Definitions and Eligibility

Conventionally built structure - any structure in excess of two hundred (200) square feet (18.58 m²), regardless of the type of material used in construction of the structure, and shall include houses, residences, one-, two- and larger family dwellings, commercial buildings, pole barns, garages, detached accessory structures, outbuildings, and similarly built structures; provided however, it does not include manufactured homes, modular homes, or any new pre-manufactured structure designed to be moved to its final destination; nor shall it pertain to any job or construction trailer, portable office, portable classroom, or registered historic structure.

Structure Moving - the transportation or the passing of a conventionally built structure from one place or position to another upon, across or over highways, streets, avenues, alleys or sidewalks into or within Sedgwick County, Kansas.

Real Property destination situs - the final location of the conventionally built structure upon real property and the foundation and site wherein the conventionally built structure is to be set, placed, affixed and or/attached.

Real Property originating situs - the original location of the conventionally built structure upon real property and the foundation and site wherein the conventionally built structure is to be set, placed, affixed and or/attached.

Definitions and Eligibility

To be eligible for Structure Moving Permit:

- Complete all prior requirements including a *pre-moving inspection*, verification with the *Sedgwick County Floodplain Manager* regarding FEMA area, obtain any *wastewater and/or water well permits*, obtain *building permit*, approval from *Sedgwick County Public Works* and all affected utility companies, obtain a *contractor's license* and *proof of insurance*.
- Conventionally built structure must not exceed two hundred (200) square feet.
- Must submit your application prior to 30 days before move date.
- Sedgwick County Clerk's Office must obtain a \$75 fee, application and copies of all required documentation.
- All permits once issued are valid for seven business days from the start of moving date.
