

### March 2024 - Present








# Average Daily Jail Population


















# Percent of Released Inmates Rearrested January 2025 and 2026



## Pretrial Services Program (PSP) Monthly ADP: June 2024- present





## Total Annual ADP: 2018 - present




# Diversion - Active Caseload






# Day Reporting - Active Caseload March 2024 - present






# District Court Probation: Pre-Sentence Investigation 2024- present








