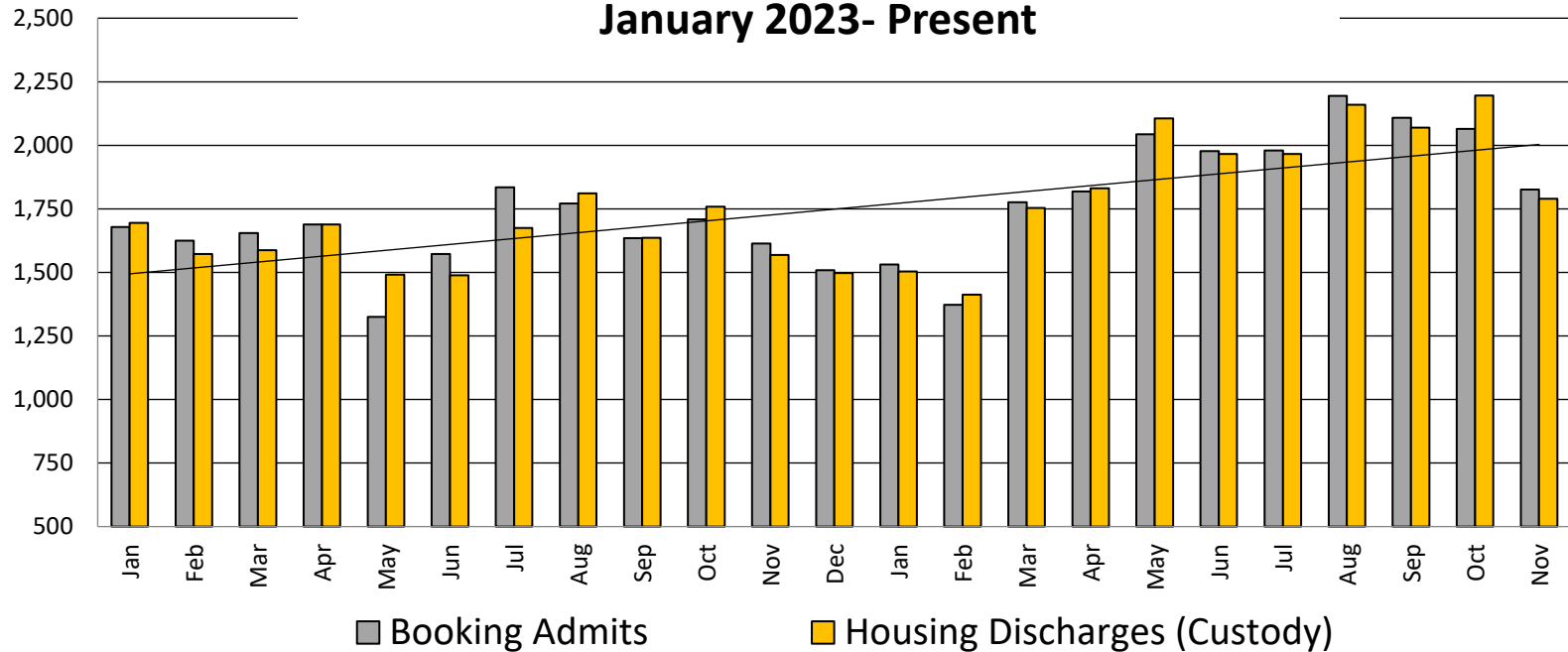

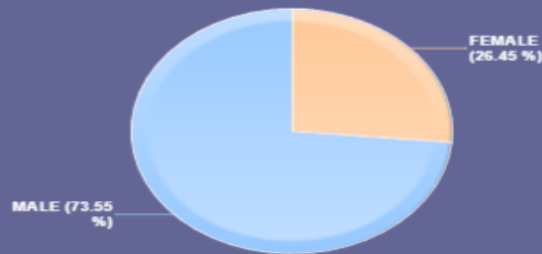

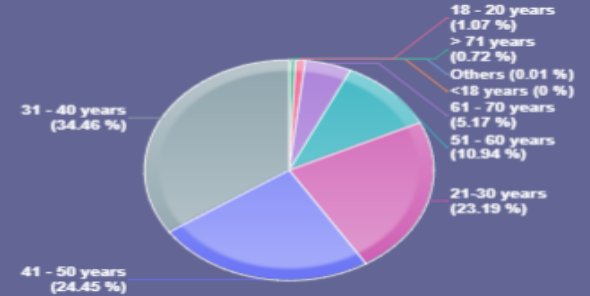

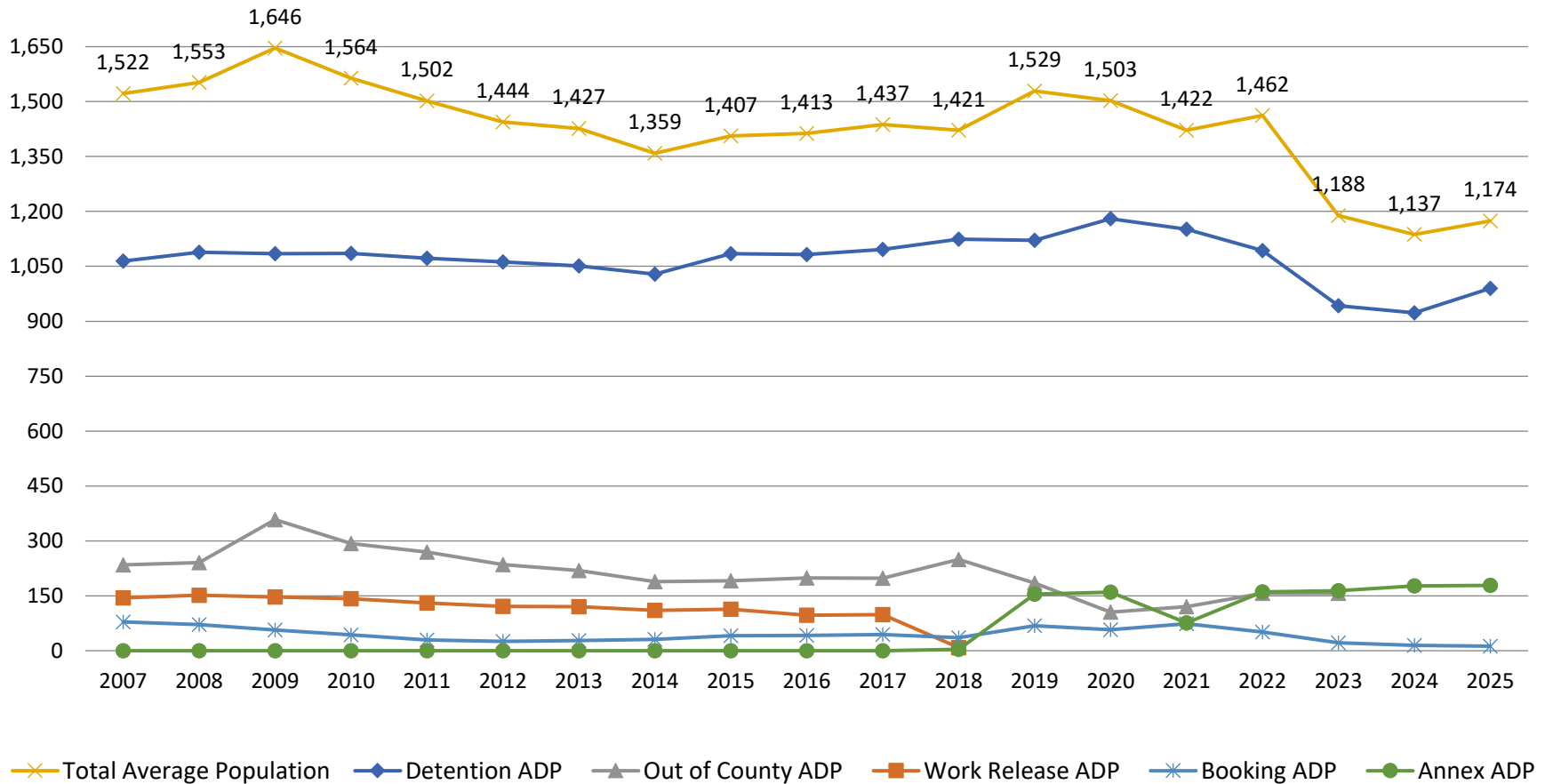

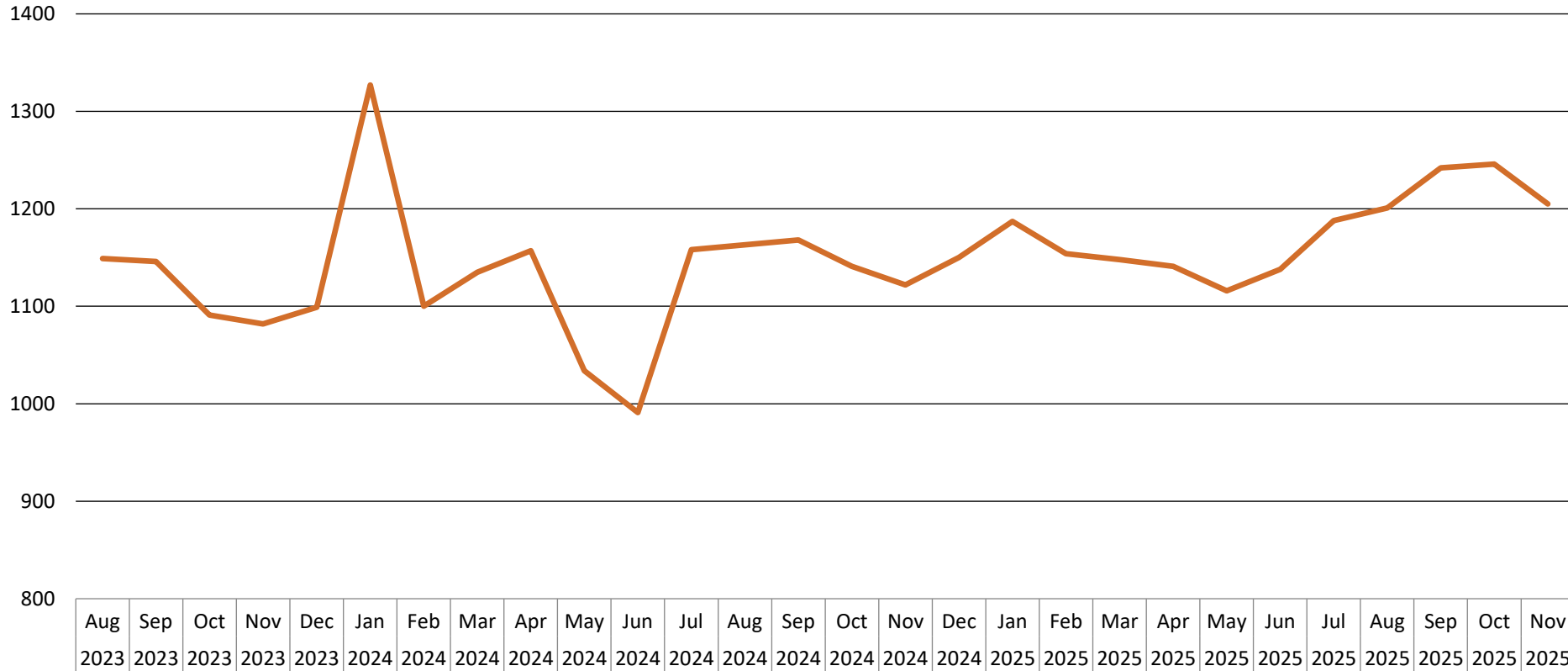

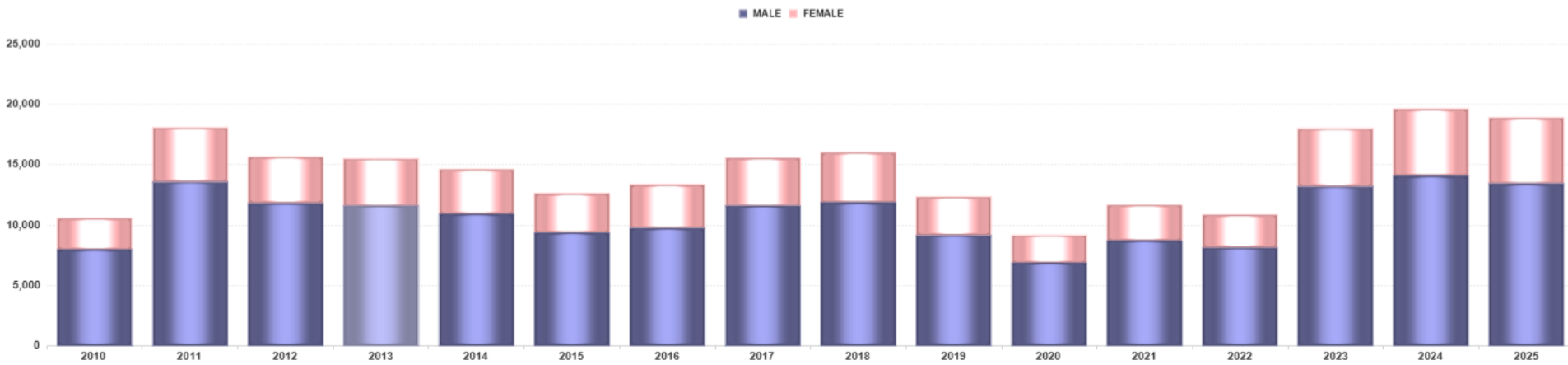

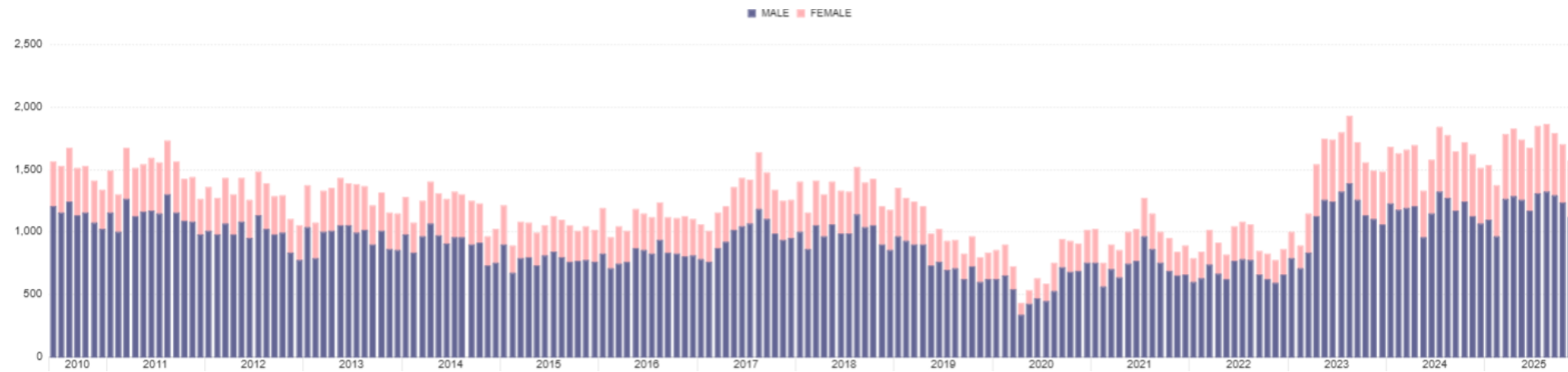

Adult Detention Arrest – November 2025

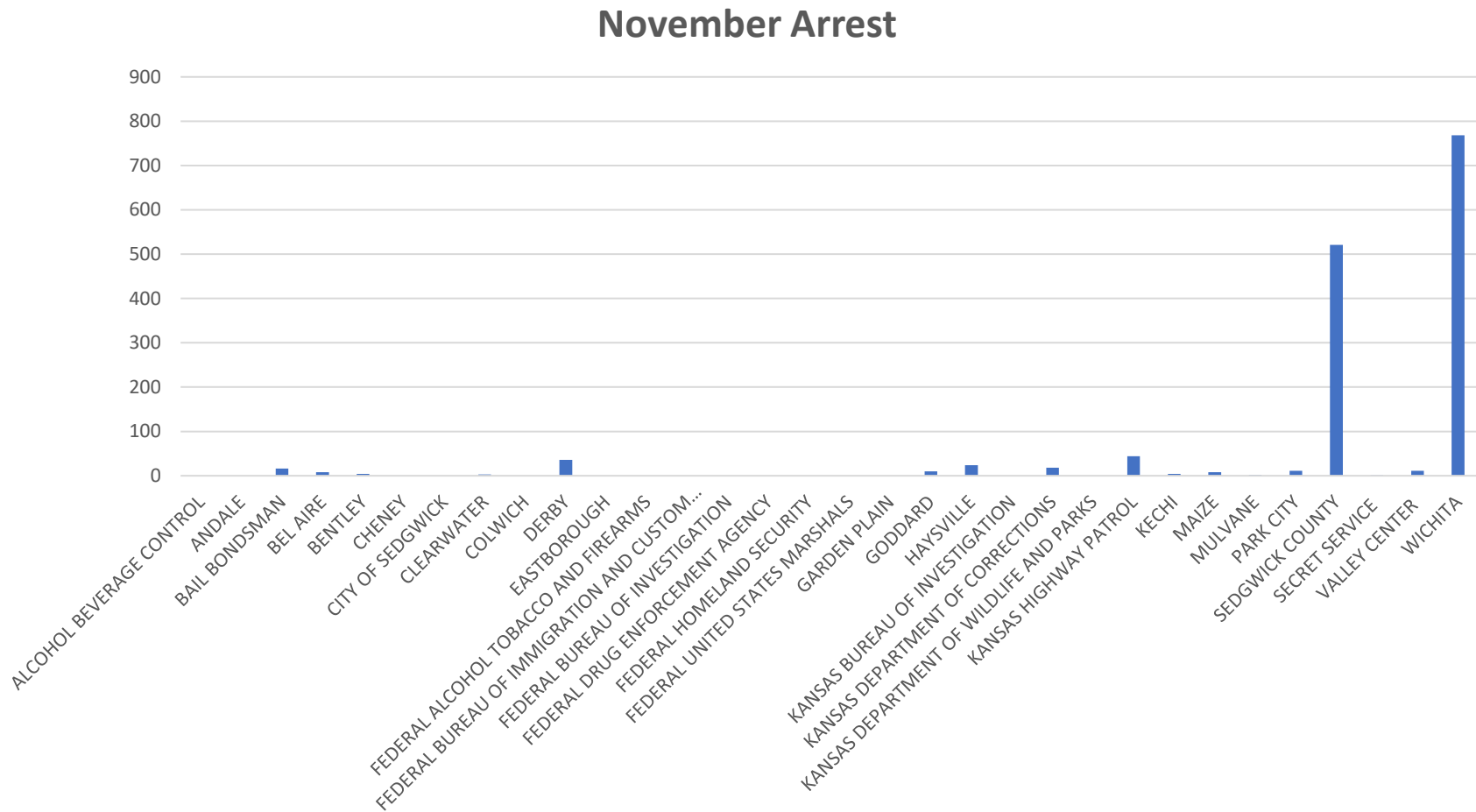

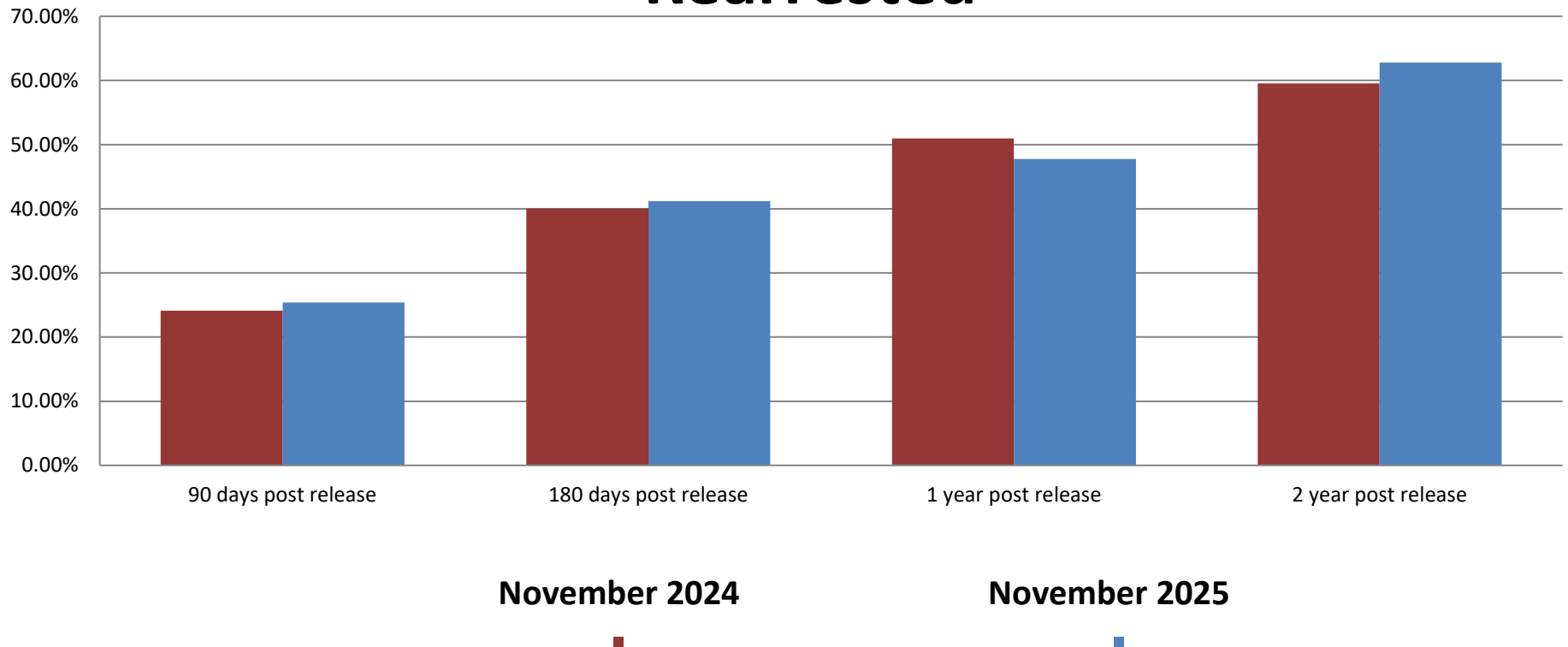

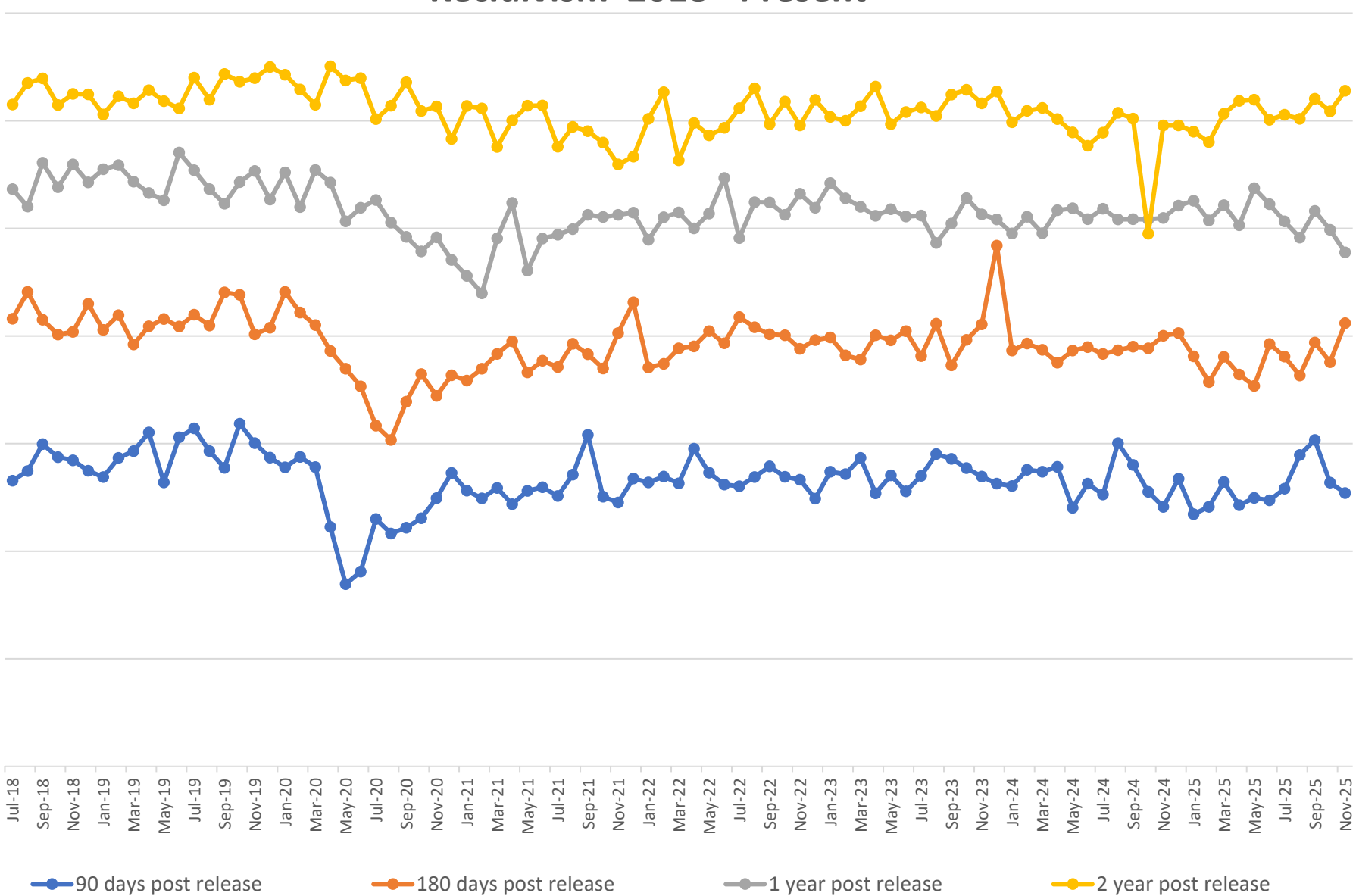
Percent of Released Inmates Rearrested



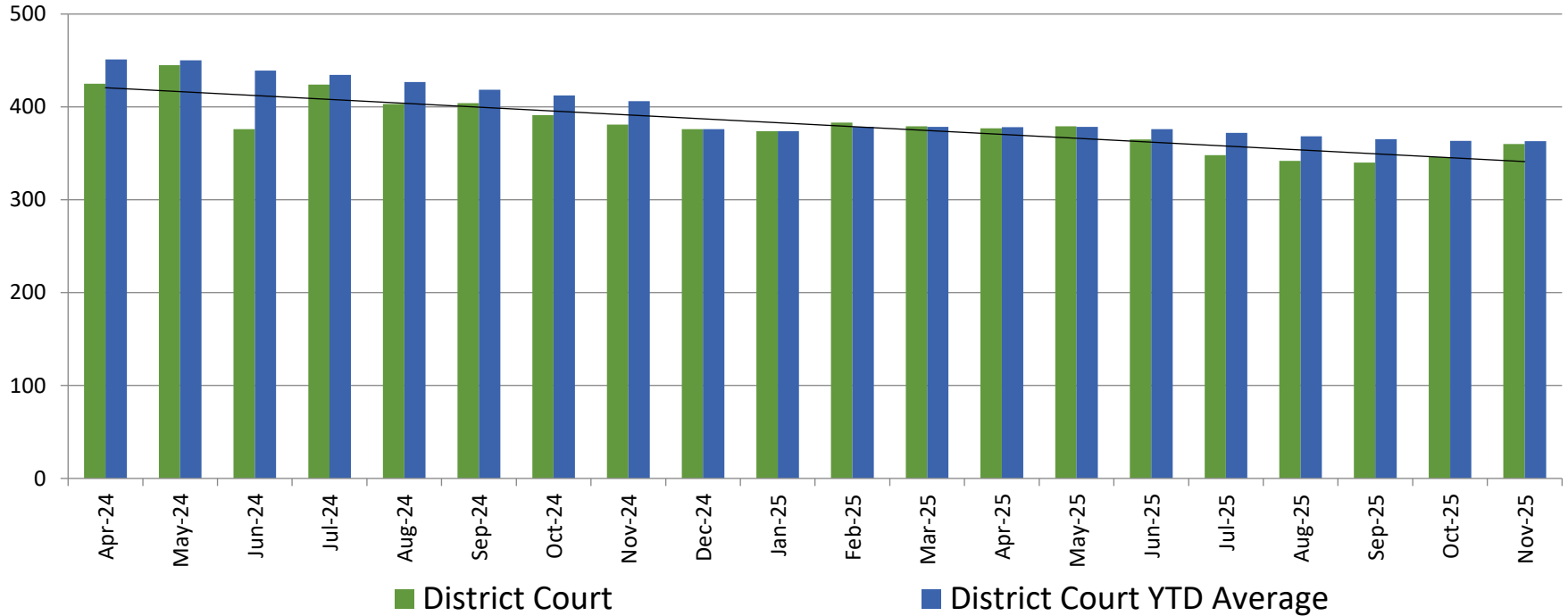

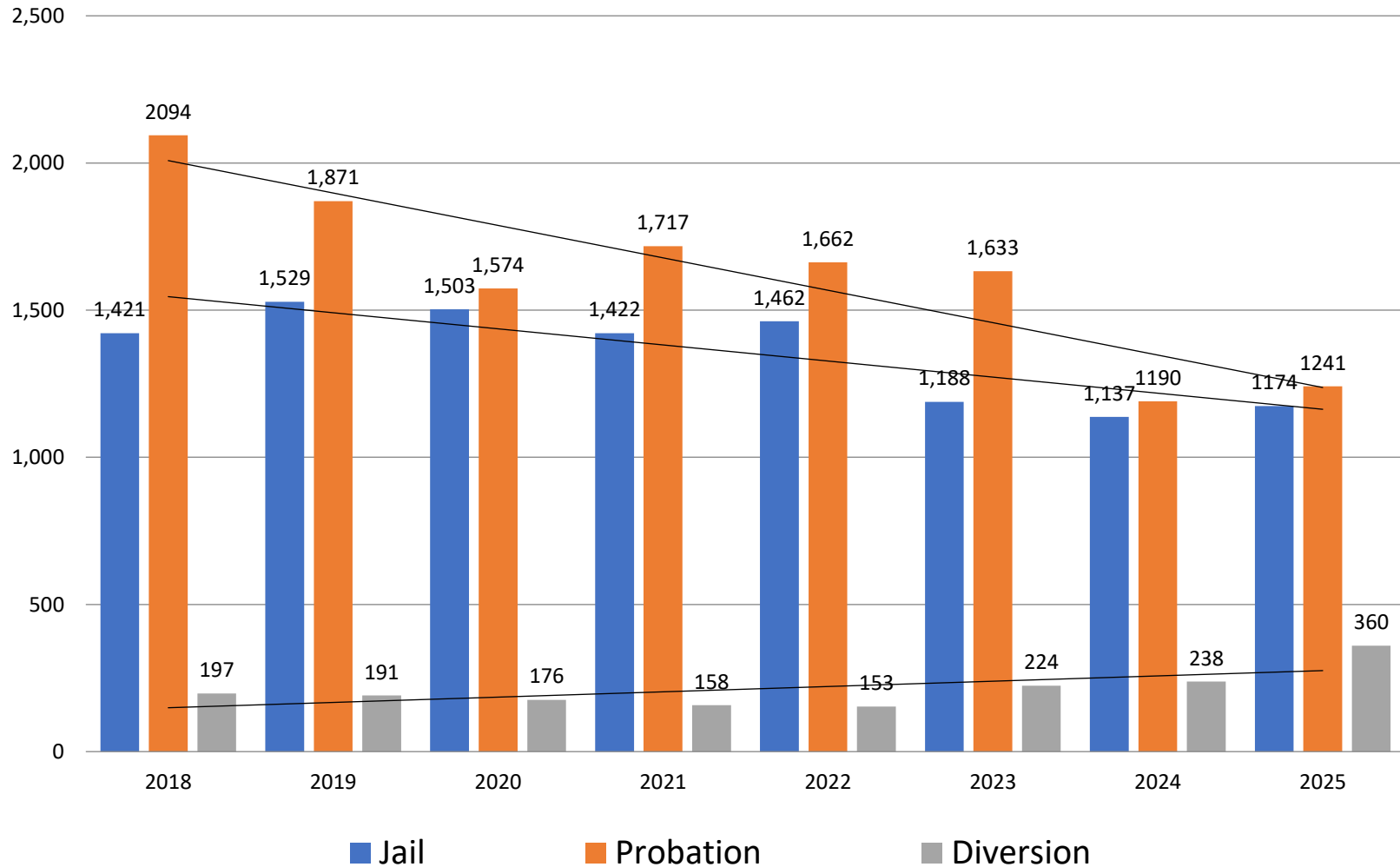

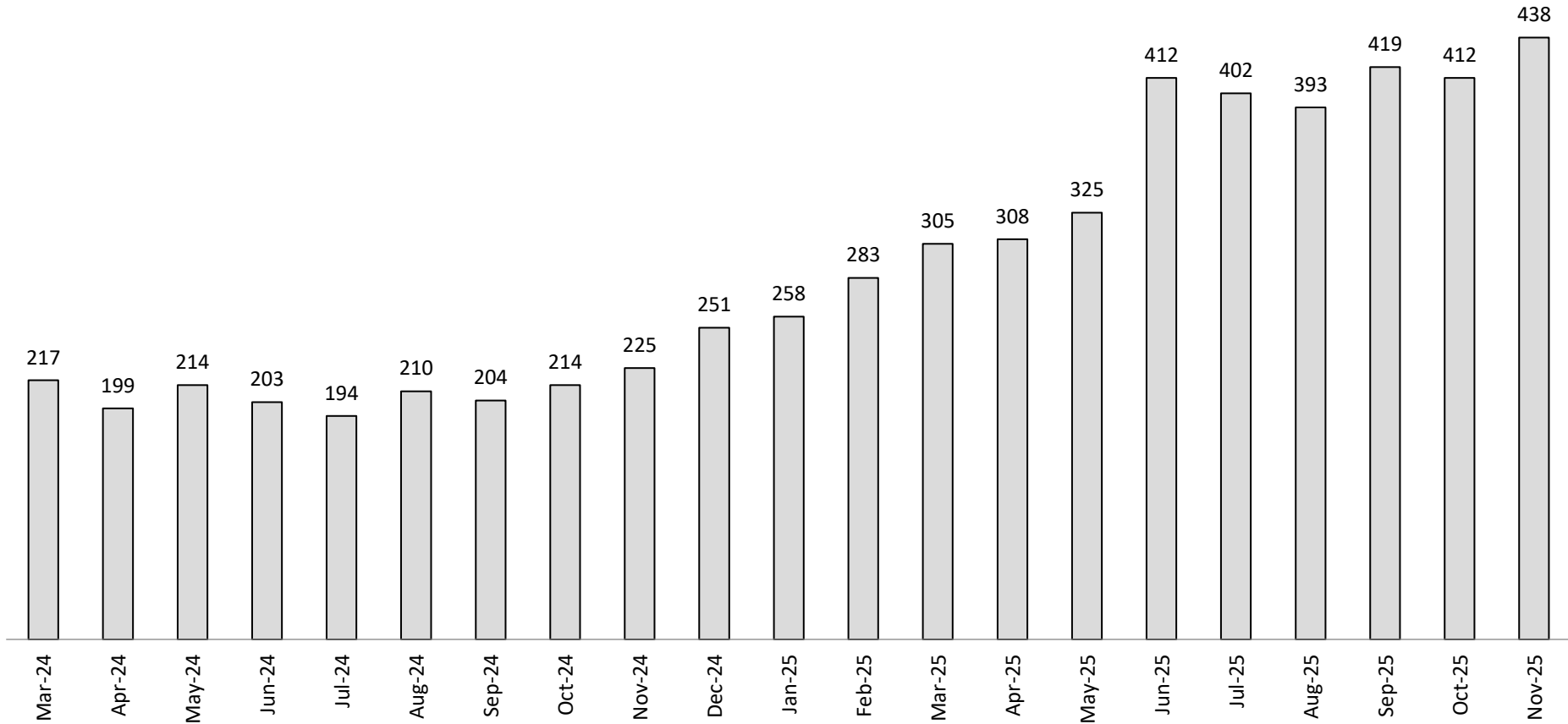

Mental Health ADP Year over Year - November Totals

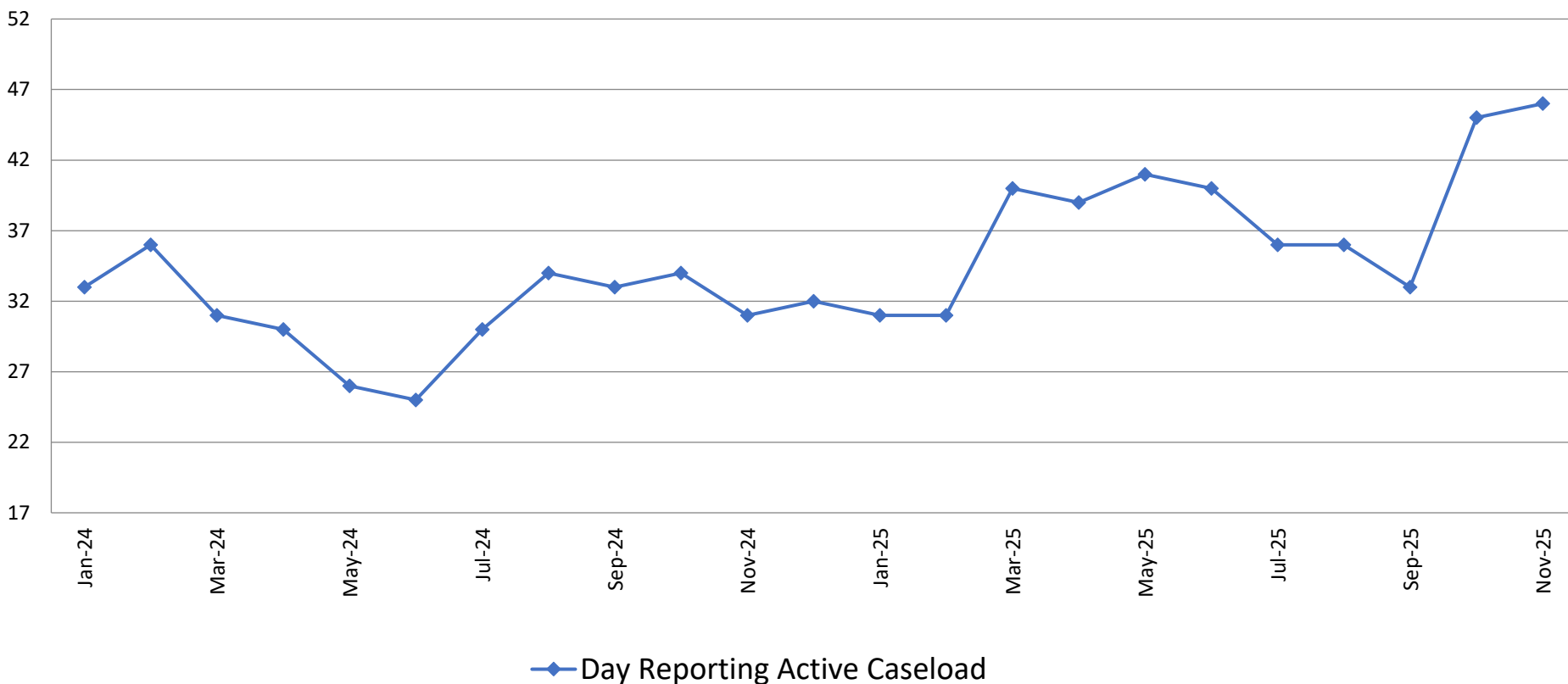

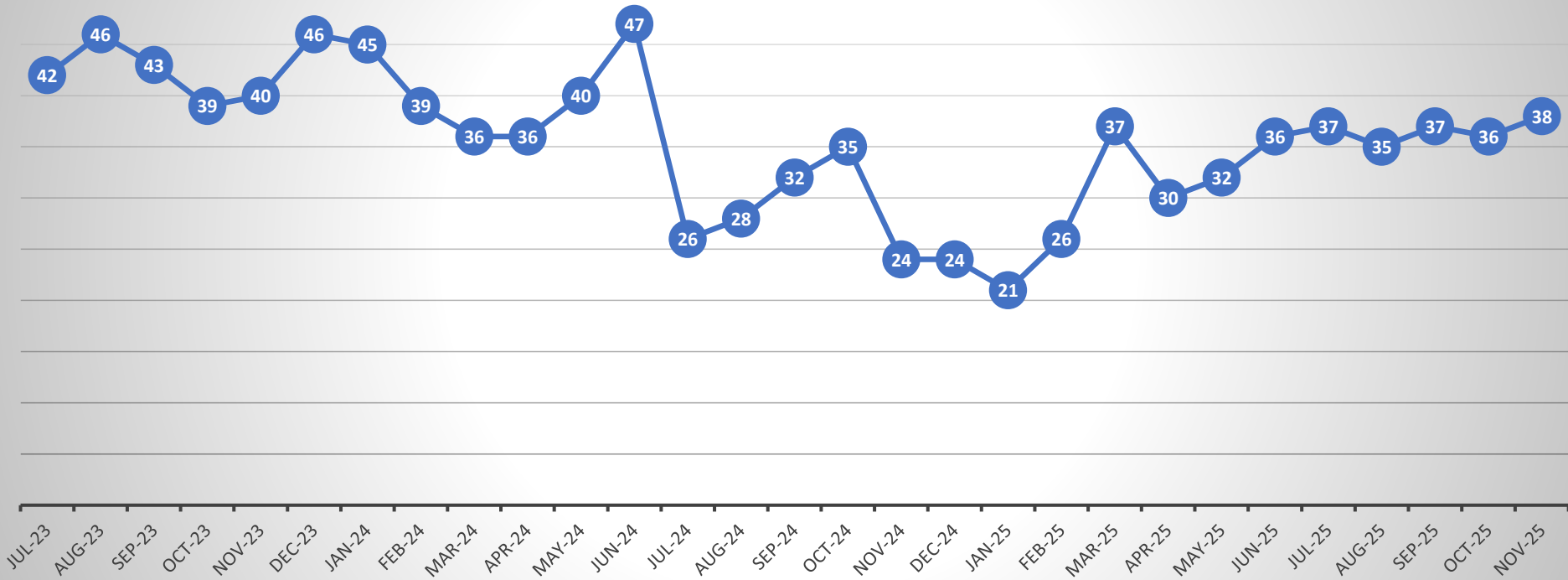

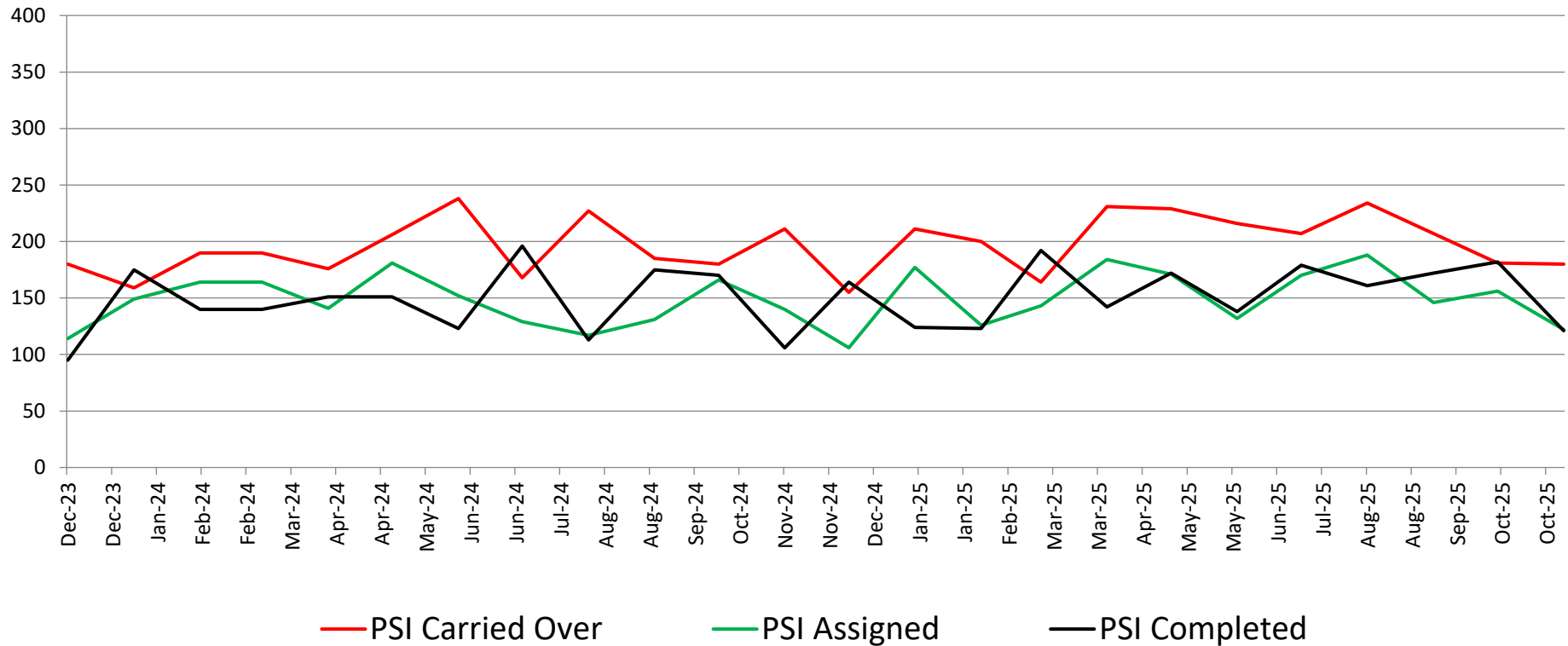

District Court Probation: Pre-Sentence Investigation 2023- present



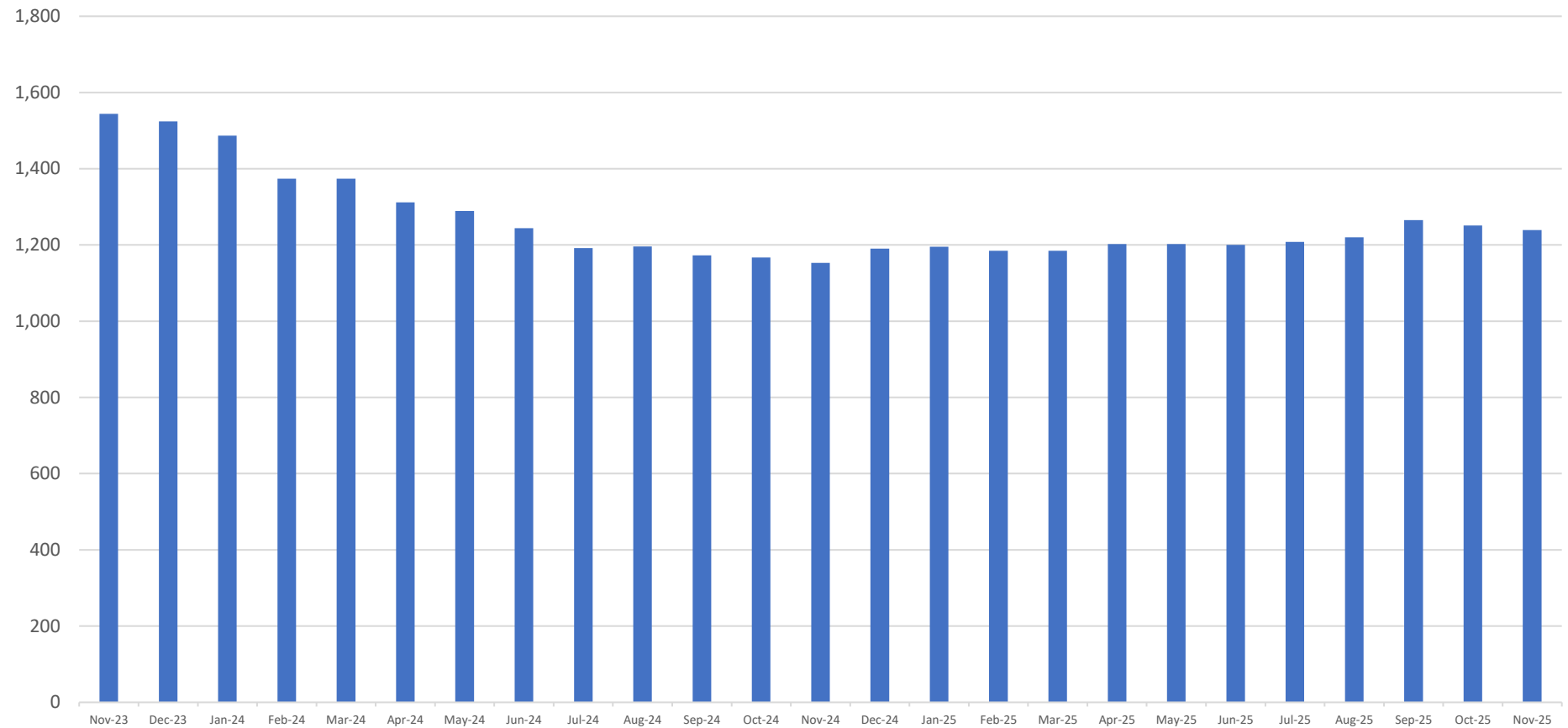

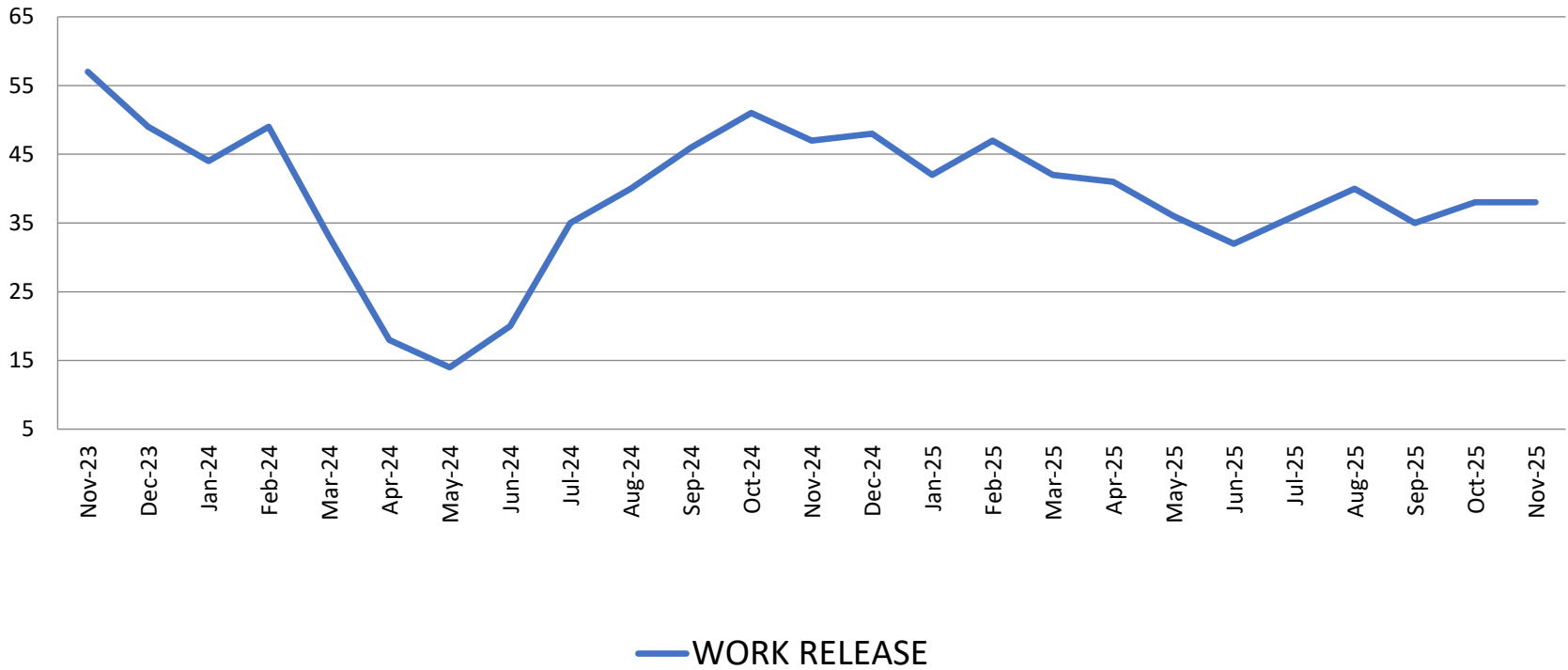

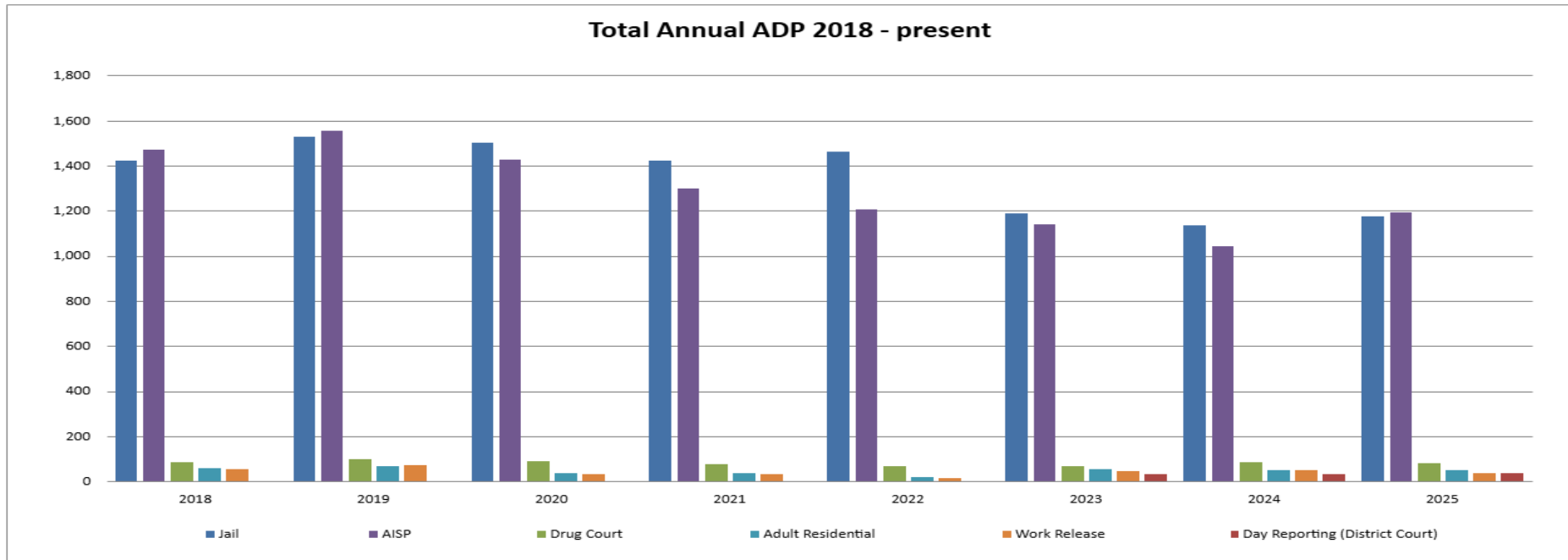

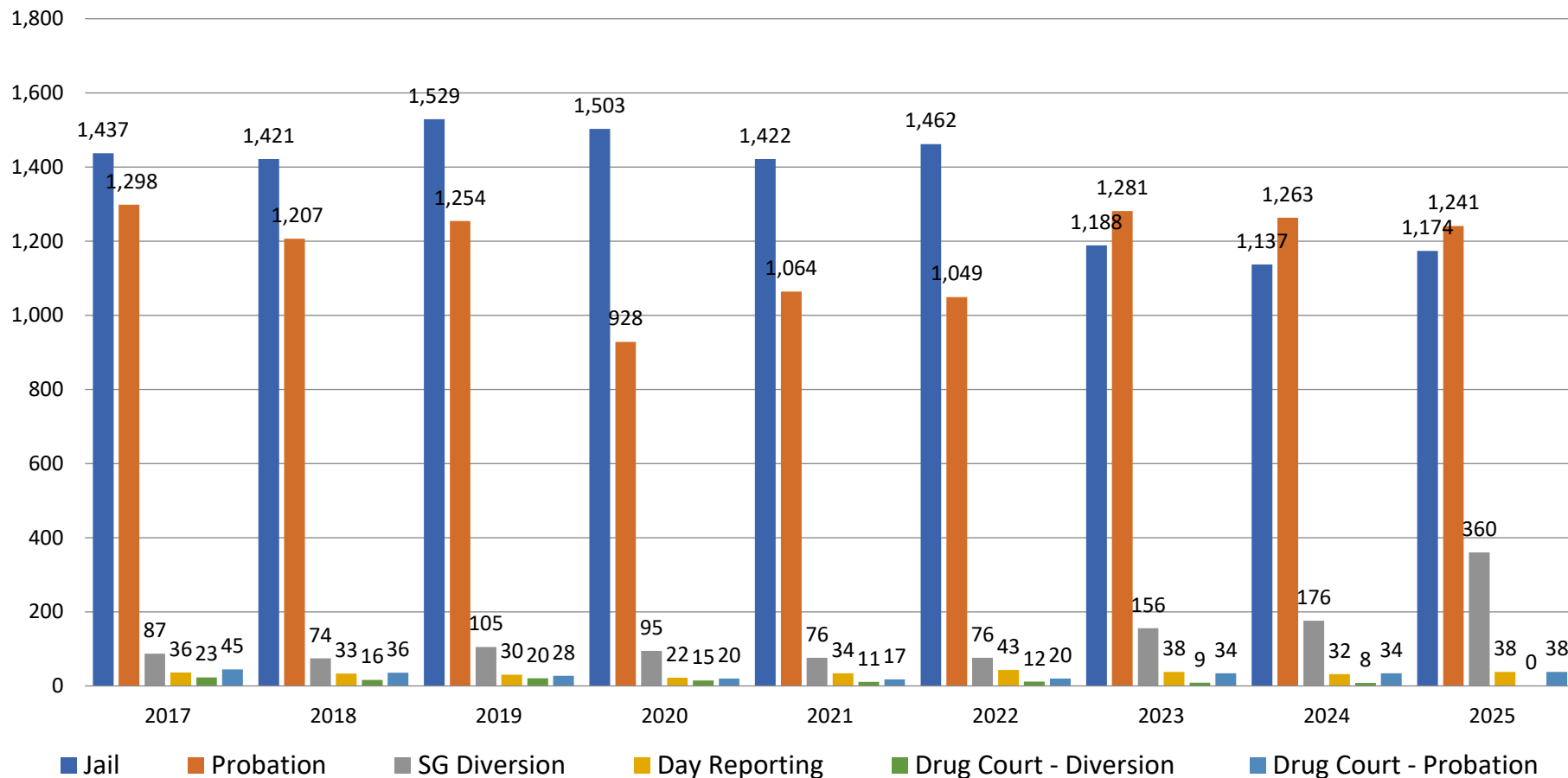
