Two Success Stories

Patient 1 - Had been in case management 3 years total and during her time in FEP, she moved out of the safe house into independent housing, she obtained income and became involved in project independence, including being part of their board. She also just did a lot of hard work in therapy and gained insight and skills to manage and speak about her mental health.

Patient 2 and 3: both had the longest time in the program. They have both obtained income and independent housing in the last quarter

Patient 4: housed after being at the Humankind Inn for over 18 months and experiencing chronic homelessness before that. She was also able to obtain income during her time in FEP services before successfully discharging.



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
