On the recommendation of Lee Barrier, on behalf of Public Works, Tim Myers moved to **accept the low bid from Conspec Inc., dba Kansas Paving in the amount of \$5,705,479.32.** Jennifer Blasi seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Sedgwick County Project 2026 NovaChip (R175-B) will result in a thin asphalt overlay on approximately 61.9 miles of county-maintained roadway. NovaChip is durable and effective on high-speed roadways with minor to moderate cracking and it creates an improved wearing surface for the traveling public. It's applied with a spray paver which places both the asphalt and an emulsion membrane in a single pass sealing small cracks and ensuring proper adhesion to the underlying pavement.

Conspec Inc. dba Kansas Paving is a well-known contractor to Public Works and has successfully worked on many past county projects.

Questions and Answers

Tania Cole: Lynn, will all these 61.9 miles be done in 2026?

Lynn Packer: Yes. All these will be finished up. We plan to start these particular projects right after the 4th of July or right around that time after the harvest. We usually complete in October.
