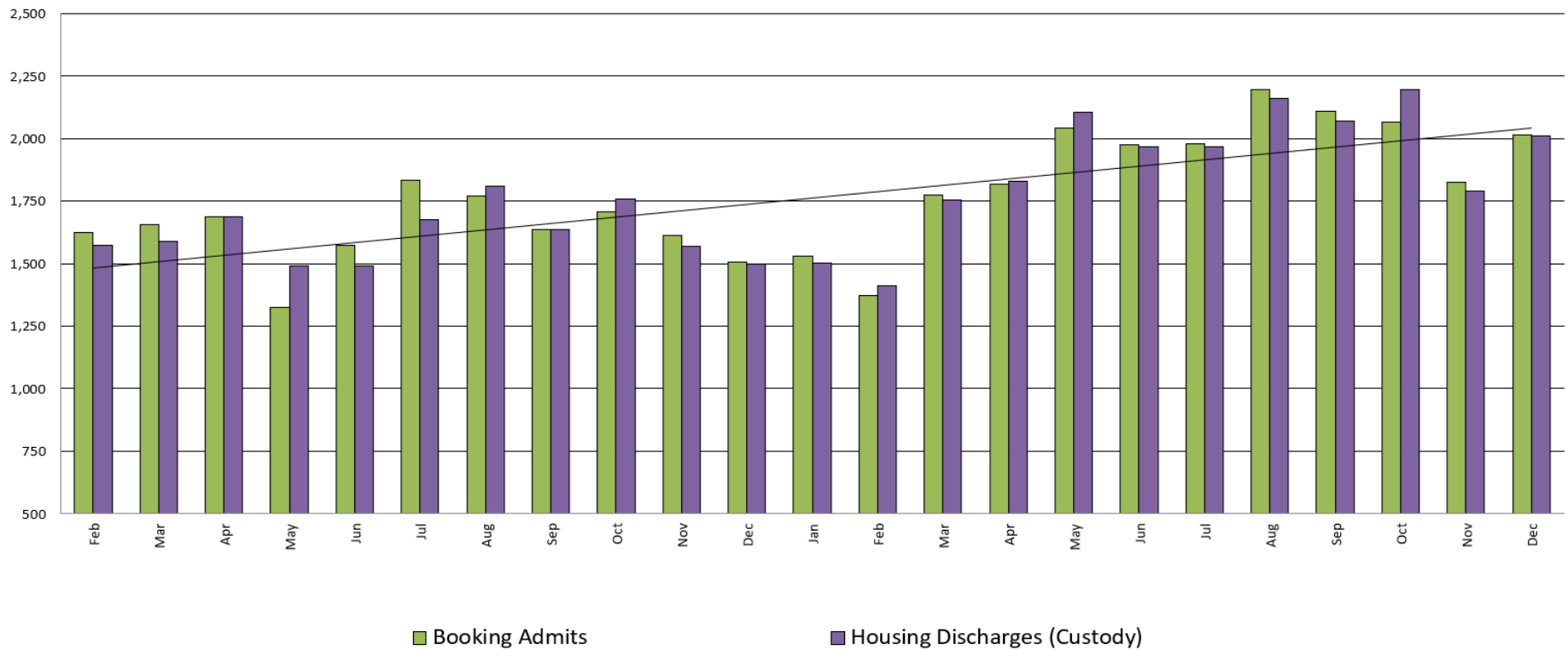

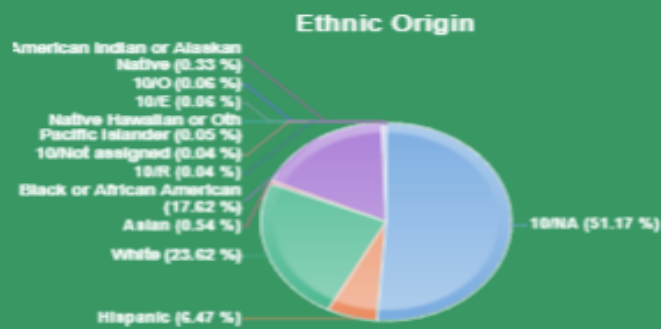

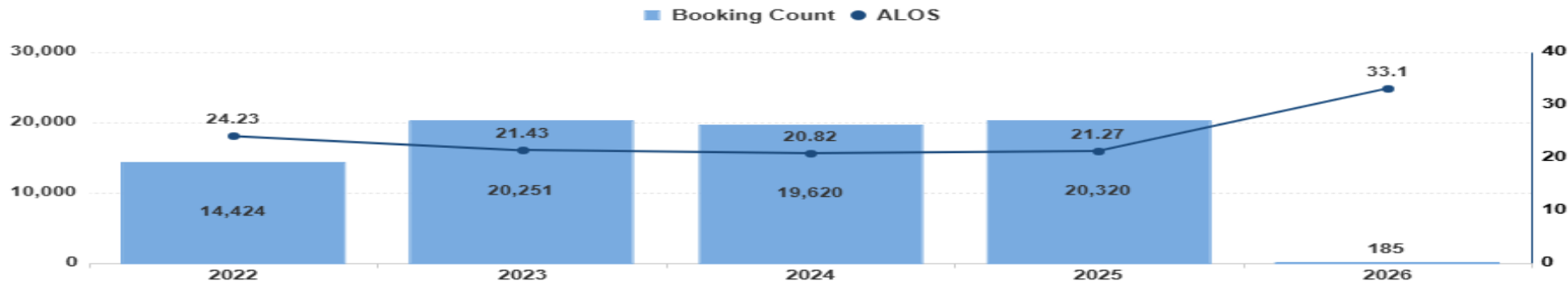

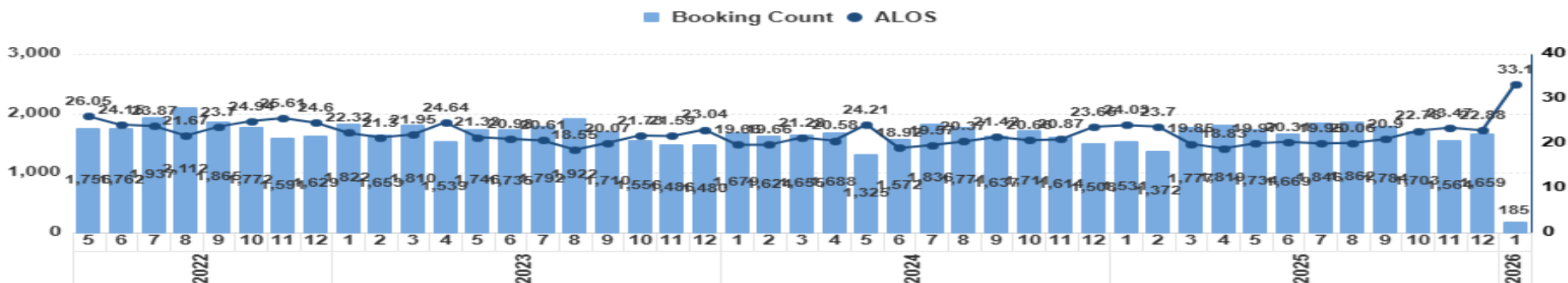
Average Daily Jail Population

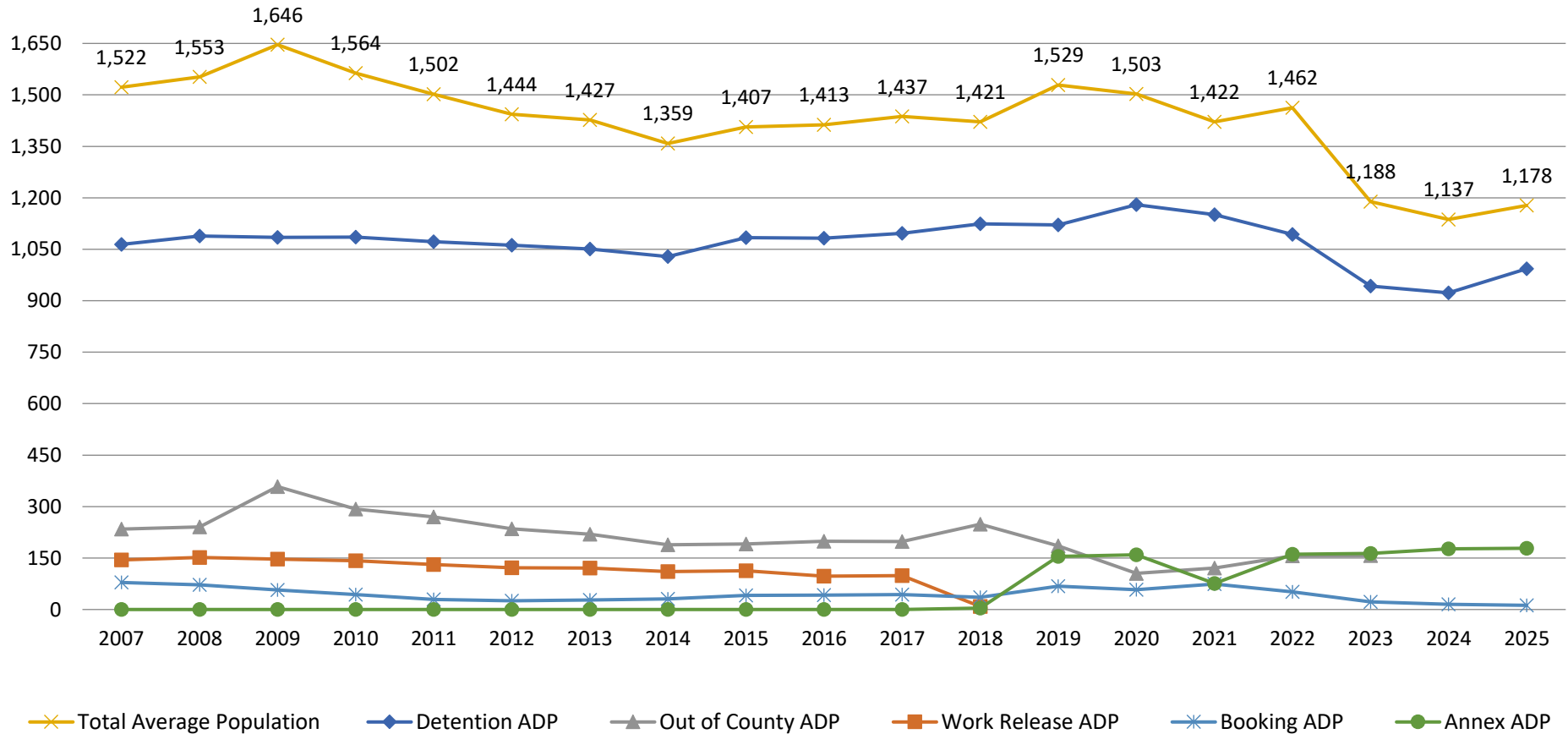

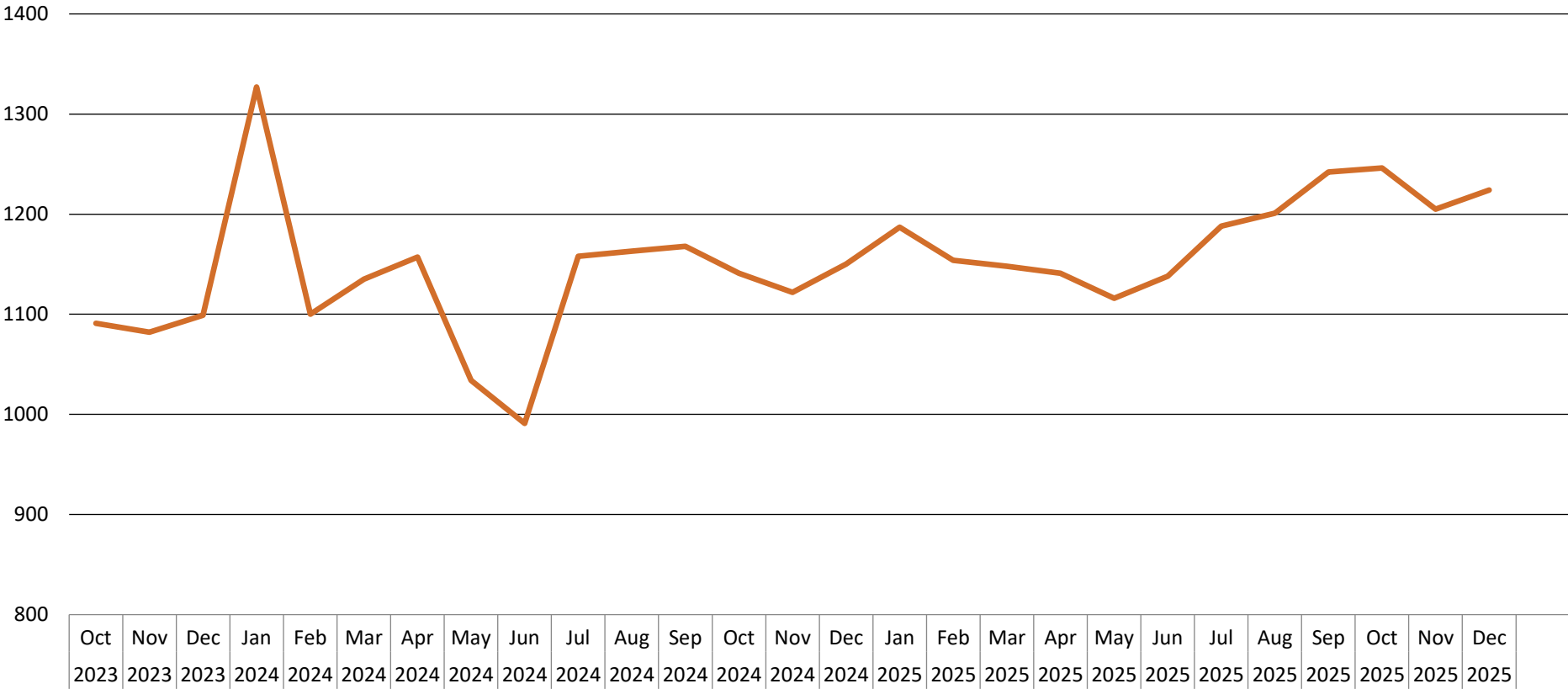

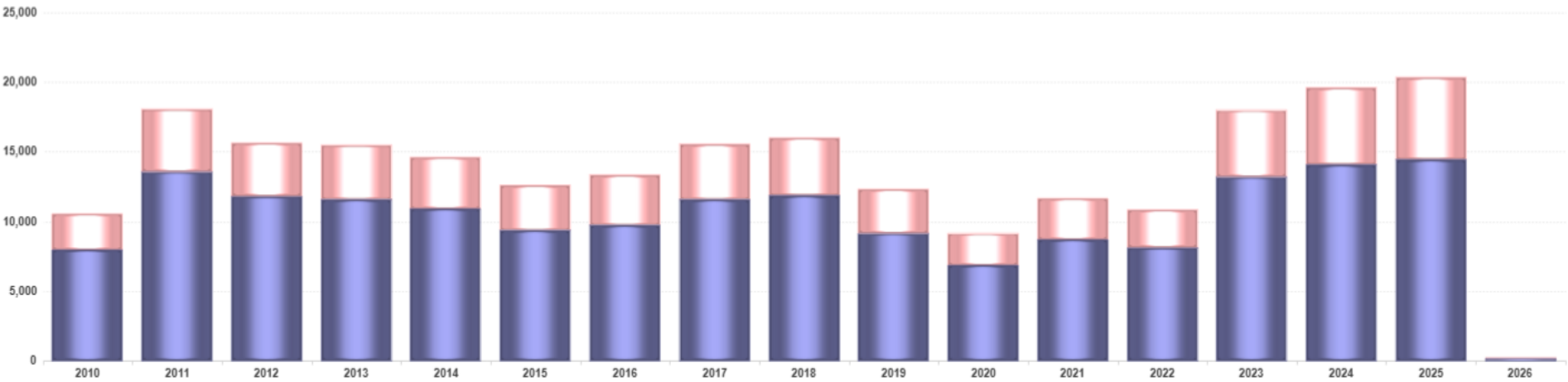

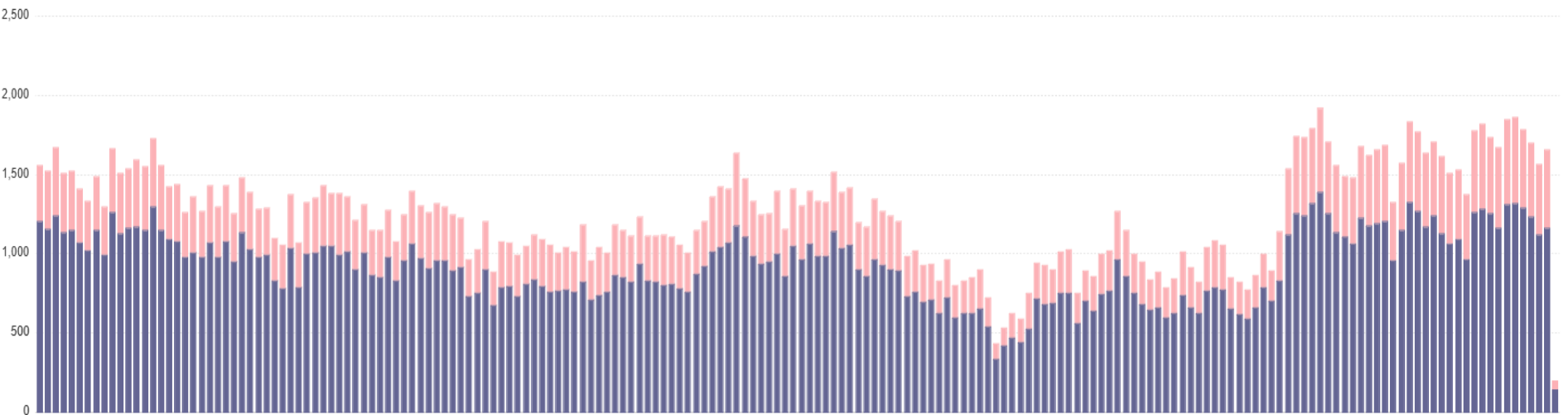
Booking by Year

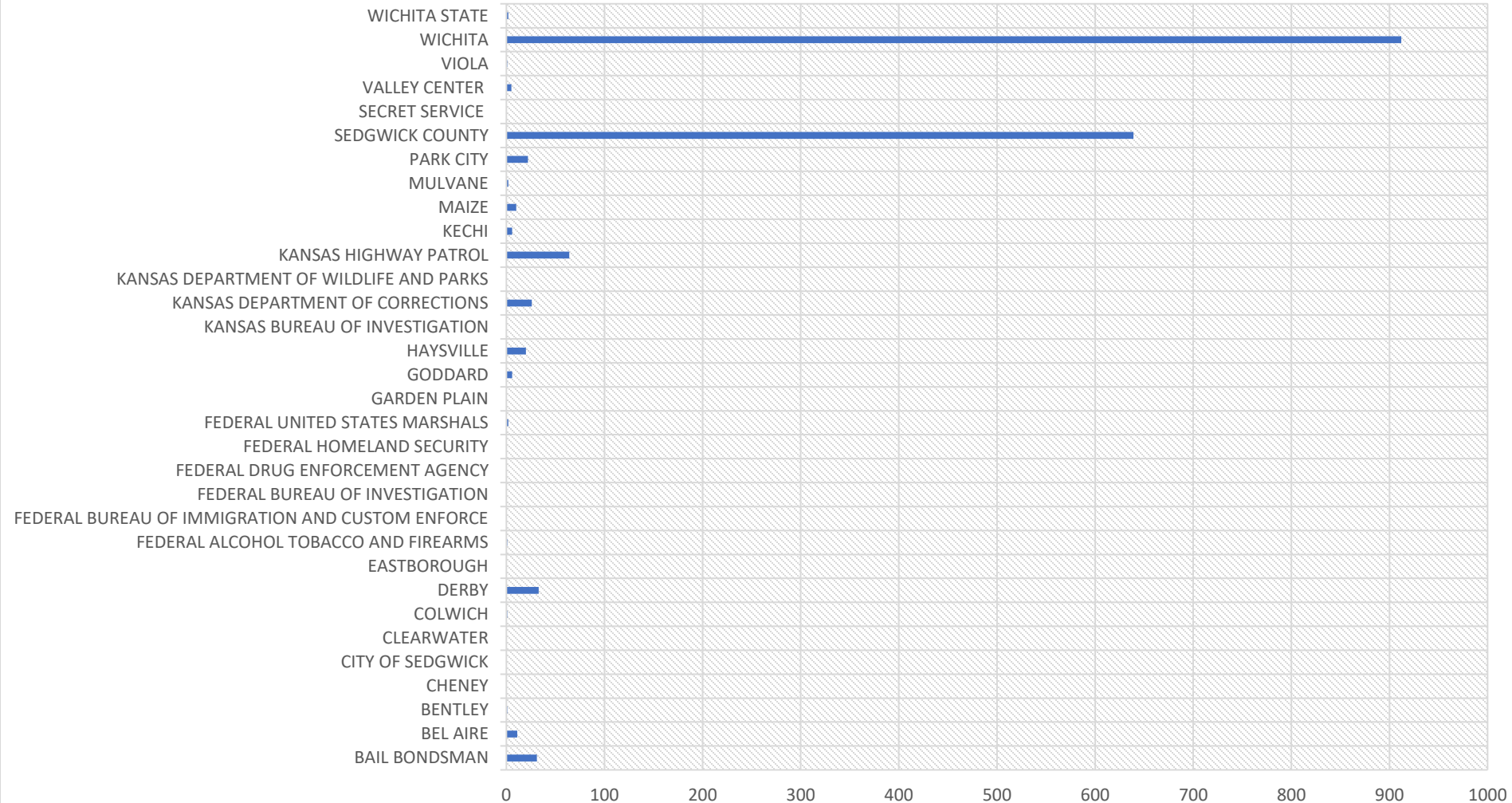

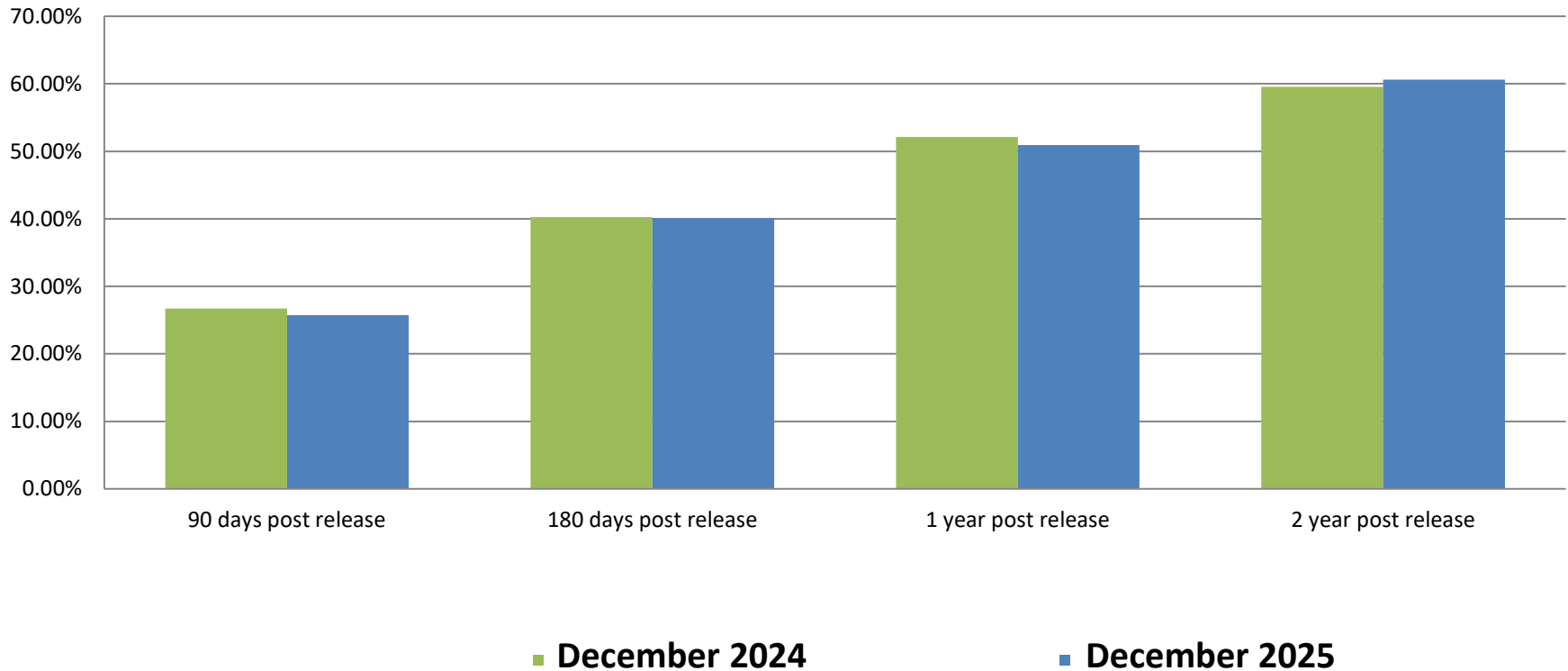

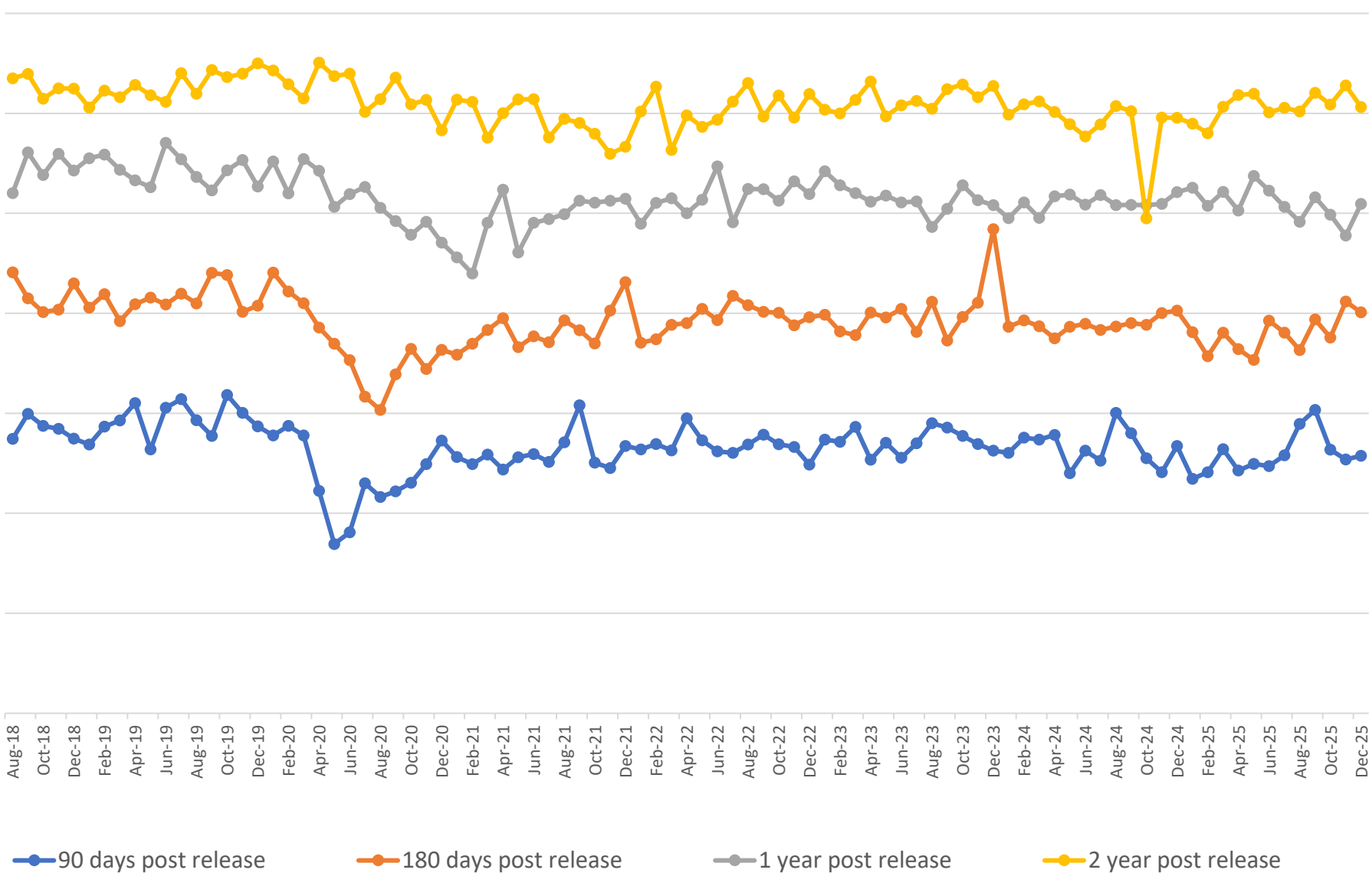
Percent of Released Inmates Rearrested December 2024 and 2025



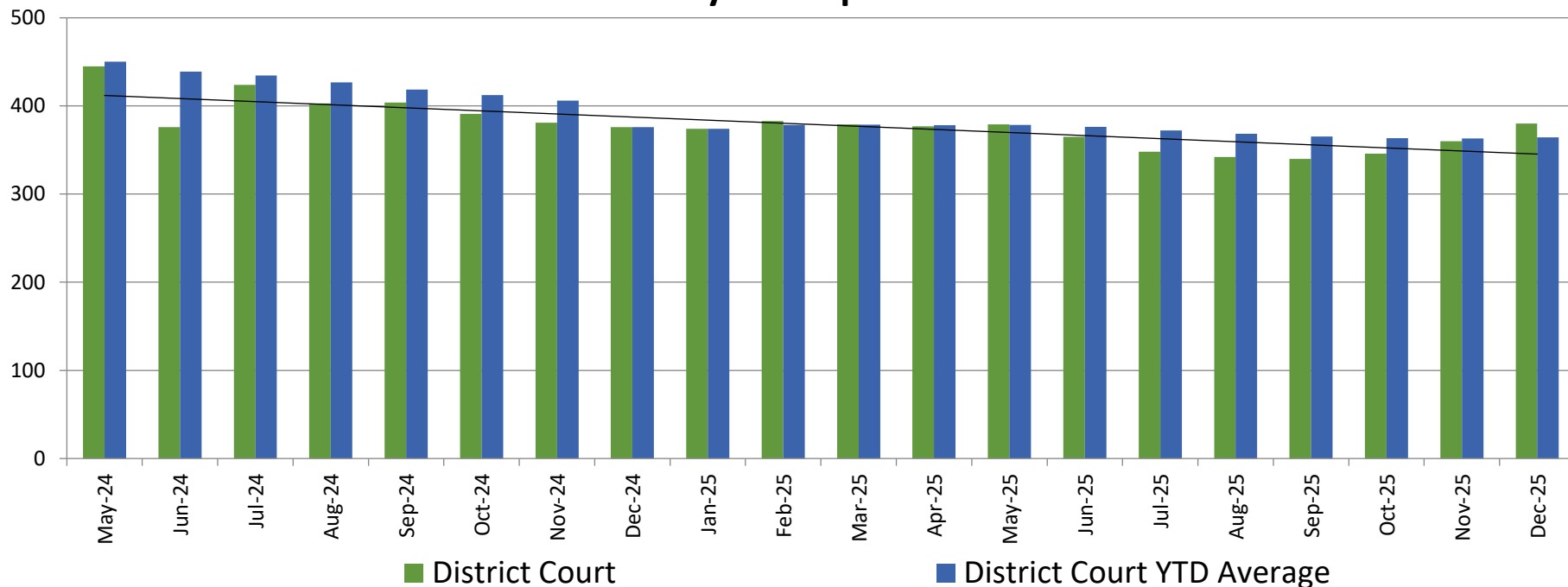

Pretrial Services Program (PSP) Monthly ADP: May 2024- present



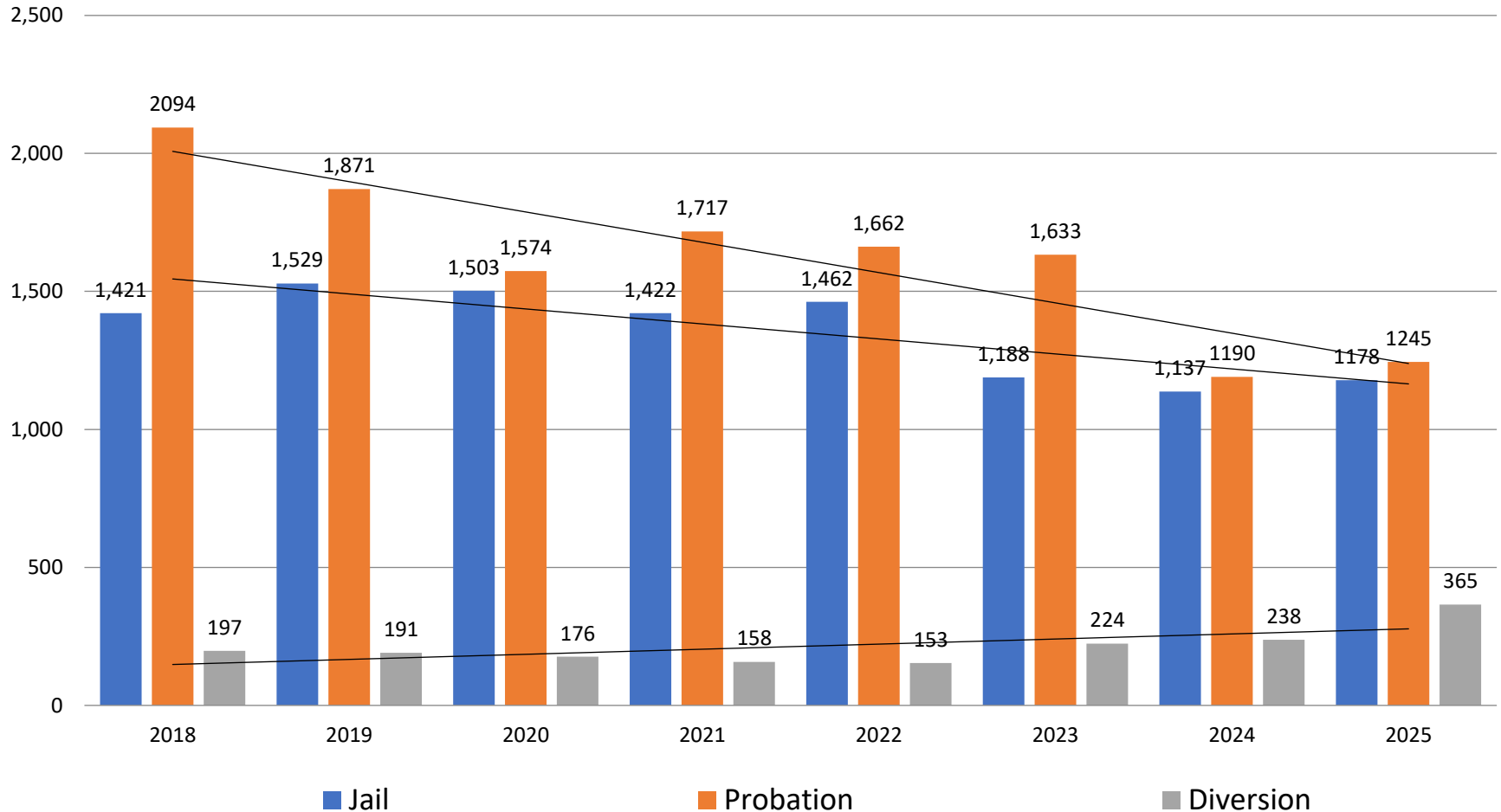

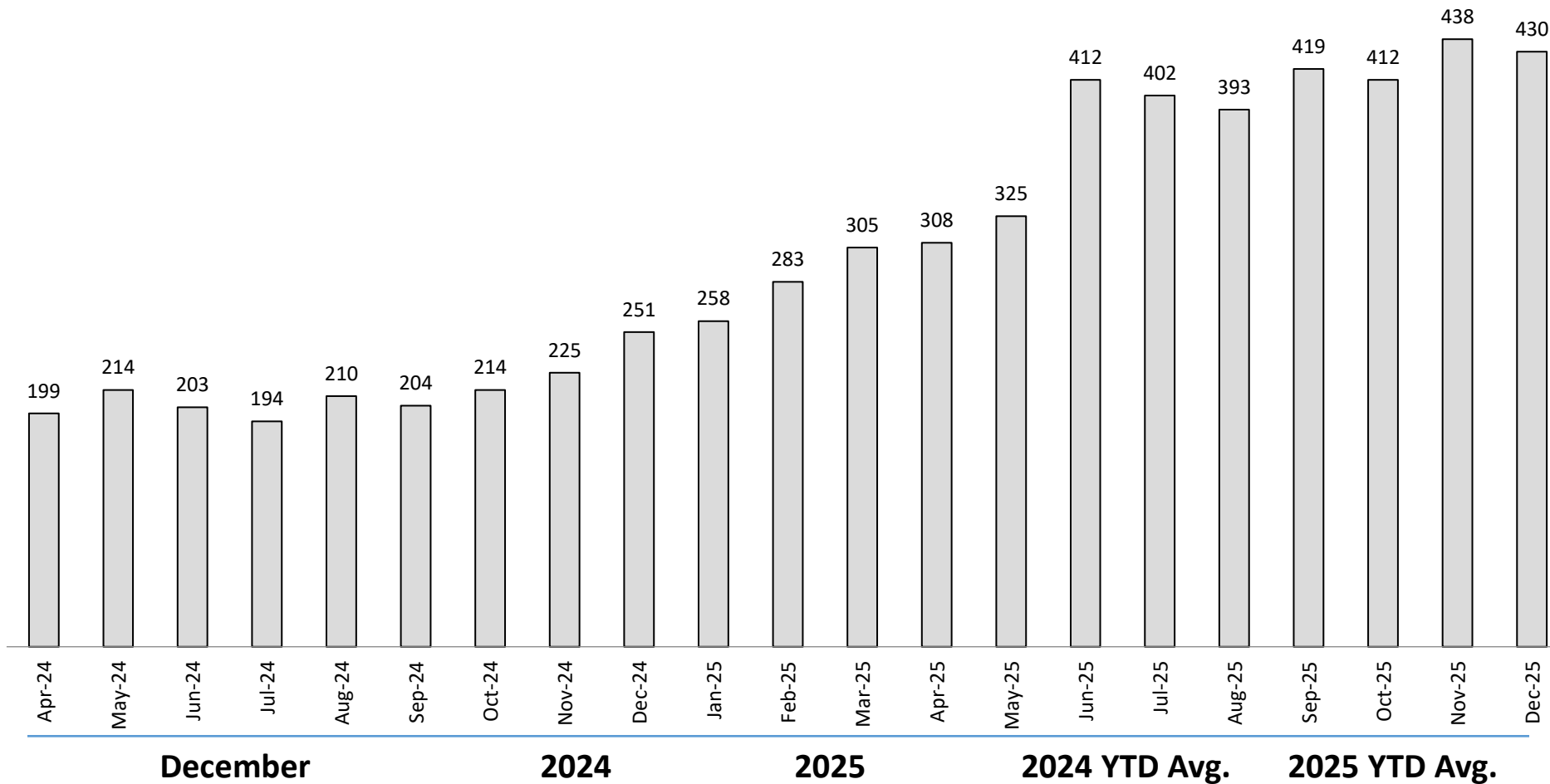

Mental Health - ADP December 2023- present



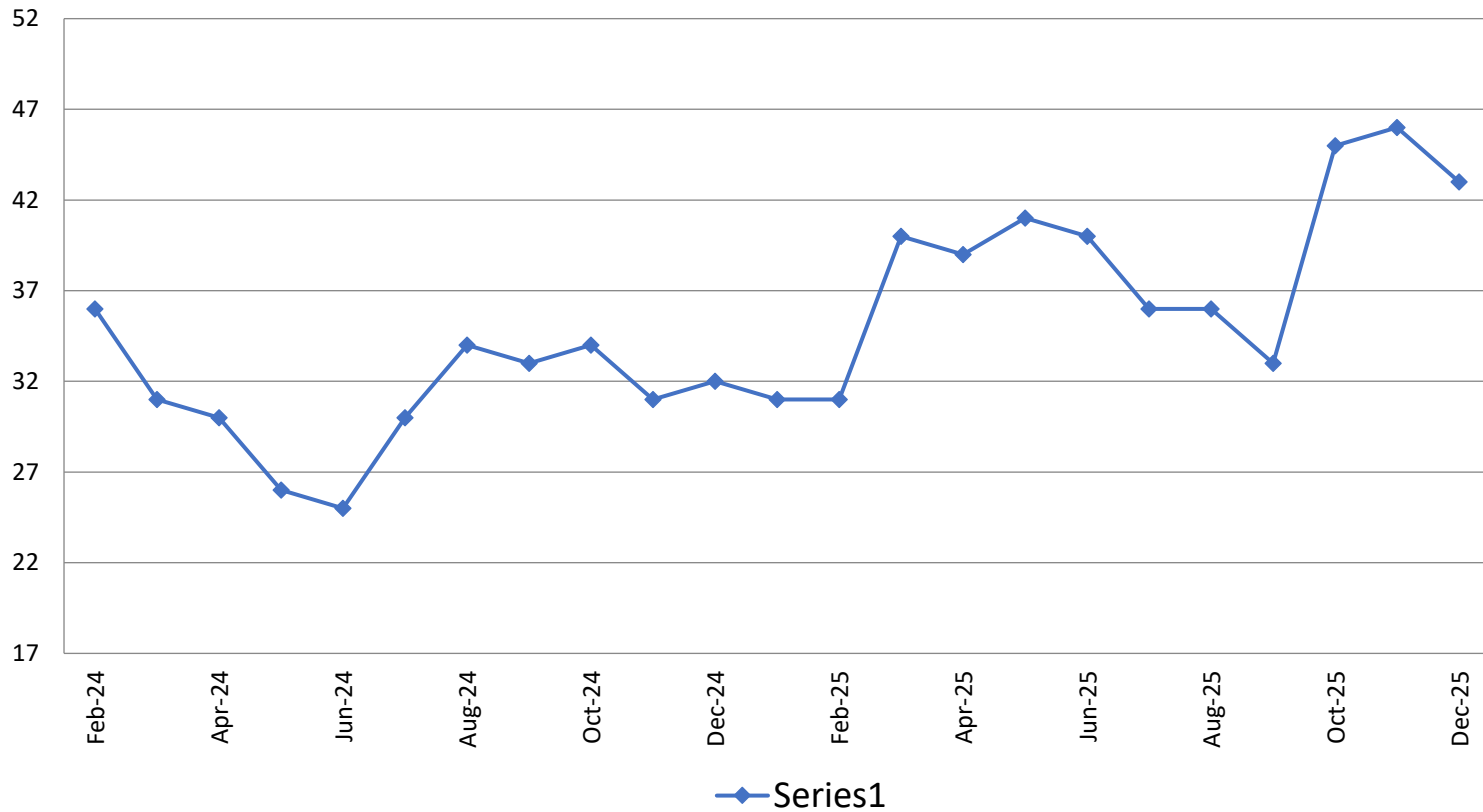

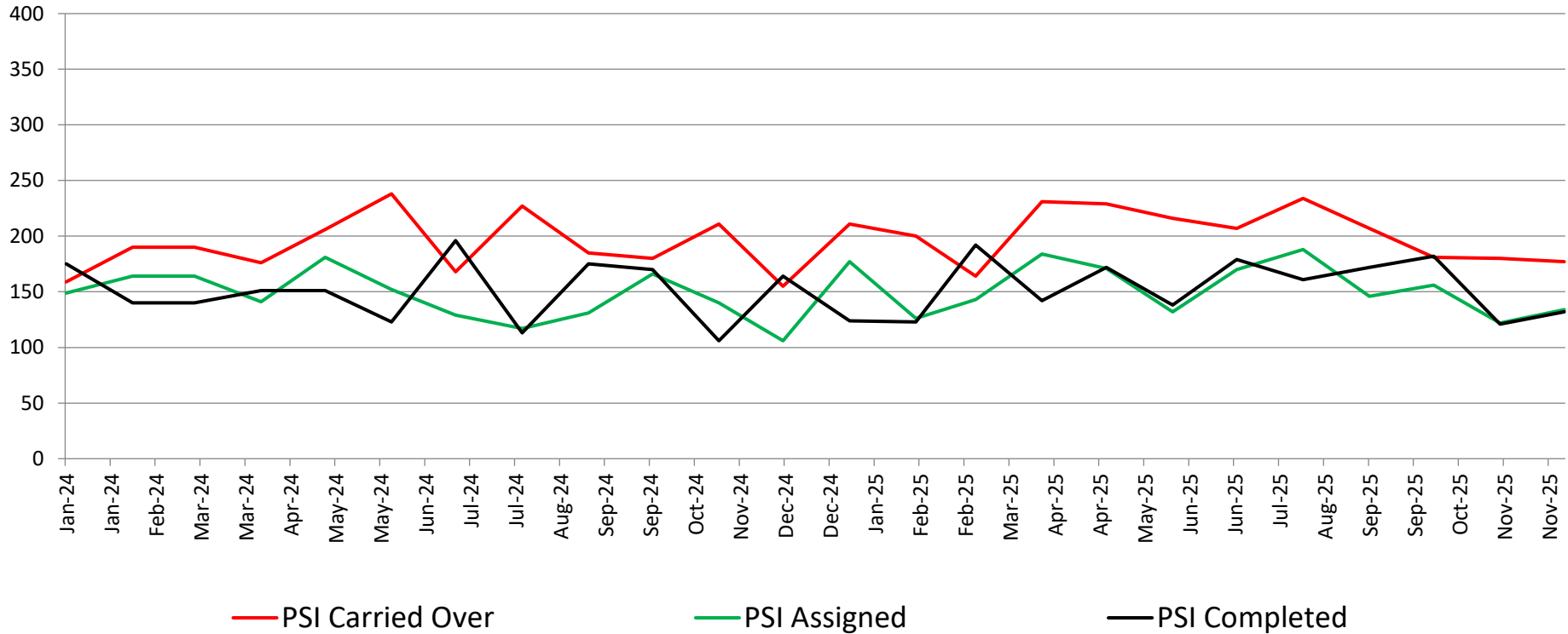

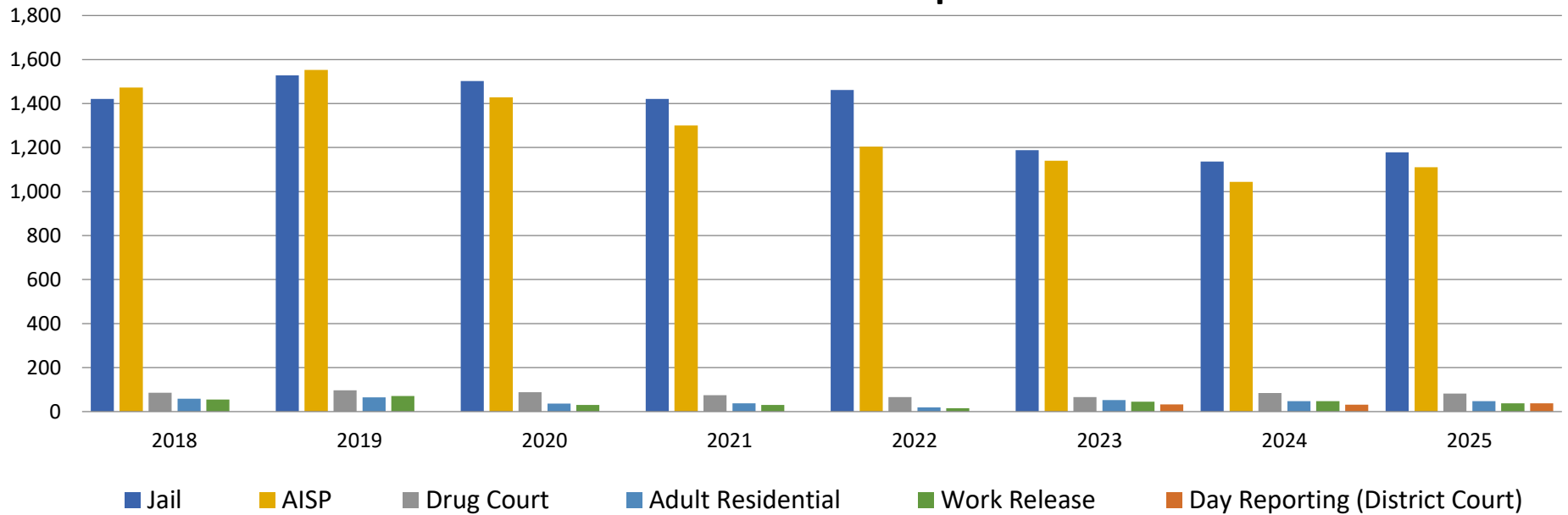

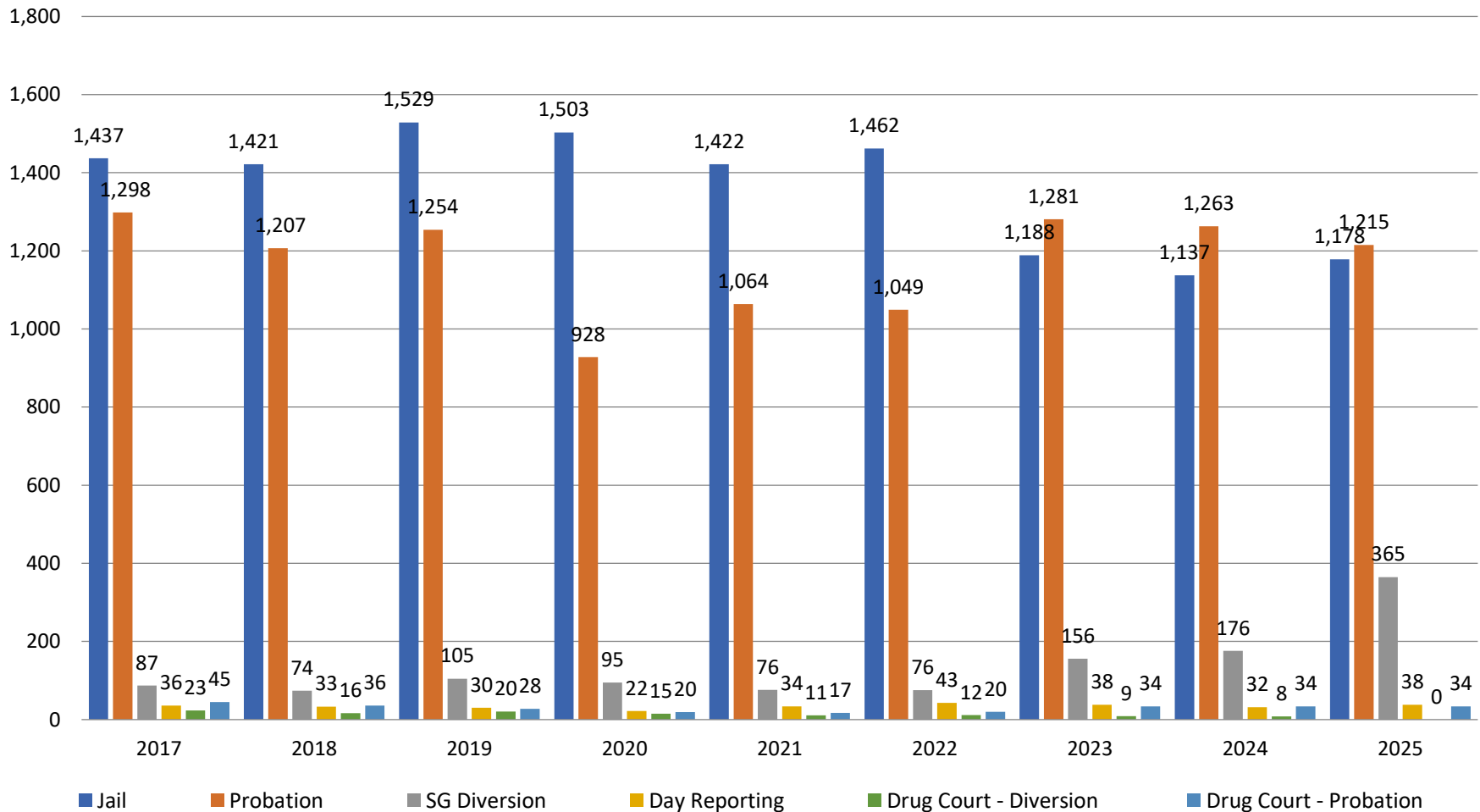

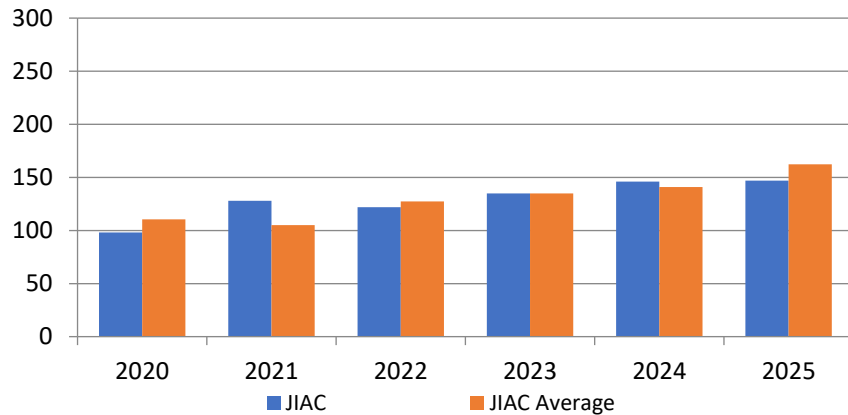

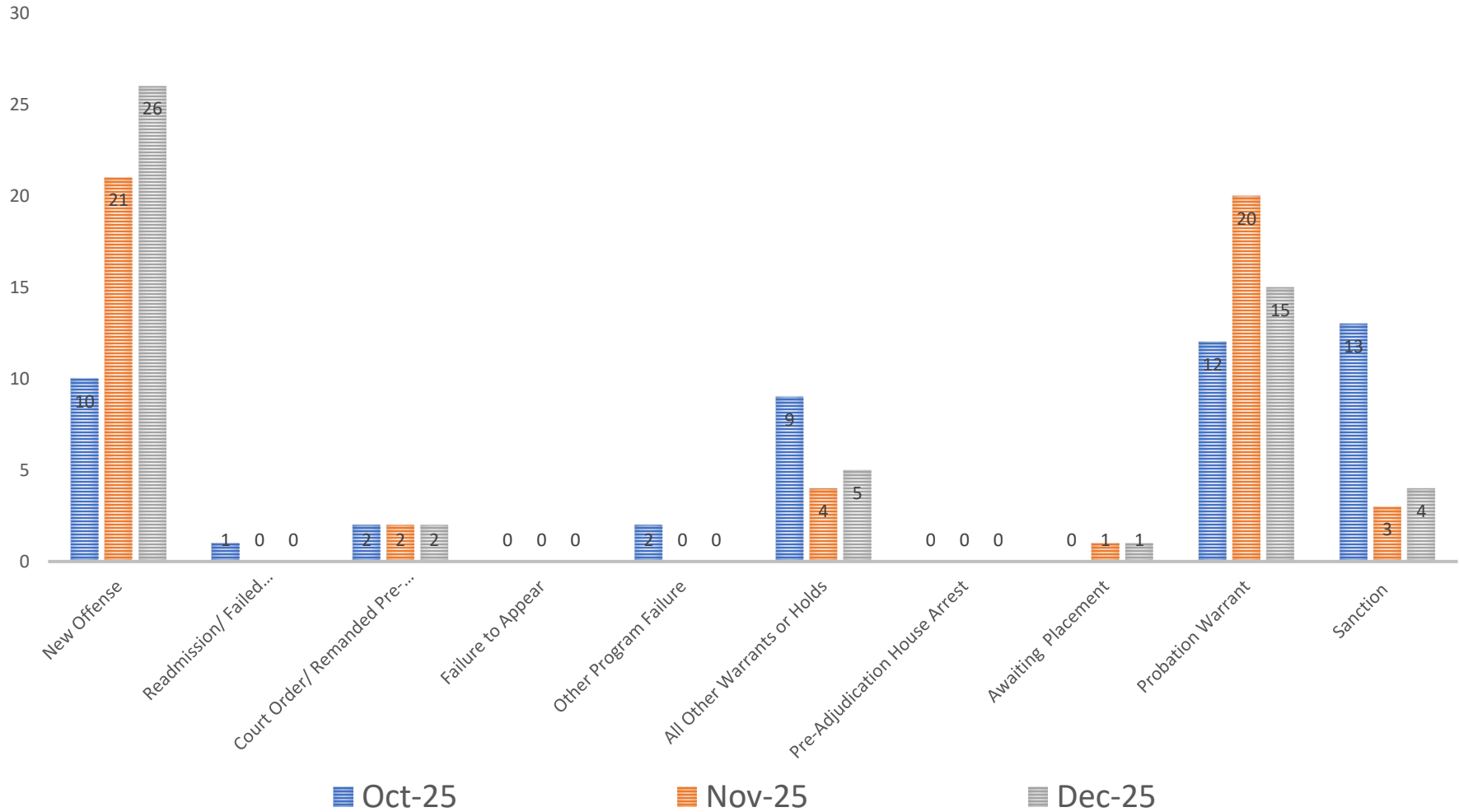

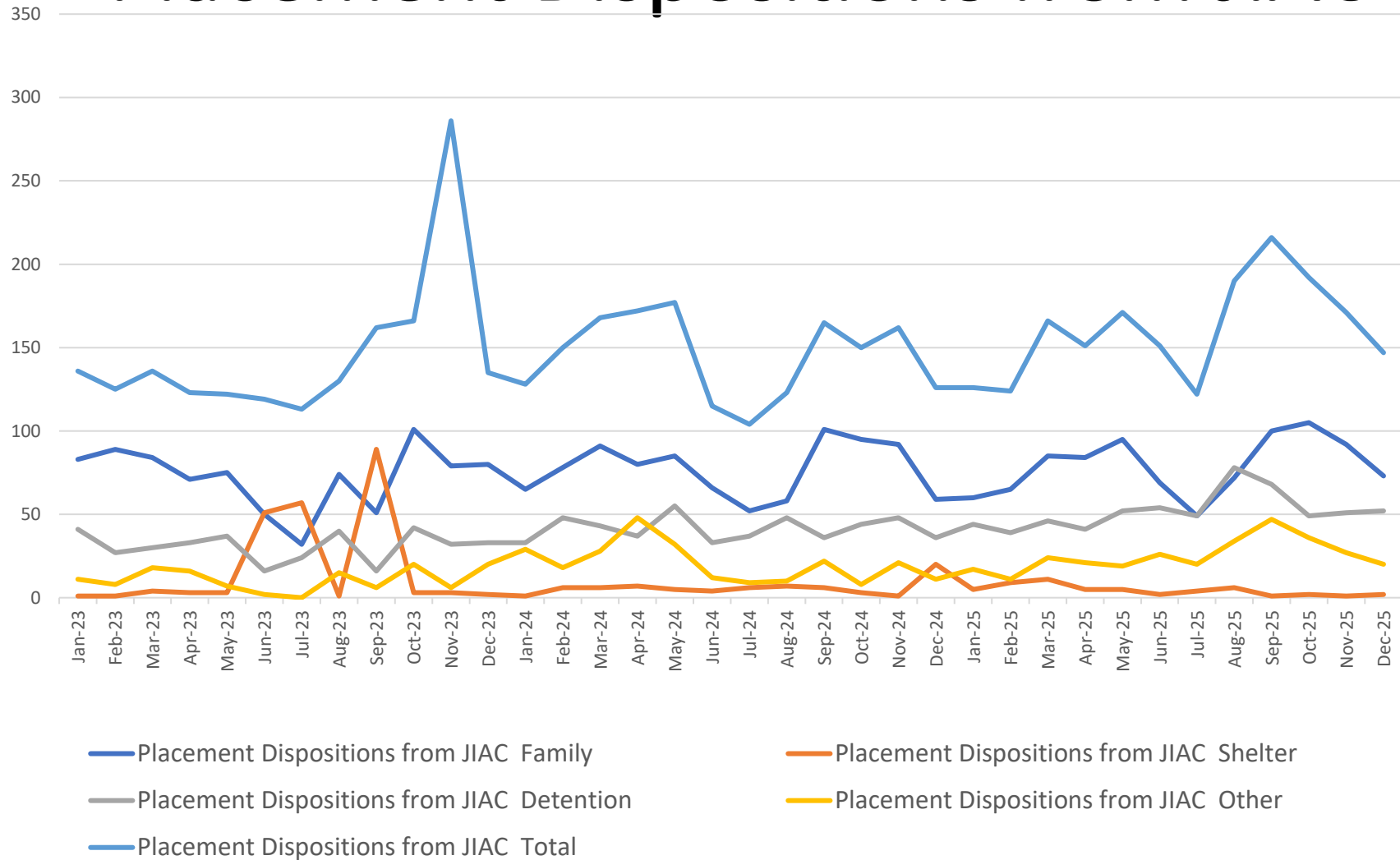

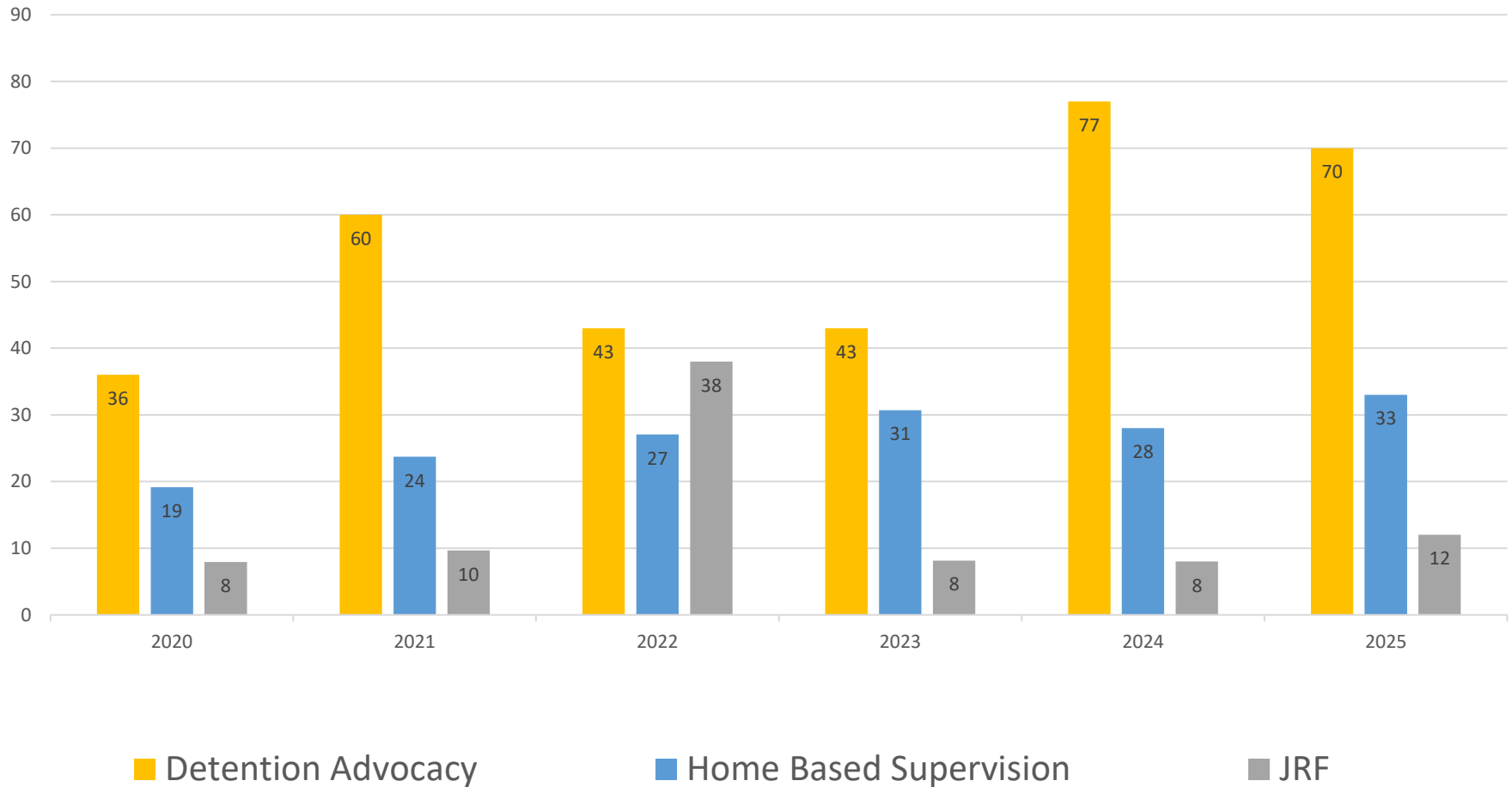


Placement Dispositions from JIAC
