Unfinished Business

Board Member Kilian nominated Board Member Lenz to serve as the Vice Chairperson, Board Member Hawkins seconded the motion, and the nomination of Board Member Lenz as Vice Chairperson was approved (5-0)

Mr. Nordick presented to the Board Members the proposal to present for adoption, the 2017 National Electrical Code with amendments to the UBTC (Unified Building and Trades Code). Board Member Hawkins made a motion to propose for adoption the 2017 National Electrical Code with Amendments to the UBTC. Board Member Kilian seconded the motion, the motion was approved (5-1).

With no other business to conduct. Board Member Naylor made a motion to adjourn, Board Member Hawkins seconded the motion, and the motion was approved (6-0).
